### Captain's Log

**LAST TIME OUT:** The Lake County Captains fell to the West Michigan Whitecaps 10-2, after a six-run seventh inning from the Whitecaps. Doug Nixhazy set up the Captains well, going six innings and permitting only one run with seven strikeouts and left with Lake County ahead 2-1. Over the next two innings, West Michigan tallied nine runs on eight hits. Both runs for the Captains were scored in the first inning, Alexfri Planez on his 21st birthday drove in one on a sacrifice fly.

**IS STAT SO?:** Yesterday was the lone game in August where the Captains were held without a home run. Lake County has mashed 28 in the month through 14 games played. That is an average of two per game and leads the Midwest League, with the Dayton Dragons in second with 18.

**STREAK OF THE SUMMER:** The Lake County Captains won nine games in a row from August 5th to August 14th, the second longest winning streak in Captains history. The unbeaten streak started included three consecutive wins over the Great Lakes Loons and a six game sweep of the Fort Wayne TinCaps. The longest winning streak in Lake County history is 13 games, which was achieved from May 27 to June 8, 2003, a season where the Captains won a franchise best 97 games.

**CAPitalize:** The Whitecaps have a one game advantage over the Captains atop the second half Midwest League East Division standings. The remaining four games are the final matchups between these two this season.

**ANGEL AT THE PLATE:** Angel Martinez has reached base safely in his last 26 games, smacking five of his ten home runs this season in the span. The 20-year-old is batting .333/.380/.559 with seven doubles and 11 runs batted in. It is the longest active streak in the Midwest League.

**PLANEZ'S PLACE IN CAPTAINS HISTORY:** Alexfri Planez this season strung together a 22-game hit streak. It stands as the longest streak in the Midwest League this season. The 20-year-old was just two hits away from the longest hitting streak in Lake County history. Francisco Mejia, now a Tampa Bay Ray had a hit in 24 consecutive games with the Captains in 2016. Over the stretch, Planez had a .333/.340/.667 slash line with eight home runs, 23 runs batted in and 32 hits. Planez only walked once during the streak. The streak began on June 14th and ended July 14th.

**2021 DRAFT:** Five starting pitchers for the Captains' were selected in the 2021 draft. Doug Nixhazy, the 58th overall selection, has totaled 85 innings over 19 starts allowing 32 earned runs. Tommy Mace was taken in the second round, 69th overall via a competitive balance pick, the right-hander has 59 strikeouts in 67.1 innings pitched. Aaron Davenport, was the sixth round and 186th overall pick in the 2021 draft, his nine home runs allowed is the lowest among qualifying Captains starters. Cleveland selected today's starter Jack Leftwich with the 216th overall pick in the seventh round. Leftwich has just eight runs over 31.1 innings with Lake County. Rodney Boone was an eighth-round selection, pick number 246, and has made eight starts including a complete game shutout against the Lansing Lugnuts on July 2nd.

LAST TIME OUT: Jack Leftwich after a challenging first inning, returned to form completing five innings against Fort Wayne. After two walks in the top of the first, half of Leftwich's total through his first five starts, the TinCaps knocked a single bringing home their lone run. The right-hander would allow just two hits over the next four and retired the final nine he faced.

CAROLINA LEAGUE'S BEST: On June 30th following Leftwich's last start, he ranked first in many individual pitching statistical categories. Leftwich compiled 84 strikeouts, a strikeout to nine ratio of 12.53 and had the lowest walk percentage at 4.3%. The Cedar Rapids born Leftwich also kept batters to a batting average of .195 and posted a 0.88 WHIP, both top marks.

GATOR CHOMP: Leftwich had a decorated career as a four-year player at the University of Florida. The right-hander was a member of the 2019 NCAA Lubbock All-Regional Team, helping Florida to their only win in three games played that year, a 13-5 victory over Army - West Point. Leftwich went seven complete innings, allowing one hit and one run with seven strikeouts. Fellow Captains Starter Tommy Mace and Jack Leftwich were teammates for all four years in Gainesville and drafted in the same year. They are roommates on the road but not during home series due to Leftwich joining Lake County in mid-season.

