SOMERSET PATRIOTS NOTES

- The Somerset Patriots lost to the Akron RubberDucks 11-4 at 7 17 Credit Union Park in Akron, OH on Friday night.
 - The loss moved Somerset to 4.5 games back of first-place Reading in the Northeast Division with 32 games remaining.
 - With homers from DJ Gladney and Jackson Castillo, Somerset has smashed multiple homers in back-to-back games and in 45 of 106 (42.5%) games this season. That surpasses Somerset's multiple homers in 35 of 138 (25.4%) games in 2025.
 - Somerset's 151 homers this season lead Double-A and are tied for eighth in MiLB at the time of the game's conclusion.
 - Jackson Castillo's two-out homer in the eighth inning marked Somerset's 14th two-out homer since the All-Star break to tie for the MiLB lead. Somerset's .324 AVG with two outs in that span leads Double-A and ranks second in MiLB.
- RHP Chase Hampton (3.0 IP, 7 H, 5 R, 0 BB, 1 K)** struck out Jaison Chourio looking in the second inning during his ninth start with Somerset this season.
- RHP Trent Sellers (2.0 IP, 1 H, 0 R, 1 BB, 1 K)** tossed two scoreless innings for his second consecutive outing.
 - Across his last 10 appearances, Sellers has posted a 1.26 ERA and .157 BAA with 19 K in 14.1 IP.
- DH Jace Avina (1-for-2, 2B, 3 BB)** clubbed a leadoff double in the first inning before walking three times.
 - Avina's three walks tied a career-high for the fourth time this season and eighth time overall.
 - Avina's four games with three walks this year have all come since July 23 at New Hampshire. In that span, Avina has walked 18 times en route to a .446 OBP across 14 games.
 - Avina's 45 XBH this season lead all Yankees farmhands.
- RF DJ Gladney (1-for-5, HR, 2 RBI, R)** smacked his 19th home run of the season to left field in the fifth inning.
 - Gladney's 19 homers tie a career-high for the third time (2022, 2023) and are tied for second among active Eastern League hitters and tied for third in the Yankees farm system.
 - Gladney extended his on-base streak to 10 games. With hits in nine games during that stretch, Gladney is slashing .381/.409/.738 with 4 HR, 7 XBH and 12 RBI.
- SS Roderick Arias (1-for-4)** looped a single into shallow right center field in the third inning.
 - Arias has hit safely in all four games to start his stint with Somerset.
 - Dating back to his time in Hudson Valley, Arias has hit safely in eight straight games. In that span, he's slashing .394/.412/.606 with 6 XBH, 3 RBI and four multi-hit games.

- **LF Jackson Castillo (1-for-3, HR, 2 RBI, BB, R)** powered his eighth homer of the season on a two-run shot to right field in the eighth inning.
 - Castillo's homer snapped a 29-game drought without a long ball dating back to June 30 and placed him one homer shy of tying a career-high nine home runs in 2024.
 - Castillo extended his on-base streak to eight games. In that span, he's reached base safely in 14-of-35 plate appearances (.400 OBP).
- **1B Josh Moylan (1-for-4)** extended his hit streak to five games with a single in the second inning.
 - During his five-game hit streak, Moylan is 6-for-19 at the plate.
 - Across his last 16 games, Moylan is slashing .333/.354/.517 with 3 HR, 11 RBI, 5 XBH and four multi-hit games.
- **CF Luis Durango (1-for-3, BB, R, SB)** singled in the third inning before swiping his 40th stolen base of the season.
 - Durango's 40 SB this season rank second in the Yankees farm system.
 - Durango extended his on-base streak to eight games during which he's reached in 13 of 27 plate appearances (.481 OBP).
 - Across 10 Double-A games this season, Durango is 9-for-26 with 5 R, 2 XBH, 4 RBI, 4 SB and 4 BB.
