Today: The Lansing Lugnuts, the High-A affiliate of the Oakland Athletics, play the fifth in a six-game series at the Lake County Captains, High-A affiliate of the Cleveland Guardians, the fifth of 18 meetings between the two clubs this year. Last year, the Nuts finished 9-15 vs. the Captains, going 2-9 in Eastlake and 7-8 at home. Lansing has won three of the first four games in the current series.

On the Air: Logan Potosky and Tyler Danburg deliver the call via Bally Live and MiLB TV, while Jesse Goldberg-Strassler and Adam Jaksa are on StreamGuys.

Yesterday: Lugnuts 5, Captains 2. Henry Bolte homered and delivered an RBI single, Euribiel Ángeles singled, doubled and tripled, and Jacob Watters tossed five fine innings to lead the Lugnuts to the Friday night victory. The game featured eight stolen bases, four by each team.

On Deck: Tomorrow is a 1:00 series finale. Then, following a Monday off day, the Lugnuts return to Michigan's state capital for a 12-game, 13-day homestand against the Dayton Dragons and South Bend Cubs.

Lug•Notes

Just Down the Road: While the High-A A's and Guardians' affiliates are facing off in Eastlake, the MLB A's and Guardians arre playing a three-game series at Progressive Field. Cleveland won the opener yesterday, 10-2.

Sizzling: Elvis Ángeles went 1-for-8 against Dayton to open the season and then 1-for-18 vs. Great Lakes last series, but he has been on a tear against Lake County's pitching staff. Ángeles's 3-for-5 performance yesterday gave him nine hits in 16 at-bats in this series, plus a walk. He has two doubles, one triple, one home run and three stolen bases in four games. Overall, Ángeles is batting .500 (10-for-20) in his last five games.

Streaking: Will Simpson went 0-for-3 with two walks last night, extending his on-base streak to 12 games to open the season.

Powering On: The Lugs had hit only two home runs in their first nine games before knocking seven homers in the first four games of this series – including a home run by **Brayan Buelvas** in each of the three games and a pair of home runs from **Henry Bolte**.

League Leaderboard: Brayan Buelvas and Henry Bolte are tied for 2nd in the Midwest League in home runs (3); Buelvas is 3rd in runs scored (12) and tied for 6th in walks (10); Will Simpson is 1st in walks (14), 5th in on-base percentage (.490) and tied for 5th in RBIs (10); James González is 1st in ERA (0.79), 3rd in WHIP (0.71) and 5th in opponent batting average (.175); Jose Dicochea is tied for 8th in strikeouts (15); Garrett Irvin is tied for 1st in appearances (5).

A Grand Start: On April 3, first baseman Will Simpson crushed a grand slam (as well as a solo shot) in an 18-0 victory over Michigan State in the Crosstown Showdown. Ten days later, Simpson launched a grand slam off the Great Lakes Loons in an 8-5 loss.

EMU to The Show: 2021 Lansing super utilityman **Max Schuemann** made his Major League debut a week ago last Friday as a pinch-runner for the A's, scoring the game-winning run in the bottom of the 10th on an RBI single from **Lawrence Butler** (2021-22 Lugnut), as the A's walked off the Nationals, 2-1. Schuemann is the 185th all-time Lugnut to reach the Majors and the first this year.

Prospecting: The Nuts' Opening Day roster includes two MLB Pipeline Top 30 A's prospects in outfielder **Henry Bolte** (No. 12) and first baseman **Will Simpson** (No. 30). Bolte, the A's No. 2 outfield prospect, was selected 56th overall in 2022 from Palo Alto High School, where he led all California high schoolers with 13 home runs. He spent the 2023 season with Single-A Stockton, where he slashed .257/.356/.421 in 112 games, collecting 17 doubles, five triples, 14 home runs and 32 stolen bases. Simpson, the A's No. 2 first base prospect, impressed with a .319/ .367/.543 line in his professional debut after he was drafted in the 15th round from Washington last year.

TODAY IN LUGNUTS HISTORY

2013: The Lugnuts scored eight runs on 14 hits, but still were steamrolled by Fort Wayne, 17-8, as the TinCaps rolled up 21 hits against five Nuts pitchers. Future Major Leaguers Roberto Osuna (3 2/3, 3 R, 4 K) started against Fort Wayne's Max Fried (4 IP, 4 R, 5 K).

