RIDERS ROMP OVER WICHITA BEHIND PERICH GRAND SLAM:

With runs in seven of the nine innings, the Frisco RoughRiders routed the Wichita Wind Surge 14-2 Friday night at Equity Bank Park to even the series at two games apiece. Frisco (33-34, 72-63) got the engine going early, plating a run in the first on a **Rafe Perich** RBI single against Riley Quick (0-3). Wichita (29-38, 53-80) responded to tie it 1-1 on a solo home run in the bottom of the first from Khadim Diaw. The third inning is when the Riders blew it open, scoring six times against Quick, including a 471-foot grand slam from Perich over the RoughRider bullpen in right field. Frisco added an RBI double from **Max Wagner** later in the inning. After the third, the Riders scored in each of the next four innings as well, putting three on the board in the sixth and a single run in the seventh on a booming home run from **Arturo Disla**. Ultimately, the Riders would score again in the ninth and plate 14 total runs and, in a bullpen game, surrendered just two runs on three hits behind strong nights from **Jonathan Brand**, **Kai Wynyard** (1-0) and **Brock Porter**, who picked up the four-inning save.

PARADE OF STARTING PITCHERS:

With **Jonathan Brand** making his first start of the season yesterday, he became the 24th starting pitcher of the season for the RoughRiders, the most in franchise history. The Riders used just 15 starting pitchers in 2025. RoughRiders' starting pitchers have a 5.75 ERA this season, ranking 29th out of 30 Double-A teams and the highest in recorded franchise history (since 2005).

GET RICH OR DIE DREILING:

RoughRiders outfielder **Dylan Dreiling** has been amazing recently. The No. 13 prospect is 2nd in the Texas League in batting average (.313), 4th in OPS (.899), 6th in RBIs (84), 2nd in hits (146), 4th in total bases (242) and 5th in runs (88). Over his last 48 games, he is batting .366 (75-for-205)/.415/.620/1.035 with 17 doubles, 11 home runs and 38 RBIs. His 22 homers are the most by a RoughRider since **Blaine Crim** in 2022 (24 home runs), the most by a centerfielder in franchise history and the most by a primary outfielder since **Mike Bianucci** hit 30 in 2011. On Sunday, he snapped a 25-game hitting streak, he is batting .407 (44-for-108)/.458/.667/1.125 with 10 doubles, 6 home runs, 24 RBIs and 22 runs scored. The streak was the longest in the Texas League this year (longest since Randy Cesar of Corpus Christi with a 42-game streak in 2018) and the longest by a RoughRider since 2012. **Jurickson Profar** had a 29-game hitting streak in 2012, the franchise record. In August, Dreiling led all of Minor League Baseball (min. 70 AB) with a .429 batting average, the best single month by batting average since 2005 in the Texas League since Drew Locke (CC) hit .446 in April of 2009.

THUNDER BUDDIES FOR LIFE:

Dylan Dreiling and **Max Wagner** have become the first pair of Riders teammates to have 20 or more home runs in the same season since 2012 when **Mike Olt** (28) and **Chris McGuiness** (23) accomplished the feat. It is the 4th time it has happened in franchise history, taking place in 2011 with **Mike Bianucci** (30) and **Tommy Mendonca** (25) as well as 2006 with **Nate Gold** (34) and **Kevin Mahar** (20). Wagner has the 2nd-fewest home runs per plate appearance in franchise history, among those who have 20 or more homers (.072), trailing just **Joey Gallo** (.072) in 2014.

'PEN USING ALL THE INK:

The RoughRiders used their bullpen a lot in August. Frisco bullpen arms threw a Double-A-leading 134.1 innings in August while owning the Texas League's 6th-best ERA (4.96) in the month. Frisco starters in the month had a league-worst 6.39 ERA. The bullpen's 5.1 innings per game is a recorded franchise record (since 2005) for any single month. Since July 29th, the Riders are 17-22 with 15 of their 17 wins coming when Frisco scored 6 runs or more while being 2-17 when scoring 5 runs or fewer.

THIS SHOWING IS IN IMAX:

Max Wagner has been hitting homers at a furious pace in 2026, setting his career high with 14 on August 11th (now 21 total). He reached 13 homers in 58 fewer games than 2023. His 16 home runs from the 8 and 9 spots in the order are the most in all of Minor League Baseball. Over his last 56 games, he is hitting .264 (51-for-193)/.340/.580/.920 with 17 home runs, 42 RBIs and 31 runs. Since June 20th, in those 56 games, he is T-3rd in the Texas League with 17 home runs.

