JACKSONVILLE FALLS 11-4

Peyton Burdick homered for the second day in a row but the Jumbo Shrimp dropped Friday's contest 11-4 to the IronPigs. With a run in the second, three in the third, two in the fourth and four in the sixth, Lehigh Valley jumped out to a 10-0 advantage. Burdick's two-run shot highlighted a fourrun bottom of the sixth. However, the IronPigs plated one more tally in the eighth to set the final score at 11-4. Lehigh Valley has taken three of the set's first four games.

THE *START* OF SOMETHING?

Jacksonville starting pitchers have ceded three runs or fewer in 12 of their last 15 games. During that span, Jumbo Shrimp lid-lifters have yielded 33 runs, 30 earned, on 69 hits in 73.0 innings for a 3.70 ERA. This stretch has not seen Jacksonville starters strike out many opponents, with the club's rotation registering just 50 punchouts (6.2 K/9). However, they have only issued 19 walks during this run, a rate of 2.3 per nine innings

WALKING ON SUNSHINE

Over the season's first eight games, Jacksonville mustered only 25 walks, the second-fewest such total in the International League. However, the Jumbo Shrimp have shown a significant amount of patience of late; Jacksonville has registered 79 free passes over the last 15 games since April 11, a figure that ranks tied for fourth in the International League. During this stretch, the club has walked in 13.6 percent of their plate appearances. The MLB average is roughly 8.6 percent. The Shrimp walked in just 7.6 percent of plate appearances in their first eight games.

BYE-BYE BURDICK

Coming into 2023, Peyton Burdick hadn't recorded a multi-homer game since bashing two in Biloxi on August 4. 2021 while playing for Double-A Pensacola. The Cincinnati native has already registered two multi-homer games this season, and his 10 on the season are tied for first in the International League. Burdick is tied for fourth in the IL in RBIs (22), tied for fifth in extra-base hits (14), sixth in slugging (..674), tied for seventh in runs scored (21), tied for eighth in RBIs (20), 10th in OPS (1.053) and tied for 11th in hits (28). Burdick's HR/FB rate of 43.5 percent ranks second out of the 139 IL qualifiers

FRIENDS CLOSE, ENEMIES CLOSER

Jacksonville bested Nashville at home last week, winning three-of-five in the series, with all three coming by exactly one run. Thus, of the team's first 11 victories in 2023, six have come by one run with an additional triumph by two tallies. Consequently, Jacksonville's six wins in such games tops the league. The Jumbo Shrimp are 6-2 (.750) in one-run affairs after posting a 19-19 (.500) such record in those closely-decided games during the 2022 season.

'PEN PALS

The Jacksonville bullpen struggled mightily during a seven-game stretch from April 14-26. Over that timeframe. Jumbo Shrimp relievers collectively surrendered 27 runs, 26 earned, on 38 hits (11.7 H/9) in 29.1 innings for a 7.98 ERA. That stretch saw the club's bullpen fan 35 batters (10.7 K/9) but walk 23 hitters (7.1 BB/9). However, in the last three games since then. Jacksonville relievers have combined to cede six runs, but only two earned, on 16 hits (13.5 K/9) in 14.2 innings for a 1.23 ERA. The Jumbo Shrimp bullpen has combined for 16 strikeouts (13.5 K/9) against seven walks (4.3 BB/9).

GO C.J., THAT'S MY C.J.

On Jacksonville's slugging offense, perhaps no one has shined more than C.J. Hinojosa. Through 17 games thus far in 2023, Hinojosa is 24-for-73, slashing a robust .312/.349/.558/.907 with two doubles, one triple, five home runs, 17 RBIs and 10 runs scored. The Houston native ranks for 18th in the International League in slugging, tied for 19th in RBIs and 24th in batting average. The Houston, Texas native has reached base in 12 of his last 13 games entering play on Saturday.

SHRIMP BITES

Jacksonville has dropped five of their last seven games. getting outscored 32-16 in the process. The 16 runs scored during that span are the fewest in Triple-A and secondfewest out of the 120 MiLB teams. The Jumbo Shrimp are batting just .174/.288/.246/.534 as a team in those seven games since April 20 | Jerar Encarnacion ranks in a tie for 16th in RBIs (19)... Xavier Edwards placed in a tie for 13th in runs scored (13)... Jacksonville's 15 hits allowed last night matched a season-high.

ABOUT JEFF

-A graduate of Illinois State University, Lindgren was mainly a reliever in college, starting in just 17 of his 83 appearances. He went 8-14 with a 6.02 ERA over his four seasons. However, entering 2022, he has already totaled 19 minor league starts in 36 career games, collecting an 8-10 record and 3.28 ERA.

-Jeff comes from an athletic family; His father, John, played football at Henderson State University in Arkadelphia, Arkansas.

-An alumnus of Illinois State University, Jeff followed in his sister Allyson's footsteps in attending school in Bloomington-Normal, Illinois. Allyson is a fellow graduate of Illinois State.

2022 SEASON

-Lingren played for the Pensacola Blue Wahoo's between stint with Jacksonville. In 2022 combine, Lingren posted a 7-4 record with $116\ \rm strikeouts$ in $136.2\ \rm IP$.

2021 SEASON

-With the bases empty, opponents hit .234 (59-for-252) with a .740 OPS. However, with runners in scoring position, Lindgren buckled down for a .211 (16-for-76) opponents' average and .598 OPS.

-Lindgren got off to slower starts in 2021; in the first and second innings, opponents batted .290 (43-for-148). However, in the third and fourth innings, often his second time through the order, Lindgren held opposing hitters to a .183 (25-for-136).

-When Lindgren got hitters in a 1-2 hole, they were just 7-for-71 (.099) against him with 33 strikeouts.

Interestingly, when Lindgren was pitching from behind on the scoreboard, he performed better, holding opponents to a .176 (24-for-136) average. When his team led, opposing hitters collected a .241 (27-for-112) average.

2019 SEASON

-With High-A Jupiter, lefties hit .297 with a .680 OPS against Lindgren. However, he held right-handed hitters to a .176 average with a .432 OPS.

-With the bases empty, opponents hit .275 (11-for-40) against Lindgren with a .626 OPS. With runners in scoring position, Lindgren limited opposing batters to .194 (6-for-31) with a .508 OPS. Total, with runners on, Lindgren posted a .188 (9-for-48) batting average against with an OPS of .471.

ADDITIONAL CAREER NOTES

-At Centennial High School (Champaign, Ill.), Lindgren competed in both baseball and basketball. He served as the baseball team captain, helped win two regional championships and one sectional championship.
