### CAPTAINS LOG

**LAST TIME OUT:** Lake County's 3-run 5<sup>th</sup> inning anchored its 5-1 victory vs. West Michigan on Friday night in a 2 hour, 20 minute game in front of 4,568 fans at Classic Auto Group Park in Eastlake. This was the Captains' shortest 9-inning game so far this season.

Lake County scored its runs in the 3<sup>rd</sup>, 4<sup>th</sup>, and 5<sup>th</sup> frames. In the bottom of the 3<sup>rd</sup>, **C.J. Kayfus** (MLB Pipeline's No. 28 CLE prospect) roped an RBI double, and CF **Jonah Advincula** hit a 2-out RBI single 1 inning later.

Then, 3B **Nate Furman** led off the bottom of the 5<sup>th</sup> with his 2<sup>nd</sup> home run of the series and team-best 7<sup>th</sup> long ball of the year. **Kayfus** singled two at-bats later, and scored on a balk by Whitecaps reliever Gabe Sequeira. C **Johnny Tincher** plated the Captains' final run of the game later in the frame with a 2-out RBI single.

Despite allowing a solo home run in the top of the 7<sup>th</sup>, LHP **Steve Hajjar**, RHP **Jay Driver**, and RHP **Zach Jacobs** tossed the final 4 innings in relief.

**MESSICK'S MASTERFUL OUTING:** LHP **Parker Messick** (MLB Pipeline's No. 21 CLE prospect) earned his 3<sup>rd</sup> victory of the season, tossing 6 shutout innings with a season-high 10 strikeouts. This marked Lake County's first 10-strikeout performance since he fanned 10 on 8/18/2023 vs Peoria.

**INGLE IGNITES:** C **Cooper Ingle** is heating up, batting .545 (6-for-11) with 2 doubles and 3 walks this series. **Ingle's .643 OBP is tied with teammate C.J. Kayfus for the best in the MWL this week.**

**JAKE RAKES:** CF **Jake Fox** is batting .357 (5-for-14) with a team-high 7 RBI in the series against West Michigan. **Fox's 7 RBI are tied for 2<sup>nd</sup>-most in the MWL during that span.**

**DOMINANT DENHOLM:** **Trenton Denholm's 8.1 innings pitched on Wednesday are the most by a Lake County pitcher since RHP Joe Colon also pitched 8.1 frames on 5/14/2022 vs. Great Lakes.** Denholm is the first Captain since at least 2005 to throw 8+ innings without recording a strikeout.

**2024 VERSUS WEST MICHIGAN:** Lake County leads the season series 9-4 through 13 games. The Captains took 2 of 3 games from April 6-7 at home and won 5 of 6 contests from April 23-28. **Lake County is 9-1 in games that follow a West Michigan series-opening win.**

**2-OUT HITTING:** As a team, the Captains have hit .358 with 19 hits and 9 RBI with 2 outs so far this series. **Lake County's .289 AVG with 2 outs this season ranks 2<sup>nd</sup> across Minor and League Baseball, trailing only the Single-A Modesto Nuts' (SEA). .292 mark.**

**21<sup>ST</sup> SEASON OF CAPTAINS BASEBALL:** 2024 marks the 21<sup>st</sup> season of Captains Baseball. After the Columbus RedStixx were purchased in 2003, they were moved to Eastlake and became the Lake County Captains. In 2,777 regular-season games, Lake County has an all-time record of 1,397-1,380 (.503).

**WINNING WAVES:** The Captains have had a winning record in 13 of their first 20 seasons, including in each of their last four campaigns. Lake County has made 7 playoff appearances in franchise history (5 Midwest League, 2 South Atlantic League), with its 2010 Midwest League Championship being its sole title in franchise history.

### TRENDS & NOTABLES

**A KWAN-FORGETTABLE WEEKEND:** Cleveland Guardians OF **Steven Kwan** will make a rehab assignment Saturday and Sunday for the Captains, his first action since being moved to the 10-day injured list with a left hamstring strain. **At the time of his injury, Kwan led the American League with a .353 AVG and 47 hits.**

**ALL ABOARD THE TUGBOAT:** On Tuesday, Cleveland announced the promotion of Single-A Lynchburg LHP Matt "Tugboat" Wilkinson to Lake County. **Wilkinson, a 10<sup>th</sup> round pick in 2023 out of Central Arizona College (JUCO), leads Minor League Baseball with 71 strikeouts, while ranking 6<sup>th</sup> with a 0.77 WHIP and 8<sup>th</sup> with a 1.12 ERA through 8 starts with Single-A Lynchburg.** The Vancouver, B.C. native fanned a season-high 15 batters on April 25 versus the Myrtle Beach Pelicans (Single-A, CHC) in 6 scoreless, hitless innings. According to MiLB.com's Jesus Cano, **Wilkinson became the 5<sup>th</sup> MiLB pitcher since 2005 with 15+ strikeouts without allowing a hit.**

**YOU MAY BE RIGHT, GUY'S MAY BE CRAZY:** But it just may be a **Lipscomb** that you're looking for. With a single on Friday, **Captains OF Guy Lipscomb is 2<sup>nd</sup> in the Midwest League with both a .482 OBP and .408 AVG in the month of May.** He has reached base in 17 of 18 games played this month.

