#### By the Numbers

The Captains are tied for the Midwest League lead and rank T-10<sup>th</sup> in High-A with 31 HR this season. <u>Lake County has hit 13 HR in 14 games against Great Lakes this year.</u>

In 2 starts against Great Lakes this year, LHP **Jackson Humphries**, today's Captains starting pitcher, has held Loons
hitters to a .095 AVG. The 20-year-old has limited Great Lakes to
just 2 H in a combined 7 innings of work.

Lake County leads MiLB and MLB with 44 R in the 7th inning this year. This includes a 6-run 7th frame on Saturday night in an eventual 7-6 defeat.

MORE 7<sup>TH</sup> INNING SUCCESS: After trailing 5-0 through 6 innings, the Captains took the lead with 6 runs in the top of the 7<sup>th</sup>. Lake County's 6 runs were courtesy of a pair of a pair of 2-run singles from 1B Ralphy Velazquez, MLB Pipeline's No. 6 Cleveland prospect, and RF Wuilfredo Antunez, a bases-loaded HBP from C Jacob Cozart, MLB Pipeline's No. 15 Cleveland prospect, and Cozart eventually scoring on a wild pritch. The Captains have outscored opponents 44-11 in the 7<sup>th</sup> inning this season, and their 44 R in the 7<sup>th</sup> inning are the most across MiLB and MLB this year.

RALPHY RAKES: 1B Ralphy Velazquez, MLB Pipeline's No. 6 Cleveland prospect, recorded a double and a 2-run single on Saturday night. The 19-year-old has now tallied 6 XBH and 10 RBI over his last 6 games, and is 1 of just 3 Midwest League players with these marks during this span (also John Michael Faile (DAY) and Gabriel Gonzalez (CR)).

**DEFEND THE 'SHIP:** This season, the Captains are ooking to win back-to-back Midwest League Championships. Lake County will look to record the 7th instance of a franchise winning consecutive MWL titles.

#### TRENDS & NOTABLES

KNAPCZYK'S ON FIRE: INF Christian Knapczyk has become one of the Midwest League's premier hitters to begin his High-A career. The 2023 5th-round pick out of Louisville leads the Midwest League in OPS (.953), while ranking top-5 in: OBP (.441, 2nd), AVG (.331, 3rd), H (40, T-4th), and SLG (.512, 5th). He also ranks 7th in TB (62). So far this month, Knapczyk ranks T-1st in the Midwest League in H (21), 2nd in AVG (.389). The 23-year-old is also currently on a 10-game hitting streak, batting .385 with a 1.042 OPS during this span.

JOSE'S HOT START: After winning the 2024 Midwest League Championship with Lake County, INF Jose Devers has excelled early to begin the 2025 campaign. The Samana, DR native leads the Midwest League with 21 XBH and 15 2B, while ranking 5th in TB (64) and just outside of the top-10 in HR (5, T-11th). After hitting 7 HR in 102 games with the Captains last year, Devers already has 5 HR in his first 36 games this season.

RALPHY'S POWERFUL BAT: 1B/LF Ralphy Velazquez, MLB Pipeline's No. 6 Cleveland prospect, ranks T-2nd in the Midwest League lead with 6 HR, while ranking just outside of the top-10 in RBI (23, T-11th), XBH (14, T-11th), and R (22, T-11th).

ALFONSIN'S AWESOME OFFENSE: OF Alfonsin Rosario, MLB Pipeline's No. 25 Cleveland prospect, has had a strong start to his High-A career, The 20-year-old ranks T-3rd in the Midwest League with a .515 SLG and just outside of the top-10 in HR (5, T-11th) and OPS (.866, 12th), while batting .287 in his first 26 High-A games. Rosario was the only Single-A player with 15+ HR, 70+ RBI, and 20+ SB last year with Single-A Myrtle Beach (CHC).

JASIAK'S SHUTDOWN STRETCH: RHP Jack Jasiak is off to an impressive start to begin his High-A career. The 2022 12th-round pick out of South Florida has yet to allow an earned run in his first 10 appearances for Lake County, logging a 0.00 ERA over 19.2 innings during this span. Jasiak is the only Milb/MLB pitcher with 19.2+ IP, 2-orfewer BB, and a 0.00 ERA so far this season.

