**LAST TIME OUT:** Wilmington clinched a series victory over Brooklyn by way of a 3-2 victory...OF **Omar De Los Santos** provided the Cyclones' offense with a go-ahead two-run home run in the top of the second inning that came off the bat at 110 mph and traveled an estimated 421 feet...The Blue Rocks took the lead for good in the fifth on an RBI single by SS **Vandel Peña** and a run-scoring double from 3B **Murphy Stehly**...SS **Wilfredo Lara** and RF **Karell Paz** each tallied multi-hit games for Brooklyn...RHPs **Victor Castañeda** (0.2 IP) and **Luis G. Moreno** (2.0) combined to toss 2.2 innings of hitless relief, walking one and striking out four...The two-hour and three-minute contest was the Cyclones' shortest nine-inning game of the season.

**THIS DATE IN CYCLONES' HISTORY:** On July 14, 2001, the Cyclones played their first game against their cross-borough rival the Staten Island Yankees...With **Tsuyoshi Shinjo** suited up as the first Major League rehabber in franchise history, Brooklyn beats Staten Island on the road, 3-1...A special ferry is used to shuttle passengers from Coney Island to Staten Island...In 2004, the Cyclones' stretch of 113 consecutive sellouts, which started on July 3, 2001, came to an end in the second game of a day-night doubleheader when 6,464 fans came out to then-KeySpan Park...In 2011, RHP **Eduardo Aldama** (5.0 IP, 8 K), LHP **Jack Leathersich** (1.0; 2), RHP **José De La Torre** (2.0, 4), and RHP **Hunter Carnevale** (1.0, 1) combined to strike out 15 batters and a three-hit shutout in a 2-0 win vs. Auburn...In 2018, OF **Walter Rasquin** stole the 34th base of his Brooklyn career to set the franchise's all-time record...Rasquin's mark stood until 2023 when it was surpassed by UT **Jaylen Palmer**...LHP **Jason Vargas** struck out 10 over 6.0 innings in a Major League rehab start in the Cyclones' 5-3 win vs. Williamsport.

**SPROUT THE GOAT:** RHP **Brandon Sproat** — who started the season in the Brooklyn Cyclones rotation — represented the New York Mets in Saturday's Sirius/XM All-Star Futures Game at Globe Life Park in Arlington, Texas...He tossed a scoreless third inning allowing only one baserunner on an error and hitting 99 mph with his fastball...The 23-year-old made six appearances (five starts) for Brooklyn, registering a 2-1 record with a 1.07 ERA (3 ER in 25.1 IP), 16 walks (15.7 BB%), and 33 strikeouts (32.4 K%)...Since joining Double-A Binghamton on May 13, Sproat has continued his dominance, posting a 4-0 mark with a 2.05 ERA (11 ER in 48.1 IP), 12 walks (6.7 BB%), and 52 strikeouts (29.2 K%)...The 2023 second-round pick was the first player to play for Brooklyn and appear in the Futures Game in the same season since **C Francisco Alvarez** and INF **Brett Baty** in 2021.

**'TALK 2 'EM:** RHP **Kade Morris** has started to find his stride at the High-A level...Since his start on June 21 vs. Jersey Shore, the 22-year-old holds a 2-1 record with a sparkling 1.85 ERA (5 ER in 24.1 IP) in four appearances (three starts)...He has yielded just 15 hits and 10 walks (10.2 BB%) while striking out 21 (21.4 K%)...Since June 20, Morris and RHP **Jonah Tong** have been two of the best arms in the South Atlantic League...In that span, Tong is second in the circuit in ERA (0.82) and Morris (1.85) is sixth...Additionally, Kade is third in innings pitched (24.1), fourth in batting average against (.174), and seventh in WHIP (1.03)...Since making his SAL debut on May 22, Morris is third in the league in innings pitched (48.0), fourth in batting average against (.219), sixth in WHIP (1.21), and eighth in ERA (3.56).