TO THE WINDOW, TO THE WALCOTT:

Rangers No. 1 prospect **Sebastian Walcott** returned to the lineup following the All-Star Break after undergoing internal brace surgery on his right elbow in February. In his first 36 games this year, he hit .322 (48-for-149)/.399/.591/.990 with 13 doubles, 9 home runs, 20 RBIs, 17 walks, 11 stolen bases and 43 runs scored. After recording 34 extra-base hits in 124 games last year, he has 22 this year in 36 games, putting him on pace for 73 in 124 games, including 31 homers.

THIS OFFENSE HAS BEEN HISTORIC:

Through 135 games the RoughRiders are 1st in Double-A with 1,258 hits. They are 1st in Double-A in batting average (.272) and 2nd in runs (816, 6.0 runs per game). The RoughRiders have not led the Texas League in batting average since 2014. The Riders are 3rd in the Texas League in homers (180), 1st in doubles (257), 1st in SLG (.452) and 2nd in OPS (.810). They have already set franchise records in runs scored and home runs while they have the best OBP (.358), SLG and OPS in franchise history.

RIDERS ARE POSTSEASON BOUND:

The Riders clinched a playoff spot with a win on June 18th, capturing the Texas League South Division 1st Half. The Riders have now made the playoffs 11 times, their first berth since 2024, with two championships in 2004 and 2022. The Riders have now won the first half 9 times, their first since 2024. Frisco finished the first half 39-29 (.567). The Riders will take on Amarillo in the Division Series.

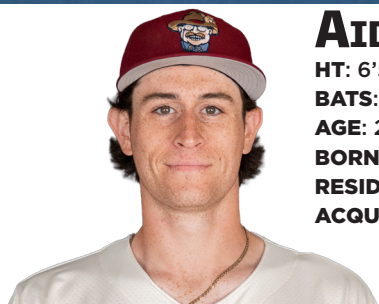

-One of five Rangers pitchers to be signed after the five-round 2020 Draft, including former RoughRiders Josh Stephen and Nick Krauth.

-Originally committed to Bucknell University.

-Was part of the 2017 Ossining Little League team that won the New York state championship and advanced to the Little League World Series.

2026 SEASON

-Before promotion, went 2-1 with 3.48 ERA in 7 starts with High-A Hub City. Struck out 42 in 31.0 IP to 18 walks.

-With Hub City, led South Atlantic League in fly ball rate (51.4%) and 11th in ERA (3.48).

-Tied a career high with 12 strikeouts at Corpus Christi on 7/7. Riders tied nine-inning franchise record with 18 on the night. Over a 2-start span, Curry with 23 strikeouts, the most in a 2-start span in his career.

-Made spot start for Triple-A Round Rock on 8/15, going 5.0 IP, 2 H, 1 R, 1 BB, 3 K

2025 SEASON

-Started the season with High-A Hub City, owning 4.72 ERA from 4/9-6/11 before spending short stint with ACL Rangers from 6/21-7/23. Returned to Hub City from 7/30-end of season, owning 3.00 ERA over 24.0 IP).

-116 K were 3rd among Texas farmhands and was his third-straight season with 100+ Ks.

-From 2023-25, Curry was 5th among all High-A and Low-A pitchers with 284.

CHAD COMER

Years with Rangers: 10

Years with RoughRiders: 2 (1st as manager)

Comer returns to Double-A Frisco in 2026 after managing at the High-A level over the last three seasons. The native of Mansfield, Texas will enter his 10th season with the Rangers and his second in Frisco.

In 2022, Comer helped pilot the Riders to their second Texas League Championship in franchise history, serving as a development coach. Over the last three seasons, Comer managed High-A Hickory (2023-2024) and High-A Hub City (2025), going 197-191 (.508).

Prior to Frisco, Comer was the hitting coach for the High-A Hickory Crawdads in 2021, after serving as a coach at various levels of the Rangers system from 2016-2019.

The former University of Texas at Arlington catcher played two seasons in the Atlanta Braves organization, reaching High-A Lynchburg in 2012. He was drafted by Atlanta in the 29th round of the 2011 draft after four seasons at UTA.