SANTOS SAILING IN ON HISTORY: On Jan. 30, it was announced that Manager Omir Santos would return for his 3<sup>rd</sup> season as Lake County's skipper. *He is now the longest-tenured manager in Captains history*, and 1 of just 2 to win a championship for Lake County (Ted Kubiak, 2010). With a 162-135 (.545) record at the helm, *Santos is 9 victories away from becoming the winningest manager in Captains history*.



### **BIO**

**Mokoro** (wears #43) enters her first season as Lake County's Bat Dog, and first season with the Guardians organization. The 1-year-old Chocolate Labrador Retriever is owned and trained by **Victoria Brody**. **Brody** is a professional dog trainer who started Mission Empawthy, LLC, a local dog training company which focuses on specializing in psychiatric service dogs for those whose disabilities aren't always visible. **Mokoro will retrieve bats** and balls for the Captains alongside Brody at all Thursday home games this season!

**Mokoro** is named after a type of dugout canoe found in Botswana. These vessels, which usually carry 1-2 passengers, are commonly used to navigate the Okavango Delta for both transport and game viewing safaris. While mekoro (plural form of "mokoro") used to primarily be made from Jackalberry, Mangosteen, and Sausage trees, they are now mainly made from fiberglass.

LAST TIME OUT: LHP Jackson Humphries (ND) did not record a decision in an eventual 6-2 home victory over Quad Cities back on Sunday, May 11. The southpaw pitched 3.2 innings, allowing just 2 hits, 1 earned run, and a season-high 4 walks (tied), while throwing 5 strikeouts in 71 pitches (40 strikes). **Humphries**' lone run allowed scored on a sac fly double play in the top of the 4<sup>th</sup> inning.

TOP 15 PROSPECT: Humphries is Cleveland's No. 14 prospect according to Keith Law of The Athletic. Law on Humphries: "Humphries developed a stomach ailment early in the 2024 season and it affected him all year. He was 88-90 much of the season when he was more 90-94 the year before and can be 92-95 at full strength. He comes from a high three-quarters slot with huge break and tilt on the slider, needing to work on his changeup and generally on getting to a consistent release point. He might be a breakout candidate for this year if he gets all his strength back."

TOP 20 PROSPECT: Humphries is MLB Pipeline's No. 17 Cleveland prospect. MLB Pipeline on Humphries: "When he's at full strength, Humphries shows the potential for three plus pitches. His fastball can operate at 92-95 mph and touch 97 with sink and run, and he can show a pair of high-spin breaking balls, an upper-70s curve with quality depth and a sharp low-80s slider. Even his fade low-80s changeup has the upside to become a solid offering."

WORK HORSE: In 2024 with Single-A Lynchburg, Humphries ranked T-2<sup>nd</sup> in the Carolina League with 23 games started and finished 4th on the Hillcats in innings pitched with 79.0. His 97 strikeouts on the year were also tied for the team lead.

JULY GUY: Last July, Humphries had his best month of professional baseball to date. Posting a 1.69 ERA during this span, Humphries allowed just 3 runs over 16.0 innings pitched. He was just 1 of 6 Carolina League pitchers to strike out 20 or more batters in the month (min. 15 IP). His 1.06 WHIP during July was also good for 2<sup>nd</sup> on Lynchburg and 12<sup>th</sup> in the Carolina League for the month.

FRESH START: In 2024 with Single-A Lynchburg, Humphries battled an illness he pitched through. Despite losing nearly 20 pounds of body weight, he was still effective, striking out 29.1% of batters faced. Humphries was just 1 of 12 starters in the Carolina League last year to boast a K/9 of 11 or higher (min. 78 IP). With a fastball set to be in the mid-90s, Humphries is eyeing a fully healthy year of continued production striking out batters.

STATE CHAMP: A former high school standout at Fuguay-Varina HS (NC), Humphries was a highly sought-after MLB Draft prospect following a state championship run in his junior season in 2021. That year, **Humphries** posted a perfect 5-0 record and a 1.46 ERA, and was the starter in the winner-takeall Game 3 of the 2021 NCHSAA 4A State Championship. He went 4.2 innings, struck out 6, and allowed 1 run en route to a 12-1 win over Reagan, crowning Humphries a North Carolina State Champion. As a senior the following year, he worked a 1.55 ERA across 40.2 innings pitched, striking out 89.