**THE TONG SONG:** RHP **Jonah Tong** has been magnificent for the Cyclones in the last few weeks...Over his last four starts since June 20, the 21-year-old is 2-1 with an 0.82 ERA (2 ER in 22.0 IP), allowing only eight hits and six walks (7.40 BB%), while striking out 32 (39.51 K%)...Since making his South Atlantic League debut on May 2, the Markham, Ont. native has led the circuit in strikeouts (70)...He is also second in ERA (2.85), WHIP (1.14), and batting average against (.189), and eighth in innings pitched (53.2)...Tong has been as good as any pitcher in Minor League Baseball this year, tossing 26.0 consecutive innings without allowing an earned run to start the season...Among full-season Minor Leaguers with at least 70.0 innings of work, the Markham, Ont. native is second in FIP (2.11), fourth in strikeout rate (36.1%), fifth in strikeout-to-walk rate (26.5%), and seventh in strikeouts (106).

**TAKING KELLUM 123:** OF **Kellum Clark** snapped out a 1-for-37 funk at the plate with a three-hit game last Saturday at Hudson Valley and has been on a tear offensively since...The 23-year-old had a four-game multi-hit streak snapped on Saturday, during which he went 9-for-14 (.643) with three runs scored, a double, an RBI, and two walks during the streak...Clark had just one multi-hit game in the first 48 contests of his career before the four-game multi-hit streak...In nine games during the month of July, the Brandon, Miss. native is hitting .357/.486/.393 with a .379 OPS...His .486 on-base percentage is sixth in the South Atlantic League during the month.

**TRAVELING CIRCUS:** Starting with the June 25 game in Aberdeen, the Cyclones have just six home games in 28 days...Brooklyn's next full six-game home series will take place from July 23-28 vs. Rome...So far, Brooklyn is 5-12 in the stretch...The Cyclones played three games at home vs. Hudson Valley from July 1-3 and will play another three vs. Jersey Shore from July 19-21 immediately following the All-Star break...The stretch also includes a 12-day run without a day off (June 25-July 6), the longest of the season for Brooklyn.

**WIZARD OF PAZ:** OF **Karell Paz** is in the midst of one of his best offensive stretches of the 2024 season...Since clubbing a go-ahead two-run home run in the ninth inning on June 30 at Aberdeen, the 24-year-old is hitting .353/.421/.529 with a .950 OPS in 11 games...Paz has scored four runs and picked up three doubles, a home run, five runs batted in, four walks, and six stolen bases.

**vs. WILMINGTON:** After a two-day break, Brooklyn travels south for a six-game series against the Nationals' High-A affiliate...The Blue Rocks boast three of Washington's top 30 prospects per MLB Pipeline: RHP **Jarlin Susana** (10), OF **Jeremy De La Rosa** (23), and INF **T.J. White** (25)...The Cyclones took 4-of-6 from Wilmington in the first meeting on Coney Island (April 23-28), but the Blue Rocks swept the season-opening series at Frawley Stadium (April 5-7) winning the last two games in walk-off fashion...Brooklyn was 9-9 at home and 7-5 on the road against the 'Rocks in the 2023 for a 16-14 record...Since 2021, the Cyclones are 47-47 all-time against Wilmington (.500).

**MORABITO FUEL:** OF **Nick Morabito** has been outstanding throughout the 2024 season...The 21-year-old is tied for 11th in Minor League Baseball in stolen bases (37)...Since making his SAL debut on May 7, Morabito is tied for fourth in the circuit in hits (60), tied for fourth in stolen bases (26), and tied for eighth in runs scored (37)...On the year, the former second-round selection is tied for ninth in the SAL in stolen bases (26)...The 21-year-old leads all full-season Mets farmhands in batting average (.305) and stolen bases (37)...He is also second in hits (91), on-base percentage (.403), and runs scored (51) and tied for fourth in triples (4).

