SHUCKERS NEWS & NOTES

RUN OF A LIFETIME: C/1B Wes Clarke smashed his fourth home run over the last three games on Thursday night with a solo shot, going back-to-back with INF/OF Isaac Collins.

- Clarke has eight home runs since the All-Star Break, the most out of any player in Double-A... He currently is hitting a home run once every 7.6 at-bats, the eight-best mark out of all players in MLB and MiLB since the All-Star Break... Eight of his 16 hits since the break have been home runs.
- Clarke's 17 home runs lead the Shuckers and are a new career-high... It's the most Clarke's hit in any college or pro season since he hit 23 during the 2021 season with the University of South Carolina, tied for the NCAA DI lead.

<u>THIS OFFENSE IS ON FIRE</u>: Since the All-Star Break, the Shuckers have won 14 of their last 18 games, the best record out of any team in Double-A.

- Since the All-Star Break, the Shuckers have scored 146 runs, an average of 8.1 per game... The Shuckers have scored at least six runs in 16 games over that span, and have tallied at least 10 hits in 12 games... Their 146 runs are the most out of any team in Minor League Baseball.
- The Shuckers enter today with 557 runs this season, the fourth-most in Double-A.

MEET MR. ROBINSON: After a scoreless ninth on Thursday, RHP Cam Robinson enters today with eight saves in 2023, the most out of any player on the Shuckers and tied for the fourth most out of any pitcher in the Southern League.

Since July 6, Robinson has tallied eight scoreless outings in his last nine, including an active 5.2 inning scoreless streak, his longest of the year... His five saves over that span are tied for the most in Double-A.

CHOURIO'S MULTI-HIT MADNESS: OF Jackson Chourio has tallied multiple hits in 14 of his last 19 games, including doing so in five of his last six games... Chourio's 33 multi-hit performances are more than anyone else on the Shuckers', and he's the only player with at least 20.

- Chourio enters today with 69 RBI, the second-most in the Southern League... He enters today tied for the third-most in a season in franchise history (since 2015), and five away from the franchise record of 74, set by **OF Corey Ray** in 2018.
- Chourio is the first teenager to tally at least 15 home runs in a season in the high minors since INF Fernando Tatis Jr. did so in 2018 with the Double-A San Antonio Missions... Six players have reached the mark since 2005... Chourio is the first since OF Giancarlo Stanton in 2006 to hit at least 16 as a teenager in Double-A.
- Chourio enters today four home runs away from becoming the first teenager to record a 20/20 season in the high minors since OF Delmon Young reached the mark with the Montgomery Biscuits in 2005.

TODAY'S STARTER // RHP_CARLOS RODRIGUEZ (6-3, 2.64): After being named the Southern League Pitcher of the Month for July on Thursday, RHP Carlos Rodriguez makes his 19th start of the year... Rodriguez earned the first monthly award of his career after a 0.98 ERA over four starts and 18.1 innings in July... He enters today among the Double-A leaders in opponent's average (1st, .181), ERA (2nd, 2.64), WHIP (6th, 1.14) and strikeouts (8th, 114)... Rodriguez has allowed two runs or less in each of his last eight starts, a 1.22 ERA, the second-lowest in Double-A over that span.