**FURMANATION:** Lake County INF **Nate Furman** extended his hitting streak to 12 games in Friday night's win vs. West Michigan, trailing only Beloit INF Josh Zamora (12 games) for the longest active streak in the Midwest League. Furman is the only player in the MWL with multiple hitting streaks of 10+ games this season. **He is batting .529 (27-for-51) with 6 home runs and 14 RBI during this streak.**

**TOP QUALITY:** Through 43 games, Lake County starting pitchers have recorded 14 quality starts (6+ IP, 3-or-fewer earned runs), which are the most in High-A and tied for 5<sup>th</sup> in MiLB. RHPs **Austin Peterson (5), Trenton Denholm (4), Carter Spivey (3)** and LHP **Parker Messick**, MLB Pipeline's No. 21 Cleveland prospect (2) have recorded quality starts.

**STRONG STARTING PITCHING:** Lake County's starting pitching staff has been one of the premier units in the Midwest League so far this season. The group ranks top-4 in the Midwest League in: wins (15, 1<sup>st</sup>), fewest walks (50, 1<sup>st</sup>), innings pitched (210.0, 2<sup>nd</sup>), strikeouts (199, T-3<sup>rd</sup>), and WHIP (1.23, 4<sup>th</sup>).

**WELCOME TO RAKE COUNTY:** Captains hitters have been having a strong season at the plate so far this season. The team ranks top-3 in the Midwest League in: AVG (.269, 1<sup>st</sup>), OBP (.360, 1<sup>st</sup>), OPS (.763, 1<sup>st</sup>), hits (388, 2<sup>nd</sup>), fewest strikeouts (318, 2<sup>nd</sup>), SLG (.403, 3<sup>rd</sup>), and walks (190, T-3<sup>rd</sup>). **The Captains' .269 AVG, .360 OBP, and .763 OPS lead all of High-A.**

LAST TIME OUT: As a member of the Single-A Lynchburg Hillcats, LHP Matt "Tugboat" Wilkinson suffered his 1st career Minor League loss on Sunday, May 19 versus Delmarva (Single-A, BAL). The left-hander pitched 5 innings, allowing 3 hits, 1 earned run, and no walks, while throwing 8 strikeouts in 79 pitches (51 strikes). Wilkinson's lone run allowed in the 2-1 defeat was courtesy of a 2-out RBI bunt single in the 4th inning.

MINOR LEAGUE RANKS: Wilkinson has been one of the premier pitchers in Minor League Baseball so far this season. The 21-year-old leads all of MiLB with 71 strikeouts, while ranking 6th in WHIP (0.77) and 8th in ERA (1.12). Tonight marks Wilkinson's High-A debut.

ALL ABOARD THE TUGBOAT: Wilkinson has held the nickname "Tugboat" from a young age. His father's best friend growing up, Phil McNeil, gave Matt the nickname, "after seeing Wilkinson run around the bases at a pace he thought was similar to that of the boat designed to tow larger vessels," MLB.com's Rob Terranova wrote. "I love it, I love being called Tugboat," he said to Terranova. "But I don't want people to forget that I'm Matt Wilkinson, too."

TOP 30 PROSPECT: Wilkinson is Cleveland's No. 30 prospect according to Baseball America. Per Baseball America, "Wilkinson gets bushels of whiffs thanks to a flat-plane fastball that has solid life, even if it sits 89-90 mph regularly, making it well below average in velocity. He also spots a fringe-average high-70s slider and mid-70s changeup. Everything plays up thanks to his plus control." His scouting grades are as follows: Fastball = 40, Slider = 45, Changeup = 45, and Control = 60.

A START FOR THE AGES: On April 25, Wilkinson made Minor League Baseball history in his start against the Myrtle Beach Pelicans (Single-A, CHC). The left-hander pitched 6 scoreless, hitless innings, allowing just 1 walk and throwing 15 strikeouts in 82 pitches (56 strikes). According to MiLB.com's Jesus Cano, Wilkinson became the 5th MiLB pitcher since 2005 to record at least 15 strikeouts without allowing a hit. The MLB pitchers to do this are Hall-of-Famer Warren Spahn (1960), 1971 NL All-Star Don Wilson (1967), Hall-of-Famer Nolan Ryan (3 times), 3-time NL Cy Young Award winner Clayton Kershaw (2014, whom Wilkinson said was his favorite player at the 2015 Little League World Series), and 3-time Cy Young Award winner Max Scherzer (2015).