STARTER & RELIEVER: At the University of Florida, Leftwich transitioned from a starter to a reliever in his senior season. He told Guardians Baseball Insider's Justin Lada "I just do whatever my coaches want me to do. I kind of ran with it. I started to like the closer role. It was nice to sit back and then hurry to get warmed up."

LOOKOUT ON LEFTWICH: Cleveland Director of Amateur Scouting Scott Barnsby added "A plus-fastball and great progression on his breaking ball, we feel the slider has a chance to also be a plus-pitch"

TOP GUN: The product of TNXL Academy was the number one ranked pitcher and seventh overall player in the state of Florida in the Perfect Game Class of 2017. TNXL Academy is an alternative to high school that prepares players for the next level. "My junior year of high school was the first year of TNXL and now it has turned into this big thing."

## CAPTAINS TO THE MAINLAND

Ten former Lake County Captains have made their MLB debut with the Cleveland Guardians in the 2022 season.

*Xzavion Curry:* The Atlanta, GA native made his first start against the Detroit Tigers in the second game of a doubleheader on August 15th. Curry went five innings permitting only three runs. The right-hander was a Captain in 2021, and started 13 games posting a 2.66 ERA.

*Hunter Gaddis:* The right-hander made his Major League Debut on August 5th, getting the start against the Houston Astros at Progressive Field. Despite a scoreless first, Gaddis would allow eight runs on seven hits in 3.1 innings. Gaddis quickly worked through the minor league ranks and was a Captains just last season where he had a 4.16 ERA in 20 games pitched.

*Tyler Freeman:* On August 3rd, Tyler Freeman made his MLB debut, getting the start at third base and went 1-3 with a walk against the Arizona Diamondbacks. The 23-year-old played 61 games with Lake County in 2019, going .292/.382/.424 and starting 57 games at short before being called up.

*Will Benson:* Benson in his major league debut came across the plate as the winning run in a 6-5 11-inning triumph for the Guardians over the D-Backs on August 1st. The 2016 Draft's 14th overall pick played in Lake County in 2018 and 2019 and is remembered for hitting four home runs, the most in a game by any Captain, on April 18, 2019 against the South Bend Cubs at Classic Park.

*Nolan Jones:* The 2016 second round pick, played his first game in the show, on July 8th against the Kansas City Royals. In his first major-league at bat, Jones smacked a RBI double down the right field line. Jones was a Captain in 2018, playing 90 games, compiling 90 hits including 16 longballs.

*Oscar Gonzalez:* The 24-year-old made his MLB debut on May 26th against the Detroit Tigers going 2 for 4, with a single and double. Gonzalez played 114 games in the 2018 season in Lake County, posting 135 hits, 13 Home Runs and 25 doubles.

*Richie Palacios:* The Brooklyn born Palacios earned two singles in his first two major league at-bats on April 25th against the Angels. Palacios earned had both his mother and father in attendance. Palacios played 20 games with Lake County in 2018 and had 24 hits.

*Kirk McCarty:* McCarty took the hill for the first time as a Guardian on Sunday, April 24th at Yankee Stadium. He appeared in the sixth inning, going three innings, surrendering four runs but adding three strikeouts. He made 22 starts in the 2018 season as a Captain, accumulating a 4.29 ERA through 115.1 innings.

*Tanner Tully:* The left-hander from Elkhart, Indiana, made his MLB debut on April 22nd entering in the fifth inning against the Yankees. He went two innings allowing two hits, and one run over 38 pitches. Tully was a Captain in 2017, where he 16 appearances, eight starts and posted a 3.16 ERA over 77 innings.

*Bryan Lavastida:* Lavastida caught all nine innings for the Guardians in their 17-3 win over the Kansas City Royals on April 10th. He earned his first big league hit April 22nd at Yankee Stadium. Lavastida was a Captain in 2021 playing in 48 games where he batted .303/.399/.467.
