# **SOUTHPAW STUD**

## **Brycen Mautz cleans up Texas League Awards**


Springfield Cardinals LHP Brycen Mautz has been on a roll in the Texas League all season, but certainly over the last several weeks. Minor League Baseball named him the Pitcher of the Month for July on August 6 and then immediately handed him another award just days later when he was named Pitcher of the Week on August 11.

Mautz is the first Cardinals pitcher to be given the Pitcher of the Month award this season and just the fourth all-time to win this specific designation (MiLB began naming both a Player and Pitcher of the Month in 2021). It's the first of his career. The Pitcher of the Week award is his second this season and fourth of his career.

In July, Mautz made five starts and never allowed more than one run in any one outing. The southpaw led the Texas League in WHIP at 0.91 and strikeouts per nine at 10.96. In two separate outings, he came within one strikeout shy of matching a season-high (nine) on July 1 against Northwest Arkansas and July 22 at Tulsa. His 1.57 ERA was the best monthly ERA he's had in his professional career and the only sub-two mark he's put up.

The lefty's start on Friday, August 8 in San Antonio, TX was one of the best of his career. Mautz racked up a season-high ten strikeouts across six shutout innings. He surrendered just one hit and walked two as the Cardinals won 2-0. It was just the third time in his career in which he reached double-digit strikeouts in an outing. Thanks to the award-winning performance, his ERA dropped to 2.99 through 84.1 IP (19 starts). At the time, his 99 total strikeouts this season were tied for the fifth-most in all of the Texas League.

The 24-year-old is in his third season in the St. Louis organization after a 2022 second-round selection out of the University of San Diego. The former Torrero was offered a walk-on spot on the University's baseball team where he eventually parlayed that into the 59th overall selection by St. Louis. The lefty features a four-seam and two-seam fastball, changeup, slider, curveball, cutter and newly added gyro slider. He is currently ranked as the 19th best prospect in the St. Louis system by MLB Pipeline. He entered 2025 outside of the publication's famed Top-30 list.





# 2025 Coaching Staff



## **Patrick Anderson** - *Manager*

After three seasons as manager of the Peoria Chiefs (A+), Anderson will now become the eighth-ever manager in Springfield Cardinals history. Anderson, who calls nearby Columbia, MO home, previously spent seven years in the Nationals organization (2013-19) as manager with the Single-A Hagerstown Suns (2014-19) and Gulf Coast League Nationals (2013). Across ten Minor League managerial seasons, he holds a 661-619 record and a 2013 Gulf Coast League Championship.

Anderson played collegiately at Mars Hill (NC) University and played three years of Independent League Baseball. He brings a wealth of experience to Springfield, as he began coaching in 1996 as an assistant with Gannon (PA) University. He also spent time at Hofstra University as an assistant coach (1999-2001) and head coach (2009-11). Inbetween his college coaching were coaching positions in the Royals organization in the GCL (2001), Midwest League (2002-06), Pioneer League (2007) and Appalachian League (2008).



## **Eric Peterson** - *Pitching Coach*

Eric Peterson returns for his third season as Springfield's Pitching Coach after guiding a staff last year that featured the Minor League Pitcher of the Year Quinn Mathews and Texas League Pitcher of the Year Tink Hence in 2024. Under his leadership, the 2024 Springfield pitching staff set a franchise record 1,279 strikeouts. The Bear, DE native played college baseball at Temple University for two seasons before transferring to North Carolina State University. He was drafted in the 37th round of the 2014 MLB Draft by the Houston Astros and suited up for the Corpus Christi Hooks in the Texas League during the 2016 and 2017 campaigns.



## **Casey Chenoweth** - *Hitting Coach*

Casey Chenoweth enters his third season in the Cardinals organization after spending the 2024 season in Springfield and the 2023 campaign with High-A Peoria, both as hitting coach. The 2025 season will mark his second with Springfield. The Tollhouse, CA native previously spent three years from 2020-22 as the assistant hitting coordinator for the Arizona Diamondbacks and two seasons from 2018-19 as a minor league hitting coach in the San Francisco Giants system. An infielder at East Central University in Ada, OK, Chenoweth played one season of professional baseball in 2017 for the East Side Diamond Hoppers of the United Shore League.



## **Danny Black** - *Coach*

Danny Black is a newcomer to the Springfield Cardinals. A former utility player with six seasons of experience in the Florida/Miami system. He spent the 2023 and 2024 seasons as a Defensive coach with Double-A Pensacola. He began his coaching career in 2018 and has served in various coaching roles since in the Marlins system.



## **Alex Wolfinger** - *Athletic Trainer*

Alex Wolfinger joined the St. Louis Cardinals organization in 2018, spanning five different levels including Double-A. The 2025 season marks his fourth consecutive with Springfield. He was named the Texas League Athletic Trainer of the Year in 2023 while with Springfield. Wolfinger earned his Bachelor's degree at Neumann University and his Masters at the University of Memphis.



## **Ryan Duffy** - *Strength and Conditioning Coach*

Ryan Duffy joined Springfield in 2024 after spending two seasons with the Peoria Chiefs (High-A) of the Midwest League (2022, 2023). This is his fourth year in professional sports and his second with the Springfield Cardinals.



## **Hunter Broadbent** - *Affiliate Fellow*

The 2025 season marks Hunter Broadbent's first in the St. Louis Cardinals organization and his second in affiliated baseball. He spent the 2024 season working for the New York Mets in a similar role with the Double-A Binghamton Rumble Ponies. Broadbent is a 2023 graduate of the University of Connecticut where he worked with the university's baseball program as a Director of Baseball Development and Analytics.