PITCHER OF THE MONTH: Wilkinson was named the Carolina League Pitcher of the Month for the month of April as a member of the Single-A Lynchburg Hillcats. In 4 starts, he went 2-0 with a 0.44 ERA, a Minor League-best 41 strikeouts, and a Minor League-best .091 opposing batting average. Wilkinson also allowed just 6 hits and 6 walks in 20.2 innings of work.

VALIANT VAQUERO: After initially committing to the University of Washington, Wilkinson pitched collegiately at Central Arizona College (JUCO). In 2 seasons, the left-hander went 15-4 with a 1.38 ERA, 221 strikeouts, and just 34 walks in 35 appearances (17 starts). In 2023, the Ladner, British Columbia native went 10-2 with a 1.07 ERA, 136 strikeouts, a 0.73 WHIP, and 2 complete games in 16 appearances (14 starts). Wilkinson was named the 2023 NJCAA Division I Pitcher of the Year, a 2023 NJCAA 1st Team All-American, the 2023 ABCA/Rawlings Pitcher of the Year, and the Arizona Community College Athletic Association Pitcher of the Year. He was also part of the 2022 Central Arizona squad that won the 2022 NJCAA Division I Baseball World Series. Following his 2023 campaign, Wilkinson eventually chose to forgo his commitment to Arizona State after being selected by the Cleveland Guardians in the 10th round of the 2023 MLB Draft.

LITTLE LEAGUE LEGEND: When he was 12 years old, Wilkinson had a remarkable performance at the 2015 Little League World Series as a member of Team Canada. In his only start, he pitched 5 scoreless innings against Team Mexico, allowing just 2 hits and throwing 16 strikeouts in a 1-0 defeat. "(The LLWS) was definitely a cool experience, it was like a dream come true," Wilkinson told The Daily Sentinel's James Burky. "It felt like more than a game for the first couple of weeks. Leading up to the tournament, you had to do ESPN interviews, all of those walkup things. I loved it because it was something that I wanted to do since I was eight."

SHIPMATE STEVEN: Cleveland Guardians outfielder Steven Kwan will complete a rehab assignment for the Lake County Captains on Saturday, May 25 and Sunday, May 26, wearing #36. Kwan was placed on the 10-day injured list on May 5 with a left hamstring strain.

SKIPPED THE SHIP: Saturday and Sunday will mark Kwan's first two games as a Lake County Captain. After being selected in the 5th round of the 2018 MLB Draft out of Oregon State, Kwan spent parts of 2018 in the Arizona League and with Low-A Mahoning Valley, 2019 with High-A Lynchburg, and parts of 2021 with Double-A Akron and Triple-A Columbus before making his MLB debut with the Guardians on April 7, 2022.

THE CHOSEN KWAN: Kwan played in 32 of Cleveland's first 33 team games before his hamstring strain. Among MLB players in the first 33 team games of 2024, he ranked among MLB players in hits (47, T-2nd) and runs (28, T-4th). Kwan became the 5th Cleveland hitter with 45+ hits & 27+ runs through the first 30 games of a season, last done by Manny Ramirez in 1995.

THE K IS SILENT: Kwan has actively gone 16 consecutive games for the Guardians without tallying a strikeout, a stretch marking 70 plate appearances dating back to April 16th @ BOS. He is the first Cleveland hitter to go 16+ games without a strikeout since Omar Vizquel (16 games, July 16-August 5, 1996).

2023 IN REVIEW (via Cleveland Guardians): Kwan made another significant impact in his sophomore 2023 campaign. Defensively, he ranked 3rd in the AL/5th in MLB with 16 defensive runs saved. He also played 1,352.0 innings in the outfield, trailing only ATL's Ronald Acuña Jr. for the most in MLB.

FIRST TWO YEARS (via Cleveland Guardians): In his first 2 seasons of MLB play, Kwan ranked highly among all MLB players in a slew of categories. He ranked top 10 among all MLB players in singles (253, 2nd), % of swings put in play (49.6%, 3rd), swing-and-miss rate (10.2%, 3rd), triples (14, T-3rd), PA/SO (10.04, 4th), infield hits (47, 6th), 4+ hit games (6, T-7th) and 3+ hit games (27, 9th).

Two former Lake County Captains have been promoted to the Cleveland Guardians during the 2024 season.

**OF Johnathan Rodríguez:** On Tuesday, May 21, **OF Johnathan Rodríguez** made his MLB debut at home against the New York Mets. He started in right field and batted 7<sup>th</sup> in the Guardians' order, going 0-for-4 with 2 strikeouts. **Rodríguez** played in 103 games for the Captains across the 2021 and 2022 seasons, hitting .275 with 103 hits, 20 doubles, 23 home runs, 70 RBI, and an .862 OPS.
