TRIPLE-A INFORMATION

On February 12, 2021, Major League Baseball announced its new plan for affiliated baseball, with 120 Minor League clubs officially agreeing to join the new Professional Development League (PDL).

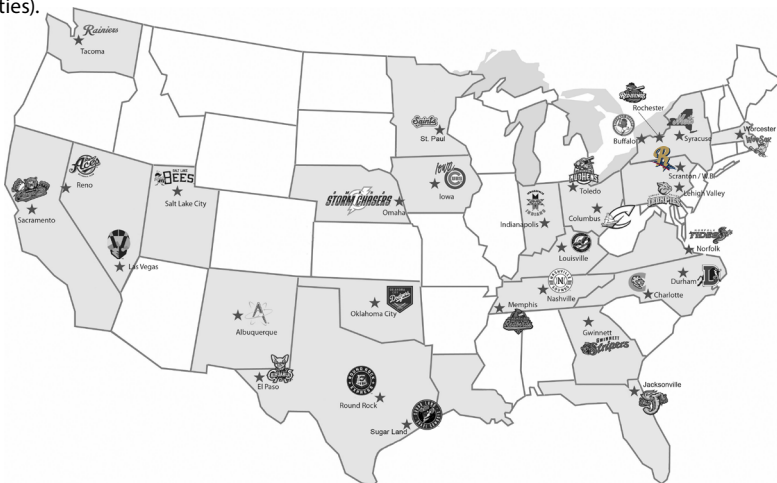
In total, the new player development system includes 179 teams across 17 leagues in 43 states and four provinces. Including the AZL and GCL, there are 209 teams across 19 leagues in 44 states and four provinces. That includes the 150 teams in the PDL and AZL/GCL along with the four partner leagues: the American Association, Atlantic League, Frontier League and Pioneer League.

The long-standing league names return this season after 2021 was played under directional monickers. The International League (formerly Triple-A East) consists of 20 teams; all 14 from the old iteration of the IL, plus teams moving from the old Pacific Coast League, the Southern League and the independent Atlantic League. The Pacific Coast League (Triple-A West in 2021) is comprised of nine former Pacific Coast League teams and one addition from the Atlantic League.

These changes were made to help reduce travel and allow Major League teams to have their affiliates, in most cases, within 200 miles of the parent club (or play at their Spring Training facilities).

DID YOU KNOW?

In 2022, Phillies prospect Darick Hall split his time between Triple-A and the Majors. He played 101 games for Lehigh Valley. Hall hit 28 home runs as he tried to chase down Rhys Hoskins record set back in 2017. Hoskins had hit 29 homers during his Iron Pigs tenure in 115 total games there. Hall added on nine more home runs in the bigs in the 42 games he was a part of for the Phillies. He made his debut on June 29, going 0-4 as the designated hitter. But, Hall put on a show in his next two contests. When he recorded his first Major League hit, and his second and third, they were all four-baggers. Dubbed "Long Ball Hall," Darick was one of just nine players in the expansion era to hit home runs for each of his first three hits.

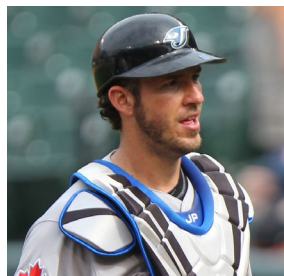