**OMAR-I-GONE:** OF **Omar De Los Santos** rejoined Brooklyn's roster on June 24 from Double-A Binghamton...Despite spending a month at Double-A, De Los Santos is still tied for fourth in the South Atlantic League with 31 stolen bases...The Santo Domingo, D.R. native set Brooklyn's single-season stolen base record (37) in 2023 and broke UT **Jaylen Palmer's** (50) all-time franchise mark for stolen bases (68) earlier this season on May 2 vs. Aberdeen...Since the start of the 2022 season, De Los Santos has led the South Atlantic League (68) and is fifth across Minor League Baseball in swiped bags (140).

**ZILCH, ZERO, NADA:** RHPs **Kodai Senga** (2.2 IP) and **Kade Morris** (6.1) combined on a four-hit shutout, as the Cyclones blanked the Renegades, 4-0, last Wednesday...A night before, RHPs **Jonah Tong** (5.0 IP), **Ben Simon** (3.0), and **Jake Stevenson** (1.0) combined on a two-hitter in a 7-0 triumph vs. Hudson Valley...Cyclones pitching threw 201 consecutive scoreless innings between OF **Garrett Martin's** solo home run in the eighth inning on July 1 and DH **Omar Martínez's** three-run blast in the first inning on July 4...Brooklyn's longest scoreless stretch of the year is 23.2 frames from June 1-5 at Jersey Shore and vs. Aberdeen...Brooklyn has thrown consecutive shutouts three times this season...The Cyclones blanked the IronBirds, 2-0 and 4-0, on May 3 and 4 at Maimonides Park...The Cyclones then earned 7-0 and 3-0 wins at Jersey Shore and vs. Aberdeen, respectively...Brooklyn now has 10 shutouts, the second most by a South Atlantic League pitching staff in 2024 trailing only Rome (13)...It is also tied for sixth most throughout Minor League Baseball...The Cyclones' single-season shutout record is 11 set during the 2023 campaign.

**LOCATION, LOCATION:** The Cyclones have several players with intriguing home and road splits in 2024...OF **Nick Morabito** loves his time on the road...He is hitting .299/.384/.396 with a .780 OPS, adding two home runs, nine RBI, and 24 stolen bases in 35 road contests...He is eighth in the circuit in road batting average (.299) and, since his SAL debut, the 21-year-old has had the most road hits (43) and stolen bases (24) in the circuit...In Brooklyn, Morabito has collected a .224/.289/.250 line with a .539 OPS, two extra-base hits, two RBI, and two stolen bases over 18 games...INF **Junior Tilién** has thrived at Maimonides Park, posting a .309/.366/.455 mark with a .821 OPS, three home runs, and 14 RBI in 31 games...On the road, Tilién is hitting .169/.272/.243 with a .515 OPS, a home run, and nine runs batted in over 38 contests...C **Chris Suero** is hitting .250/.418/.442 with a .860 OPS, three home runs, and 11 RBI in 16 games on Coney Island...The 20-year-old is batting .174/.292/.257 with a .549 OPS, a home run, and 14 RBI in 32 affairs in visiting ballparks.

**LARRUPIN' LORUSSO:** INF **Nick Lorusso** was transferred to Double-A Binghamton on Wednesday...During his time in the South Atlantic League, the 23-year-old was tied for eighth in total bases (123), ninth in walks (40), and 10th in OPS (.834)...Lorusso also dominated at Maimonides Park...The former Maryland Terrapin hit .367/.444/.661 with a 1.105 OPS in 30 contests on Coney Island...Lorusso led the SAL in home batting average (.367) and on-base percentage (.444) while trailing only Greenville OF **Brayan González** in slugging (.661) and OPS (1.105)...The Connecticut native is the 12th Cyclone to join the Rumble Ponies in 2024.

**ONE-TWO MISSTEP:** The Cyclones have struggled in games decided by one or two runs...Brooklyn is 5-15 in one-run games and 5-6 in two-run games for a combined record of 10-21 (32.3)...The Cyclones hold a record 29-26 (.527) in games decided by three runs or more.

