IT'S ALL DOWN-HILL FROM HERE: After back-to-back rainouts post-All-Star break and three straight overall, it has been eight days since the FredNats have played a baseball game. Weather permitting, the team returns to action for a doubleheader with the Lynchburg Hillcats (Cleveland Guardians), the first two of eight straight home games after the All-Star break. Yoel Tejeda Jr. starts the doubleheader opener today. He is the newest member of MLB Pipeline's Top-30 Nationals prospects, slotting in to number number 17 in the organization after a mid-season shuffle. Tejeda has been one of the most consistent FredNats all season, posting an ERA under four every single month. He faces Braylon Doughty from the Hillcats in game one, then Xander Meckely and Jervis Alfaro tangle in game two, which will be broadcast live on MASN, the television home of the Washignton Nationals.

ABOUT LAST SERIES: Fredericksburg won three out of five games played in a weather-shortened series with the Carolina Mudcats heading into the All-Star break. The FredNats are currently a game out of first place in the North Division in the second half with 45 games to play still. The FredNat offense had a nice week, averaging just under five runs per game in the series.

THIS BULLPEN IS INSANE: The FredNat bullpen has been central to the team's efforts all season, but the group has taken it to a new level since June 1. Since then, FBG's bullpen ERA is 2.37, which is currently number three in professional baseball (150 total teams) after taking a small step back with Saturday's walk-off home run. Fredericksburg is 30-1 when leading after seven innings this season, and 26-1 when leading after eight innings. Fredericksburg's 13 saves in that time frame is also tied for the second-most in Minor League Baseball.

DON'T EVEN TRY IT: The FredNat catching duo of Kevin Bazzell and Nate Rombach has been prolific at throwing out potential base stealers this season. Fredericksburg's MiLB-leading season total is up to 67, five clear of the field. Fredericksburg has allowed 29 fewer total stolen bases than the next team. Heading into play today, Bazzel leads MiLB by four with 41 caught stealings and owns the best CS% of all MiLB catchers who have played at least 400 innings this year, throwing out 40% of would-be base stealers. Rombach has 26 caught stealings himself, a top-20 mark in Minor League baseball, and is throwing out 35% of potential base stealers.

NEARLY PERFECT PABLO: FredNat reliever Pablo Aldonis currently has the longest scoreless inning streak (18.1) among active pitchers in the Carolina League, and his current streak is the second-longest among active Single-A pitchers. Aldonis has not allowed a run since June 3, and he has played practically every role for the FredNat bullpen. He closed out the 4th of July game for his first professional save, and was brought into Tuesday's series opener this week in the first inning when the FredNat starter was lifted. In that scoreless time frame, Aldonis has 24 strikeouts against five walks, and has allowed 10 total hits in that time frame.

MISSED YA, MOTA: Jorgelys Mota returned from a three-week trip to the injured list with a strained hamstring on July 1, and since coming back, he's been one of the most impactful bats in all of the Carolina League. Since coming back, Mota is 11-for-26 (.423) with three doubles, four RBIs and two walks. His .423 batting average is the third-best in the Carolina League this month.

FOR THE PEOPLES: Nick Peoples' two-run tiebreaking blast in the 9th inning Wednesday night was the second time in the last month Peoples has hit a home run in the 9th inning of a tied road game. He also did it back on June 12 at Fayetteville, breaking a 0-0 tie in that game and turning it into a 1-0 Fredericksburg victory. Peoples has enjoyed a very strong start to July, hitting home runs from both sides of the plate and posting an .891 OPS (7th in the Carolina League) in eight games so far this month.

THE STAFF: After Jake Lowery's third season as Manager of the FredNats ended in a Carolina League championship in 2024, the FredNats welcome Billy McMillon as the third Manager in Fredericksburg franchise history. McMillon, 53, has spent the last three seasons in the Nationals organization as the Development Coach for Triple-A Rochester. He also played parts of six seasons in the Major Leagues with Oakland, Detroit, Philadelphia and Florida. He's joined on the staff by returning Pitching Coach Justin Lord, returning Hitting Coach Mike Habas, Development Coach Luis Ordaz, returning Athletic Trainer Jacob Meyer, Strength & Conditioning Coach Mike Reiskind, and Performance Analyst Samantha Unger.

A LASTING LEGACY: The Fredericksburg Nationals adopt the franchise history of their predecessors in the Carolina League dating back to 1978...the Alexandria Dukes (1978, 1980-83) and Alexandria Mariners (1979) played at Four Mile Run Park in Alexandria, Virginia...the Prince William Pirates (1984-1986), Prince William Yankees (1987-1988), Prince William Cannons (1989-1998), Potomac Cannons (1999-2004) and Potomac Nationals (2005-2019) played at G. Richard Pfitzner Stadium in Woodbridge, Virginia...the franchise has won six Carolina League championships, as the Dukes in 1982, as the Yankees in 1989, and as the Nationals in 2008, 2010 and 2014. The franchise won its first league title as the Fredericksburg Nationals in 2024, defeating the Kannapolis Cannon Ballers two games to one to win the title at Virginia Credit Union Stadium.

LAST TIME OUT: Yoel Tejeda Jr (Pronounced: Yo-ell Tay-hay-duh) got the loss in his last start at Carolina before the All-Star break. In a rain-shortened game, Tejeda threw all five innings and surrendered four earned runs on seven hits.

