RHP TANNER GORDON (1-2, 6.12) vs. LHP Justin Wrobleski (NR)

TODAY'S GAME: The Isotopes hold a 3-1 series advantage after claiming a 4-3 victory last night over Oklahoma City ... Tanner Gorodn is slated to take the hill for Albuquerque while Justin Wrobleski is scheduled to make his Triple-A debut for Oklahoma

SERIES LEAD: Albuquerque holds a 3-1 series lead for the first time since Sept. 15, 2023 at El Paso. The Isotopes went on to win the final two contests of that set.

FREAKY FRIDAY: The Isotopes won on a Friday for the first time this season, snapping a 12-week losing streak. Their last Friday triumph had been Sept. 22, 2023 vs. Oklahoma City.

ONE-RUN GAMES: The Isotopes improved to 6-13 in contests decided by one run. Tonight was their first one-run victory that did not result in a walk-off since April 4 at Oklahoma City, a 5-4

DUBS: Albuquerque has won five of its last six contests and seven of nine, the most wins in a nine game stretch all season.

DINGERS: Albuquerque has belted a homer in nine-straight contests, setting a new team-high for 2024 (previous: eight, May 7-15 ... During current stretch they've hit 18 homers compared to 18 during previous stretch.

VS. OKLAHOMA CITY: All seven of Albuquerque's wins over Oklahoma City in 2024 have been decided by three runs or fewer.

BRICKTOWN: Dating back to July 5, 2023, Albuquerque has won 13 of their last 21 games at Chickasaw Bricktown Ballpark. Five of the eight losses during the stretch came during their visit to Oklahoma City in early April of this year.

FOUR OR FEWER: The Isotopes won a game for the first time in 2024 scoring four runs or fewer.

OUTHIT: For the fourth time in 2024, the Isotopes won in spite of behing out-hit. All occurrences have come against Oklahoma City (also: April 4, April 28, June 1).

ATTENDANCE: Over 39 home openings, the Isotopes have tallied the fifth-highest total attendance in all of Minor League Baseball and the second-most in the Pacific Coast League (256,334). Highest: Lehigh Valley, 280, 619.

BACK-TO-BACK: The Isotopes are in search of back-to-back series wins for the first time since Aug. 15-27, 2023, against El Paso (4-2) and Oklahoma Clty (5-1).

REAL SLIM SCHUNKY: Aaron Schunk went 2-for-4 last night with a double, his 22nd multi-hit game of the season. Schunk is 15-for-41 with four doubles, a triple, two homers and nine RBI over his last 10 contests, with five multi-hit performances during the stretch. ... His 24 doubles are 4th-most in all of MiLB.

STOVIE: Hunter Stovall extended his hit streak to seven games. During stretch, he is 11-for-28 with four doubles, two homers and six RBI ... The third-longest active streak in the PCL.

JC: Julio Carreras saw his season-best seven-game hit streak end last night with an 0-for-4 evening. During the stretch, Carreras was 11-for-26 with three doubles. ... Swiped his 20th bag of the season Wednesday, establishing a new career high.

MR. VANDY: Connor Kaiser produced his first double last night since doing so in back-to-back games May 7-9 at El Paso. Last night was his second game with multiple runs batted in this season (also: June 13 vs. El Paso).

COOLIN' OFF: From April 21-May 18, Drew Romo slashed .450/.459/.725 with eight doubles, four homers, 20 RBI ... Since, over 21 games, hitting .171 (14x82).

BIG WILLIE STYLE: Willie MacIver launched his third homer in his last six contests yesterday. Last night was his fourth game with multiple extra-base hits (also: March 31 vs. El Paso, May 26 at Salt Lake, June 12 vs. El Paso). Four of MacIver's 10 home runs at the Triple-A level have been hit at Chickasaw Bricktown

SAVES: Albuquerque has recorded a save in back-to-back contests for the second time in 2024. Matt Carasiti closed out victories over Sugar Land (May 19) and Salt Lake (May 21).

COOKIE: Matt Koch recorded the 10th save of his professional career last night, and the third featuring more than three outs (also: May 26, 2023, vs. RR and Sept. 16, 2016, vs. COL.