**WALK-OFF WOES:** Brooklyn's 3-2 loss at Wilmington on Friday night marked the team's seventh walk-off defeat of the season...Since the start of the 2023 season, the Cyclones have suffered 17 walk-off losses, accumulating 15.32% of all defeats...Brooklyn has one walk-off win this year on **Nick Lorusso's** game-winning home run in the bottom of the ninth vs. Asheville on April 14.

**AMAZIN' STARTS HERE:** The Brooklyn Cyclones have several Top 30 prospects according to *Baseball America* and MLB Pipeline...The 'Clones have five of the Top 30 per BA: INF **Jesús Báez** (9), RHP **Jonah Tong** (15), RHP **Kade Morris** (23), RHP **Jack Wenninger** (26), and **Calvin Ziegler** (29)...Báez is currently on the 7-day injured list and Ziegler is on the full-season injured list...Plus five of the Top 30 per MLB: Tong (20), Báez (22), Ziegler (23), **Wilfredo Lara** (24), and OF **Nick Morabito** (26).

**LAST TIME OUT:** Pitched in relief on Tuesday night at Wilmington...Entered in support of RHP **Jack Wenninger** with a runner at second base and two out in the bottom of the fifth and Brooklyn trailing 4-2...Inherited runner scored...Did not allow a run on one hit over 3.1 innings...Walked two and struck out two...Plunked a batter...Induced a double play...Threw 47 pitches and 28 strikes (59.57%)...Finished out the contest for the Cyclones in Brooklyn's 5-3 loss to the Blue Rocks.

**CHANGE OF PLANS:** Pintaro's final start for the Pioneer League's Glacier Range Riders (Kalispell, Mont.) was cut short due to great news...The 26-year-old tossed 2.0 innings of one-run ball against the Great Falls Voyagers on June 2 before being told by manager **Paul Fletcher** that he would not continue...Pintaro's day came to a close because his contract had been purchased by the New York Mets, officially signing the following day..."It was surreal. After the second inning I came to the dug-out and I heard him (Fletcher) say somebody get warm and I kind of gave him a look," said Pintaro to the *Daily Inter Lake*...In three starts for the Range Riders, Pintaro was 1-0 with a 4.40 ERA (7 ER in 14.1 IP), one walk, and 23 strikeouts...The Pelham, Ala. native had a 14.44 strikeouts-per-nine innings ratio in the MLB Partner circuit...Pintaro was teammates with 2024 BlueClaws INF **Chad Castillo** with the Range Riders.

**REMEMBER ME?:** Following the 2021 and 2022 collegiate seasons, Pintaro pitched for the Frederick (Md.) Keys of the MLB Draft League...During that time, the 26-year-old was a teammate of a few current and former Cyclones...In 2021, Pintaro pitched alongside RHP **Dylan Tebrake**, who was a member of the 2023 bullpen and is currently on Double-A Binghamton's 60-day injured list...During the 2022 season, the Shorter University alum was a teammate of RHP **Jordan Geber** (2023-24) who is currently with Double-A Binghamton and current Cyclones RHP **Jonah Tong**...In 25 games (17 starts) for the Keys, Pintaro was 3-9 with a 4.55 ERA (44 ER in 87.0 IP), 41 walks, and 108 strikeouts.

**SHORTER STACK:** Pintaro became the first Shorter University alum to sign a contract with a Major League team since becoming an NCAA program in 2013...During his time with the Hawks, the Alabama native was Gulf South Conference Pitcher of the Year in 2021 and 2022...Pintaro accumulated a 20-7 record with a 3.19 ERA (70 ER in 197.1 IP), 76 walks, and 286 strikeouts during those two seasons...Shorter is located in Rome, Ga. and its campus is located 3.7 miles southwest of the Rome Emperors' AdventHealth Stadium.
