### LAST GAME

The Baysox dropped their series finale to the Somerset Patriots by a 6-5 final on Sunday evening. The game remained scoreless through its opening four-and-a-half frames until Aaron Palensky gave Somerset a 2-0 lead on a two-run home run. Bowie quickly canceled out that edge in the top of the sixth on a two-run single by Greg Cullen, before Anthony Servideo doubled Cullen home later in the frame to give the Baysox a 3-2 lead. The game continued its back-and-forth nature with the Patriots retaking the lead in the bottom half of the frame on a double by Jeisson Rosario and a balk, before Donta' Williams gave Bowie a 5-4 lead in the top of the eighth on his two-run home run. The lead, however, would be short-lived, with Somerset plating a pair on a ground ball out that was thrown away by Jacob Teter tying to throw out the tying run at home plate, allowing the go-ahead run to also score on the play, as a quiet top of the ninth sealed the defeat for the Baysox.

### TODAY'S OPPONENT

The Portland Sea Dogs enter the series with a record of 56-40. The Double-A affiliate of the Boston Red Sox, Portland is 16-11 in the second half - a half-game behind first-half champion Somerset in the Northeast division standings. The Sea Dogs have the third-highest team average (.246) in the Eastern League, while also wreaking havoc on the base paths with the most steals (177) and the third-most efficient rate (79%) when stealing in the league. Defensively, Portland has the league's second-highest fielding percentage (.980). The Sea Dogs' roster is highlighted by seven of the Top 30 Red Sox prospects (via MLB Pipeline), including IF Marcelo Mayer (No. 1 BOS / No. OVR), IF Nick Yorke (No. 3 BOS / No. OVR), IF Blaze Jordan (No. 10 BOS), C Nathan Hickey (No. 15 BOS), IF Chase Meidroth (No. 19 BOS), and RHP Jacob Webb (No. 24 BOS).

### TODAY'S OPPOSING STARTER

Right-hander Isaac Coffey is projected to open the series on the mound for Portland. Coffey has won four of his first five starts at the Double-A level, allowing just eight runs in 23.1 innings, despite holding a WHIP of 1.33. He last pitched on 7/19, and missing a turn in the rotation with a stint on the development list. In his last action, the right-hander fired five shutout innings against New Hampshire with just four hits allowed, striking out a Double-A career-best 10 batters in the process. Coffey opened the season with High-A Greenville, posting a 2.83 ERA in 60.1 innings before getting the call up to Portland on 6/20. A 10th round pick of the Red Sox in 2022 out of Oral Roberts University, Coffey features a high-80s fastball, high-70s slider, and low-mid-80s changeup, all from a sidearm release.

### AVOIDING THE TRAFFIC

While the Baysox sit with the fourth-most home runs in the Eastern League at 102, Bowie has struggled with the timeliness of its long balls. The Baysox have hit the third-most solo shots in the league at 61 total. However, in terms of portions, 59.8% of Bowie's home runs have been solo blasts. That is the highest portion of any team in the Eastern League.

### ONE RUN REBOUND

Despite dropping two of three one-run contests in Somerset this past week, the Baysox have still turned a corner in one-run games this season. Bowie has only lost two of its last nine games decided by a single run. Dating back to June 2, the Baysox have fared incredibly well in one-run games, going 13-5. Bowie is 19-14 overall in games decided by one run in 2023, after going just 21-29 last season, giving them the most one-run losses in Minor League Baseball in 2022, along with the second-lowest winning percentage in the Eastern League in such games.

### SECOND HALF SLUMP

Bowie's offense has struggled to maintain consistency in the second half of the season thus far. The Baysox are hitting just .208 as a team since the start of the second half of the Eastern League season on June 28 - the third-lowest team average in Minor League Baseball since that date. In that same frame, Bowie is hitting .175 with runners in scoring position - the second-lowest such average in Minor League Baseball.

### TRENDING IN THE RIGHT DIRECTION

Bowie's struggles at home this season have been noted. The Baysox are one of just four teams in the Eastern League with a losing record at their home ballpark this season (23-28) and only two teams hold a lower winning percentage (.451) in home contests. However, lately Bowie has bucked that trend. The Baysox have won three of their previous four series at home entering this week, going 13-9 in that stretch. This comes after Bowie failed to win its opening five home series of the season, while only securing a split on one occasion.

### RUNNING RAMPANT

Bowie has struggled at maintaining the running game of the opposition this season. Baysox catchers have caught only 14.8% of attempted base stealers this season - the second-lowest rate in the Eastern League. Meanwhile, the Sea Dogs lead the Eastern League in stolen bases (177), while converting at the third-highest rate (79%) in the league.

## CAREER NOTES

- .206 opposing average was fifth lowest in the South Atlantic League at promotion.
- 2022: Ninth-most innings, sixth-most starts and tenth-most strikeouts among the Orioles' system.
- Had a very up-and-down season. Began by surrendering 20 ER in 29 innings through April and May
- Bounced back with a 1.35 ERA in June. Allowed 13 ER across 18.2 innings in July, followed up by allowing just 3 ER in his final 24 innings of the season, including a 0.90 ERA in August.
- Struck out 11 in five, one run innings on August 18 vs Asheville – one of four outings with 8+ strikeouts last season.
- Made two starts for Aberdeen in the 2022 postseason, where he allowed four runs across 9.2 innings.
- Spent the first half of 2021 with the then-GCL Orioles. Accumulated a 1.80 ERA in 20 innings with 28 strikeouts to just four walks, before being promoted to Single-A Delmarva on July 27. Had a 2.51 ERA in Single-A after nine appearances which amassed to 46.2 innings. Won Low-A East League Pitcher of the Month in August with a 1.35 ERA.
- Began his professional career in 2019, starting three games for the DSL Angels, where he allowed three earned runs in 12 innings.
- Originally signed by the Angels out of Venezuela in 2019.

Johnson's playing career most recently landed him in independent ball this past season with the Kane County Cougars. Johnson also played two seasons collegiately at Florida State.	Forrest Herrmann joins the Bowie Baysox coaching staff in his second season with the Orioles organization. He served as the pitching coach of the Aberdeen Iron-Birds during the 2022 season, helping Aberdeen clinch a first-half division title and make it all the way to game three of the South Atlantic League Championship Series. Herrmann guided one of the best staffs in the SAL last season, which led the league in strikeouts. Prior to joining the Orioles organization, Herrmann spent two seasons as a pitching coach within the Cincinnati Reds organization.
