✳ **HOMERIN' YAKS:** Salem's bats have come alive as of late. The RidgeYaks slugged 16 home runs during their 12-game road trip, and after **Kleyver Salazar** went yard Sunday, Salem has now hit 19 home runs over its last 15 games. The RidgeYaks have homered in each of their last seven games, launching 11 long balls during that span. The RidgeYaks' longest home run streak of the season came from April 10-18, when they homered in eight consecutive games

✳ **ANDUJAR, FERMIN, PINTO & PRIMERA LEADING THE WAY:** **Louis Andujar**, **Anderson Fermin**, **Avinson Pinto**, and **Franklin Primera** have fueled Salem's offense so far this homestand. The quartet is a combined 17-for-38 (.447) with 10 extra-base hits, two home runs, and 18 RBI in just two games played against Delmarva. All four bats were out of the lineup on Sunday in the series finale. The rest of the RidgeYaks lineup is just 18-for-69 (.260) with nine extra-base hits, one home run, and five RBI this homestand

✳ **13 GAME SUCCESS:** Salem has won nine of its last 13 games dating back to July 2. Over that span, the RidgeYaks rank second in Single-A with a .300 batting average and lead all of Single-A baseball with 140 hits and rank third with 99 runs scored during that stretch. Salem also possesses a Carolina League best 57 extra-base over the last 13 games

✳ **ANDUJAR BREAKS THROUGH:** After recording just one RBI, one stolen base, and batting .095 through his first 20 games in Single-A Salem, INF **Louis Andujar** has flipped it into gear over the last three weeks. Over his last 14 games since June 27, Andujar is hitting .357 (20-for-56) with 16 RBI, three homers, and a 1.083 OPS. Andujar has recorded a hit in 11 of his last 14 games after collecting hits in just five of his first 20 games

✳ **WELCOME TO SALEM:** Friday night, catcher **Franklin Primera** made his home debut for Salem and went 4-for-4 with four runs scores. The backstop followed that up by belting his first home run in Single-A baseball with a sixth inning moon shot on Saturday night

✳ **DELZINE ARRIVES:** After leading the FCL Red Sox in wins (4), innings pitched (39.2), strikeouts (43), ERA (2.72), and WHIP (1.07), **Sadbiel Delzine** earned a promotion to Single-A Salem on July 20. Ranked as the No. 17 prospect in the Red Sox organization by MLB Pipeline, Delzine becomes just the second Top 30 Boston prospect to suit up for Salem this season, joining Eddy Azocar. At just 18 years old, Delzine is the third-youngest active player in the Carolina League:

✳ **FERMIN FINDING HIS WAYS:** **Anderson Fermin** is another Salem bat that's been on fire as of late. The outfielder from Puerto Plata, Dominican Republic, is hitting a Carolina League best .526 (10-for-19) over his last seven games since July 6, collecting 10 RBI, three extra-base hits, and a team-leading 1.346 OPS during that span. The switch-hitter is back for his first full season of Single-A ball and has recorded a hit in each of his last four games

✳ **SALAZAR STAYING HOT:** Catcher **Kleyver Salazar** has recorded a hit in 13 of his last 17 games dating back to June 19. Over his last six games since July 6, he's batting an impressive .458 with eight RBI and an 1.219 OPS. The recent surge comes after Salazar hit a season-best .281 across 13 games during the month of June

✳ **PINTO'S STREAK:** Infielder **Avinson Pinto** has reached base safely in each of his last 15 games dating back to June 23. During that stretch, Pinto is batting .315 (17-for-54) with eight RBI, 10 walks, and a team-leading .431 on-base percentage. Overall, since May 29, Pinto has reached base in 29 of his last 33 games played

# YAK FACTS



## BY THE NUMBERS

- ALL ABOUT THE YOUTH: With the promotion of 18-year-old **Sadbiel Delzine**, Salem's roster now features eight teenagers and boasts the second-youngest active roster in the Carolina League with an average age of 20.89 years:

- GUZMAN GOES YARD ..... AGAIN: Catcher **Adonys Guzman** went yard three times over the roadtrip. Through 29 Single-A games, Guzman has recorded a hit in 21 contests. Over his last 12 games since June 24, he's batting a team best .324 (12-for-37) with seven extra-base hits, four home runs, 11 RBI, and a 1.156 OPS since June 24
- THE STRIKEOUT STAFF: After 89 games this season, Salem pitchers have combined to strike out 906 batters, good for the second-most in the Carolina League. The only team with more punchouts is the Hill City Howlers (914). In total, Salem is averaging 10.18 strikeouts per game
- MAGIC NUMBER TEN: The pitching staff has struck out double-digit batters on 54 occasions this season (61% of all games), including 22 of the last 30 games since June 11
- STARTING STRONG: Salem's success this season has often started on the mound. The RidgeYaks are 17-9 when their starting pitcher records at least 14 outs (4.2 innings). Over the 24 games of the second half, Salem is 6-2 when any pitcher goes more than four innings
- SCHEDULE OUTLOOK: Salem's schedule becomes significantly more favorable in the second half. After facing the league's top four clubs, Fredericksburg, Charleston, Hickory, and Wilson, a combined 45 times during the first half (69% of games), the RidgeYaks will see those teams just six more times the rest of the season (all against Wilson, August 18-23). Salem will also play each of its next 12 games against South Division opponents and 24 of its final 42 contests against teams at or below .500 after facing only 20 such opponents in the first half
- BIG GAMES AHEAD: Salem is battling in the North division with Fayetteville and Wilson. Both teams Salem will see later this season. The RidgeYaks will meet the Woodpeckers 12 more times this season, six at Carillon Clinic Field from August 4-9 and six at Segra Stadium on August 25-30. The Yaks also face the Wilson Warbirds for six games at home on August 18-23. In total 18 of Salem's 26 total games in August will come against those two teams
- WELCOME THE GREENJACKETS: Tonight Augusta and Salem meet for the first time at Carillon Clinic Field since June 23, 2024. Last year Salem only played at Augusta but the Yaks and Jackets have each won a series outright in the only two series ever played in Salem

## WHAT IS A RIDGEYAK

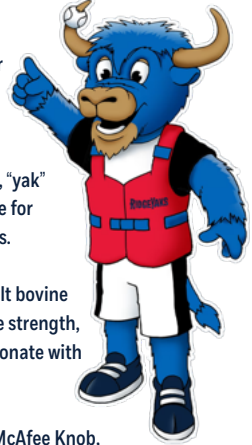
The name "RidgeYaks" is a creative and symbolic reflection of the Southwest Virginia community and carries a double meaning:

**Ridge:** A tribute to the scenic Blue Ridge Mountains that tower beyond the outfield wall at Salem Memorial Ballpark, a nod to the beautiful, rugged landscape that defines the region.

**Yak:** The name carries two layers of local-flavor meaning. First, "yak" plays off the slang for kayak, a subtle salute to the region's love for kayaking and other outdoor recreation on the area's waterways.

A Yak is also a real animal. The Yak is a long-haired, heavily built bovine native to high-altitude mountains. The Yak comes to symbolize strength, resilience, stability, and a hardworking spirit, qualities that resonate with both the team and the broader Salem community.

The new mascot, named **Mac the Yak**, takes inspiration from McAfee Knob, one of the region's most iconic natural landmarks, linking the team's identity not only to athletic grit, but to local heritage, outdoor adventure, and mountain pride.

- Was the seventh SEC pitcher that the Red Sox drafted through the first nine rounds, including his LSU teammate and third-round pick Anthony Eyanson
- Finished the 2025 season pitching for the State College Spikes in the MLB Draft League, tossing 6.1 innings with 12 strikeouts and a 1.42 ERA
- Attended Nicholls State University for two years, working primarily as a starter, before transferring to LSU for the 2025 season
- Had his best performance as a freshman and was named National Freshman Pitcher of the Year by both Collegiate Baseball and the NCBWA
- Came to LSU as the No. 17 transfer portal prospect per Baseball America. He hails from Gonzales, LA, and played prep baseball at St. Amant High School
- Earned a College World Series relief win vs. Arkansas on June 18, striking out the final two Razorback hitters in the top of the ninth
- Ranked third in the NCAA in hits per nine (4.97) and 15th in strikeouts per nine (13.50), posting a 5-1 record with a 4.58 ERA in 70.2 innings as a sophomore at Nicholls State in 2023
- Was selected as part of Boston's 2026 Spring Breakout Roster
- As a senior with LSU last year, posted a 2-0 record with a 4.80 ERA in 17 relief appearances last season apart of the 2025 National Champion run for the Tigers
- Will start a third straight outing, after going 3.2 innings last week at Columbia