UP THE PIPELINE: Tejeda, who just turned 22, recently lept into MLB Pipeline's rankings of Washington's top 30 prospects. The first-year prowent from unranked to 17th on the list after an impressive first 15 starts for the FredNats.

MR. CONSISTENT: Tejeda posted an ERA under 4.00 in each of the season's first three months: 3.94 in April, 3.28 in May and 3.69 in June. He was named as the Fredericksburg Pitcher of the Month in May by Nationals Player Development.

EXECUTIVE DECISION: Tejeda has recently been working on his mental game with a sports psychologist, developing the mindset to be an "executioner" on the mound, attacking hitters without any fear.

ON FLORIDA TIME: Tejeda pitched for two different Florida schools at the collegiate level. The righthander had a 5.56 ERA in 22.2 IP as a primary starter for Florida in 2023 and a 5.95 ERA in 19.2 IP as a reliever for Florida State in 2024 after transferring.

TOP SHELF: At 6-foot-8, Tejeda is tied with Jackson Rutledge ('21, '22) as the tallest player to ever play for the FredNats.

ALEXANDER THE GREAT: Meckley, the Nationals' 12th round pick (350th overall) in the 2024 MLB Draft, was flawless after being called up to Fredericksburg last year. He made five appearances for the FredNats between the regular season and postseason and did not give up a run. In total, he allowed just four hits in 9.1 IP and got a save in his lone opportunity with two shutout innings against LYN on 9/4.

START IT UP: Meckley's five appearances for the FredNats last year during his first year at the professional level were all out of the bullpen, making this his first year as a starter in his professional career.

LAST TIME OUT: Meckley had his shortest start of the season on Tuesday at Carolina, failing to get out of the first inning for the first time. He didn't allow a hit, but walked three and gave up two runs.

JUNE SWOON: Meckley's month of June was fabulous. Across four starts, he allowed just five earned runs in 21.1 IP, for an ERA of 2.11.

BACK IN SCHOOL: Meckley made 21 appearances at Coastal Carolina in 2024 with nine starts for the Chanticleers, posting a 7.52 ERA in 52.2 IP with 57 K's. He previously pitched two seasons at WVU Potomac State (NJCAA)...made 20 appearances (17 starts) and led the Catamounts with 73 K's and a 2.96 ERA in 2023.

BILLY MCMILLON - MANAGER

1st Season | Previously: Development Coach, Triple-A Rochester

McMillon, 53, joined Washington in 2022 and has spent the last three seasons as the Development Coach for Triple-A Rochester. McMillon played parts of six Major League seasons with four different organizations, including the Oakland Athletics (2001-04), Detroit Tigers (2000-01), Philadelphia Phillies (1997), and Florida Marlins (1996-97). The former Clemson Tiger was a three-time International League All-Star and the 1996 IL Rookie of the Year with Charlotte, earning him induction into the IL Hall of Fame in 2019 and Charlotte's Round Table of Honor in 2022. McMillon was initially selected in the eighth round of the 1993 MLB Draft by Florida. He replaces Jake Lowery, who managed the FredNats the last three seasons, culminating in a championship last year. Lowery will manage High-A Wilmington in 2025.

Prior to joining Washington, McMillon coached in the Boston Red Sox organization for over a decade. He managed the Worcester Red Sox (Triple-A) in their inaugural season in 2021 after managing Boston's former Triple-A affiliate Pawtucket in 2019. He was set to lead the PawSox again in 2020 before the cancellation of the MiLB season. Prior to managing at the Triple-A level, McMillon was the Minor League Outfield and Baserunning Coordinator for Boston from 2016-18 after managing for six seasons in the organization with Double-A Portland (2014-15), High-A Salem (2012-13), and Single-A Greenville (2010-11). His coaching career began in 2008 when he was Greenville's Hitting Coach.

3rd Season | Previously: Pitching Coach, Double-A Harrisburg

Lord, 45, returns to Fredericksburg for a third season in 2025 after leading the FredNats' championship pitching staff last season, including the 2024 Carolina League Pitcher of the Year Travis Sykora.

This is Lord's fifth total season coaching in the Washington organization after a six-year professional playing career and several seasons coaching in the Baltimore system. The Alabama native and Florida State alum was scheduled to be the Fredericksburg Pitching Coach in the canceled 2020 season, and was the Pitching Coach for one season in Double-A Harrisburg prior to joining the FredNats in 2023.

2nd Season | Previously: Hitting Coach, ACL Brewers

Habas, 34, returns to Fredericksburg from the 2024 championship staff for his second season with Washington after leading the FredNat offense to a highly successful season, finishing in the top third of the league in virtually every meaningful offensive category.

Prior to joining the Nationals, he spent spending the previous four seasons coaching in the Milwaukee Brewers organization, most recently as the Hitting Coach for the ACL Brewers in 2022 and 2023. Prior to joining Milwaukee, he was an Assistant Coach for the independent Gary SouthShore RailCats. While coaching with Gary, he was also the Head Coach at Prairie State College, a Junior College in the Chicago area.

Ordaz, 49, joins the FredNat coaching staff in the Development Coach role after managing the Florida Complex League Nationals in 2024.

He played parts of seven seasons in the Major Leagues, appearing in 206 career games with the St. Louis Cardinals, Kansas City Royals and Tampa Bay Devil Rays. Ordaz has coached in the Washington organization for over a decade, and was the Hitting Coach for the Potomac Nationals for four seasons from 2016-19. He replaces Carmelo Jaime, who will manage the FCL Nationals in 2025 after three seasons in Fredericksburg.