2023: The Lake County Captains completed a doubleheader sweep at Classic Auto Group Park, defeating the Lugnuts 3-2 and 6-4. In Game 1, the Caps outhit the Lugnuts 9-2, but Lansing tied the game at 2-2 in the top of the 6th inning on a Junior Perez sacrifice fly... only to see Joe Lampe's two-out single in the bottom of the 7th off John Beller give Lake County the walkoff win. In Game 2, Caeden Trenkle led off with a first-pitch home run off Trenton Denholm and increased their lead to 3-0 in the 3rd on a Max Muncy home run. Mitch Myers fired five brilliant scoreless innings... but Hunter Breault gave up six runs in the blink of an eye in the 6th inning to turn the tide, capped by an Isaiah Greene two-run homer.

In a Nutshell: Tallest Lugnut on the roster... youngest Lugnuts pitcher and the third youngest player on the team behind Henry Bolte and Elvis Rijo... making High-A debut this season in measured climb up the A's ladder after he was drafted from high school... part of "Pont-era" tandem combination with Blaze Pontes, opening fourth in the rotation.

Draft Day: Signed for \$125,000 out of Colegio Acelardo de Educación Secundaria (C.A.D.E.S.T.)... first ever player drafted from C.A.D.E.S.T.

Hometown Hero: Also born in San Juan: infielder Darell Hernaiz, recently sent down to Las Vegas from Oakland, as well as Bernie Williams, Danny Tartabull, Mike Lowell, Javy Lopez... home city of Vega Alta ("high/upper meadow"), founded 1775, is located in northern Puerto Rico, neighboring Vega Baja.

2021: Made professional debut on September 10 with a perfect inning against AzCL Giants Black, striking out one.

2022: Returned to action with the Arizona Complex League on July 5 with a hitless, scoreless inning against AzCL Brewers Gold... made eight appearances, none longer than 2 2/23 innings (August 6, striking out six Cubs).

2023: Joined Stockton in late May, making season debut on May 25... tossed three starts of at least six innings, peaking with 7-inning shutout gem on August 30 vs. Rancho Cucamonga (3 H, 3 BB, 5 K, 83 pitches, 50 strikes)... set career high in strikeouts with nine in five innings at Visalia, August 2... limited right-handers to .235 avg., .677 OPS (though they also hit the only three home runs he allowed all year); lefties batted .291 with an .849 OPS... 3.82 ERA in home games (8 G, 6 GS, 37 2/3 IP) compared to 7.18 ERA in road games (8 G, 6 GS, 31 1/3 IP).

Stoltz's Scouting Report: From Nathaniel Stoltz's Excessive Prospect Analysis: "Rivera has been the A's org's youngest pitcher in full-season ball by a full year, as he only recently just turned 20. As is to be expected from a young, huge (6'7", 237) pitcher who is light on pro experience, he's had bouts of inconsistency in Stockton, particularly on the command front, as the Puerto Rican southpaw is still figuring out how to corral his extended arm action and lengthy stride down the mound. He's got two good pitches to work with already, though: a 92-95 mph fastball that touches 96 and features big carry, and a wipeout mid-80s slider that he already shows signs of commanding... There's reason to expect a pitcher like this to possibly have lots of development remaining." In Stoltz's midseason review last year, he ranked Rivera as the A's No. 31 prospect.

Last Time Out: In second career professional start, allowed three runs in the 2nd inning, one in the 3rd, and then knocked out with four runs in the 4th inning, as the Loons routed the Lugnuts 12-4 in the Sunday series finale... allowed a solo home run to Dylan Campbell in the 3rd inning and a two-run homer to Chris Newell in the 4th... 68 pitches, 43 strikes.

Back Home: Signed for \$75,000... high school teammates with Hunter Breault, who was one year older at Kamehameha-Kapalama H.S... graduated HS with 3.5 GPA... played club ball for Team California Baseball, top 10 nationally ranked... First Team All-State as junior (0.95)... 2022 - junior year at Hawai'i: First Team All Big West, ranking 3rd in the conference in ERA (1.90) and leading Hawai'i in strikeouts (88)... joins Dustin Antolin as Lugnuts to hail from Mililani.

Minor League Path: Made pro debut in the Arizona Complex League in 2022 with a pair of scoreless innings, moving up to Stockton for two relief appearances by year's end... spent all of 2023 with the Ports, serving as their relief ace (11 saves in 15 chances) and only allowing three home runs in 61 1/3 innings... limited left-handed batters to .198 batting average / .530 OPS; right-handers hit .305 with .753 OPS.