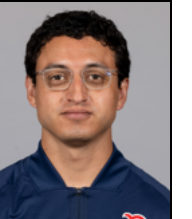

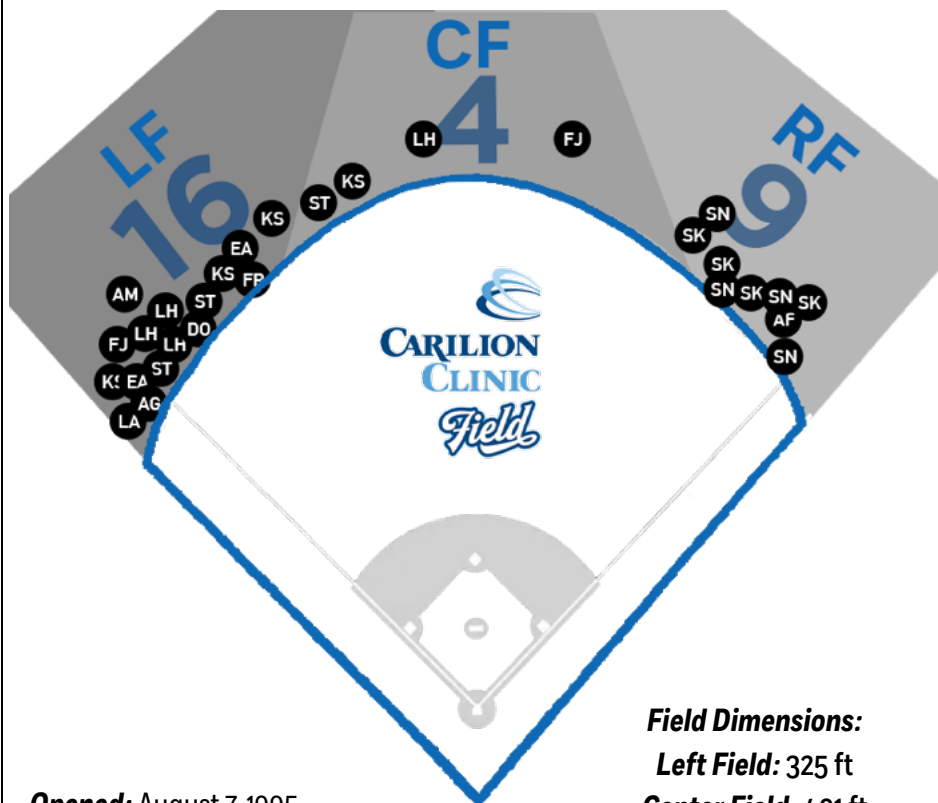

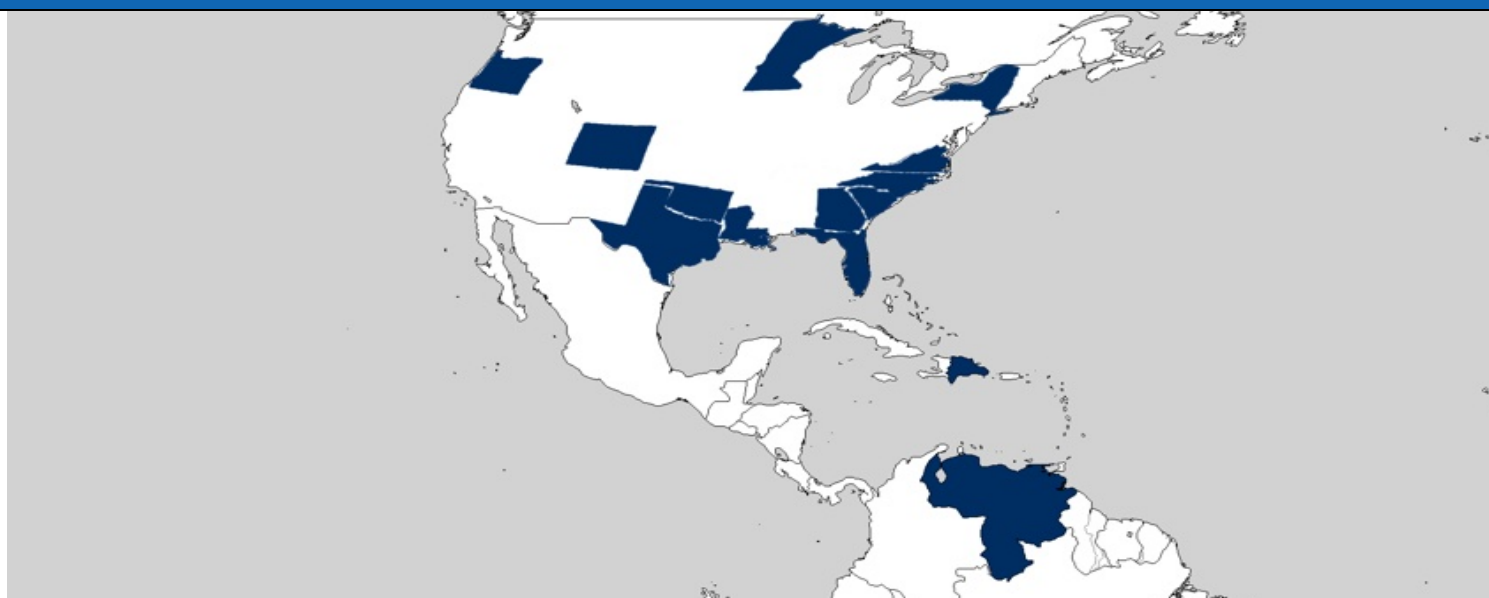
