Huge Home Tilt

The Fightin Phils remain home to finish the second to last home series of the regular season for a matchup against the Binghamton Rumble Ponies, Double-A affiliate of the New York Mets. Entering play today, Reading holds a 5.5 game lead over Binghamton in the Northeast Division Standings. It is the last-of-18 matchups between the teams this season and final-of-12 in Reading. Reading leads the season-series 9-8, as Reading has won eight-of-11 games after going 1-5 at Binghamton in early-June, when the teams first met.

Doubling Up on Wins

The Reading Fightin Phils swept Binghamton in Saturday's doubleheader, winning 5-3 in Game One and 3-0 in Game Two to extend their Eastern League Northeast Division lead to 3.5 games with 13 games remaining. Reading's magic number is now 10. Bryan Rincon homered in both games, including his Minor League Baseball-leading ninth leadoff homer of the season in Game One. Caleb Ricketts also homered and went 3-for-3, while Reading rallied for three runs in the fourth on walks, a hit batter and a wild pitch to take the lead for good. Jack Dallas earned the win and the bullpen combined for 3.2 scoreless innings. In Game Two, Luke Russo tossed five scoreless innings with six strikeouts, while Bryson Ware opened the scoring with an RBI double and Raider Tello added a two-run double in the sixth. Reading's defense also made several key plays, including Carson DeMartini's diving stop at third and Raylin Heredia's outfield assist. Wen-Hui Pan earned the save as the Fightins completed the sweep.

Magic Number: 10

With 13 games remaining in the 2026 regular season, the Fightin Phils hold a 3.5-game lead for first place in the Eastern League's Northeast Division. Somerset (3.5 GB), Portland (4.5 GB) and Binghamton (5.5 GB) are chasing Reading in the standings and the R-Phils have a chance to create some distance between them and the Rumble Ponies during this week's series. This marks the latest in the season that the Fightin Phils have been in first place since they finished the 2019 second half with a 41-31 record, which clinched the second half division title that season.

Heredia Keeps Hitting

With another base hit on Saturday, Raylin Heredia now has a team-high 140 hits this season, which ranks as tied for the most in the Eastern League. Heredia is the first Fightin Phil to surpass 140 hits in a season since Dylan Cozens had 144 base hits in 2016. Heredia also has a league-high 32 doubles on the season, which is tied for the 17th most in a single-season in Fightin phil's history. He is one-of-24 R-Phils to surpass 30 doubles in a season in franchise history.

Rincon Rakes

Bryan Rincon clubbed his 22nd home run of the season on Saturday night and his ninth leadoff homer of the year. Rincon has the most leadoff home runs across all of Minor League Baseball this season. This comes after Major League Baseball announced last Monday that he was named Eastern League Player of the Week. Over six games at Portland last week, Rincon slashed .429/.484/.786 (1.270 OPS), along with eight runs, four doubles, two home runs and four RBI.

20-20-20 Club

The Fightin Phils now have two players in the exclusive 20-20-20 club in Bryan Rincon and Raylin Heredia. Entering play on Saturday, Rincon has 23 doubles, 22 home runs and 26 stolen bases. Raylin Heredia joins Rincon in the club with 32 doubles, 21 home runs and 23 stolen bases. The duo is one-of-three players in the Eastern League to have more than 20 home runs, 20 doubles and 20 stolen bases, while they are one-of-six in Double-A and one-of-25 in all of Minor League Baseball to be in the 20-20-20 club.

Hammering Homers

After hitting two home runs on Saturday, the Fightin Phils are third in the Eastern League with 156 homers this season. In 2025, Reading clubbed 118, so they are 38 clear of last year's total, with 13 games to play. The R-Phils are on pace 172 home runs this season, which would be their most since hitting a team record 185 home runs in 2016.

One Year Turnaround

Entering play on Sunday, the Fightin Phils are 63-61 and surpassed .500 for their full-season record on Saturday, which is the latest in a season the R-Phils would be over .500 since the end of the 2019 season, which was also the last time Reading made the postseason. The Fightin Phils are now eight wins over their win total from 2025 (55) and have surpassed their win total from 2023 and '24 (59). With 63 wins, Reading has now won its most games in a single season since winning 80 games in 2019.

This Day in Baseballtown History

August 30, 2006: At Reading, Brian Sellier's walk-off homer on the first pitch in bottom of the 7th inning gives the Phils a 3-2 win and a double-header split with New Britain. After watching the games, Baseballtown legend "Broadway" Charlie Wagner quietly passes away in the stadium parking lot at the age of 93.

Rumbling Into Baseballtown

Binghamton enters play today with a 55-70 overall record and 28-28 mark in the second half, which is 5.5 games behind Reading in the Northeast Division Standings. The Rumble Ponies most recently took five-of-six games from Altoona at home last week, and following this week, they return home to host New Hampshire. Binghamton's roster features eight of the New York Mets top-30 prospects: Jefferson Rojas (1), Mitch Voit (4), Jacob Reimer (7), Gary Gill Hill (17), Chris Suero (18), Gabe Davis (23), Luke Gabrysh (28) and RJ Gordon (30).

Ponies Pitcher

Righty, and Mets' No. 23 prospect, Gabe Davis makes his fourth appearance with Binghamton and 14th Double-A outing in 2026. Between Winston Salem (A+), Birmingham (AA) and Binghamton, Davis is 1-5, with a 5.35 ERA (43 ER, 72.1 IP), along with 84 strikeouts. Davis last pitched on Aug. 23 against Altoona, earning the win over four innings of relief, while allowing no-earned runs and striking out seven. He was traded from the White Sox to the Mets on Aug. 3, along with Zach Franklin, in a deal that sent Huascar Brazoban to Chicago. The 22-year old was drafted in the fifth round of the 2025 draft by the White Sox out of Oklahoma State.