PCL LEADERBOARD: Drew Romo is 6th in average (.305) Aaron Schunk is 2nd in doubles (24) and T-6th in XBH (32) Coco Montes is 1st in average (335), 2nd in hits (85), 3rd in OPS (.965), T-3rd in triples (6), 4th in OBP (.414), 5th in slugging (.551), T-5th in total bases (140), T-9th in XBH (31) and RBI (47) and T-10th in walks (37) ... Julio Carreras is 6th in SB (20).

NUCLEI NOTES

SKIPPER: Pedro Lopez enters his 20th year as a minor league manager and second guiding the Isotopes, the eighth manager in club history ... Spent 2021 as Albuquerque's hitting coach and 2022 as its bench coach ... Notched his 1,000th career managerial victory June 4, 2023 at Salt Lake, 7-1. Managed in the Texas Rangers (2001-05, 2007) and New York Mets (2011-19) organizations while claiming the 2014 Eastern League Championship with Double-A Binghamton. Lopez was drafted in the 21st round by the San Diego Padres in the 1988 MLB Draft and spent 13 years in the minor leagues, reaching Triple-A on four occasions.

HOMETOWN KID: Jordan Pacheco begins his third season as the Isotopes hitting coach ... An Albuquerque native and 2004 graduate of La Cueva High School, Pacheco then attended the University of New Mexico (2005-07), where he was one of the most prolific offensive players in school history (.384, 59 2B, 25 HR, 145 RBI) ... Drafted by Rockies in the 9th round in 2007 and made his MLB debut with Colorado in 2011.

CHRIS MICHALAK: Begins his second season as Isotopes pitching coach ... Pitched for the Albuquerque Dukes in 2000, followed by stints with the Isotopes in 2004 and 2008 ... Started second-to-last game in Dukes history, giving up two runs in 6.0 innings during Game 4 of a PCL First Round playoff series at Memphis Sept. 9, 2000 ... Appeared in 61 Major League games (24 starts) over five season with the Arizona Diamondbacks (1998), Toronto Blue Jays (2001) Texas Rangers (2001-02) and Cincinnati Reds (2006) ... 12th round selection by the Athletics in 1993 ... Has been in the coaching ranks since 2009, including stops as the pitching coach for the Hagerstown Suns (2010-11), Potomac Nationals (2012-13) and Harrisburg Senators (2014-17). He was also the Minor League pitching coordinator for the Miami Marlins form 2018-20 and coached in the Washington Nationals organization from 2021-22.

MICHAEL RYAN: Enters his first year with the Rockies organization as the Isotopes bench coach ... It's his second stop in Albuquerque after the former outfielder played in 33 games for the club and hit nine homers during the 2008 campaign. He and Michalak were teammates on that squad for four days in late July ... Entered the coaching ranks in 2012 as a coach for the Double-A Altoona Curve (Pirates). He then managed in the Pirates organization at three levels for seven seasons with stops at Single-A West Virginia (2013-14), High-A Bradenton (2015-16) and Double-A Altoona (2017-19), while winning the Florida State League in 2016 and Eastern League in 2017. Ryan compiled a 221-197 managerial record with Altoona—the most wins for a manager in Curve history ... He also managed in the Cubs organization (High-A South Bend, 2021 and Double-A Tennessee, 2022-June 2023) ... A 5th round draft pick by the Minnesota Twins in 1996, played in 149 MLB games over parts of five seasons with the Twins (2002-05) and Angels (2010) ... Last Angels player to wear 27 prior to Mike Trout's call-up in 2011.

SPLIT-SEASON PLAYOFF FORMAT: For the second-straight year, the Pacific Coast League will use a split-season format to determine playoff participants. With one 10 team division, the first half winner (concluding June 23) will host the second half winner (beginning June 25) in a three-game set. The winner will then face the International League champion for the Triple-A Championship in Las Vegas, NV, Sept. 28.

BALLS AND STRIKES: The Automated Ball-Strike System (ABS), now in its third year in the Pacific Coast League, will be used for all Monday-Thursday games while the Challenge System, second year in the PCL, will be used for all Friday-Sunday contests. Each team has three challenges per game, retaining one for each successful challenge.