PITCHING COACH

THOMAS ST. CLAIR

Years with Rangers: 5

Years with RoughRiders: 1

St. Clair joins the Riders as the pitching coach after leading a Hub City staff that finished third in the SAL with a 3.50 ERA in 2025. St. Clair also will serve as the assistant pitching coordinator in the Rangers farm system in 2026.

Initially, St. Clair came to the Rangers as a coach in the Dominican Summer League in 2022 before serving as a pitching coach for the ACL Rangers from 2022-23. Before professional baseball, he spent two and a half years as pitching coach and recruiting coordinator at North Carolina Wesleyan College.

The right-hander pitched three professional seasons in the St. Louis Cardinals system from 2017-19 after he was picked in the 24th round of the 2017 June draft, making 88 outings for the organization's Rookie and Single-A affiliates.

The Winston-Salem, North Carolina native played four years (2014-17) at Division II Lenior-Rhyne University in Hickory, N.C.

HITTING COACH

JASON HART

Years with RoughRiders: 9

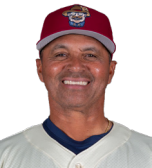
Hart returns as the hitting coach in Frisco for the first time since he served as the RoughRiders hitting coach from 2012-2019. Before that, most recently, he was the Major League hitting assistant for the Miami Marlins under current Rangers manager Skip Schumaker.

In 2015, Hart was named the Mike Coolbaugh Texas League Coach of the Year for his work with the Riders hitters. Prior to joining Frisco, Hart spent two seasons as the hitting coach with Low-A Hickory. His tenure with the Rangers began after he assisted the Single-A Clinton staff with coaching responsibilities for a portion of the 2008 season and continued when he accepted the role of hitting coach for the Arizona Rangers before the 2009 campaign.

Hart played professionally for parts of eight seasons from 1998-2006, with stints in the Oakland, Texas and Minnesota organizations. He made his Major League debut with the Rangers in 2002, when he batted .267 (4-for-15) with three doubles over a span of 10 games. He missed the 2004 campaign following the removal of a benign brain tumor, but returned to the field in 2005 and hit 21 home runs in 128 games with Frisco.

Originally drafted by Oakland in the fifth round of the 1998 draft, Hart was acquired by Texas in a January 2002 trade with the Athletics. He attended Southwest Missouri State University, where he paced the conference in homers in 1997 and was named a Missouri Valley Conference All-Star in 1998.

BENCH COACH

Hernandez joins the RoughRiders for his first season with the Rangers organization.

During 2020, Hernandez managed the Texas Collegiate League Frisco RoughRiders after the MiLB season had been canceled. In 2025, he served as a bench coach for Triple-A Jacksonville and spent 19 seasons with the Marlins as a coach and coordinator. As part of that stint, he served eight seasons as a manager, most recently in 2022 with High-A Beloit.

Hernandez started his coaching career at the University of Mobile in 1993 as a hitting coach and stayed there through 2001. From 2005-2006, Hernandez served as the hitting coach for the Independent Pensacola Pelicans.

DEVELOPMENT COACH

JAY SULLENGER

Sullenger joins the Riders in 2026 as the Development Coach. He made his professional managerial debut in 2021, leading the ACL Rangers.

Before joining the professional ranks, Sullenger led the baseball program as head coach at Biola University in La Mirada, California, from 2013-2018.

Additionally, he worked one season in stadium operations for the Tampa Bay Rays. Sullenger attended Spotswood (Va.) High School and went on to play baseball at Florida Southern College (one season) and Liberty University (three seasons).

He holds a bachelor's degree from Liberty and earned a master's degree in Kinesiology with a focus in Athletic Administration/Coaching from James Madison in 2003.

ATHLETIC TRAINER



KILEY BROWN

Brown makes his Double-A debut in 2026. Before being the athletic trainer for High-A Hub City in 2025, Brown was the ACL Rangers athletic trainer in 2024.

Brown was also a student athletic trainer at Slinger (Wisc.) High School (2022) and Carroll University in Waukesha, Wisc. (2021).

The Louisville, Ky. native holds an associate's degree in Biology (McHenry County College), a Bachelor's degree in Exercise Science (Upper Iowa University), and a Master's in Athletic Training (Carroll University).

STRENGTH AND CONDITIONING COACH



BRETT PLATTS

Platts is back with the RoughRiders for his third season and his fourth in the Rangers organization in 2026.

In his first year, he was the strength and conditioning coach for the Low-A Down East Wood Ducks before spending a season with the Cubs, working in the Dominican Summer League.
