YESTERDAY: The Flying Squirrels beat the Somerset Patriots, 7-3, in a rain-shortened game. In the first inning, Oswaldo Cabrera hit an RBI double and Michael Beltre hit an RBI single to put Somerset ahead, 2-0. Max Burt added a solo homer in the second. In the bottom of the second, **Diego Rincones** hit a three-run homer to tie the game, 3-3. It was his first home run at the Double-A level. Later in the inning, **Simon Whiteman** gave Richmond a 5-3 lead with a two-run homer. **Vince Fernandez** hit a solo home run in the third and **Will Wilson** hit a solo homer in fifth, his first at Double-A, to push the lead to 7-3. The game was delayed and later completed early in the sixth inning due to lightning and rain.

TODAY'S GAME: The Flying Squirrels play the finale of a six-game series against the Somerset Patriots, Double-A affiliate of the New York Yankees. This series marks the first-ever trip for the Patriots to The Diamond. From June 15-20, the Patriots won five-of-six in Bridgewater against the Flying Squirrels. This series marks the final set between the two teams this year. A win for Richmond would give them a series victory. If the Patriots win, the two teams will split the series.

THE FLYING SQUIRRELS have won 10 of their last 14 games. They are tied for third place in the six-team Double-A Northeast Southwest Division, 2.5 games behind first-place Akron. For the season, the Richmond offense is ranked ninth in the league with a .237 batting average. The pitching staff is ranked fourth in the league with a 3.86 ERA for the season.

THE PATRIOTS have gone 5-6 over the last 11 games. They are currently tied for first place in the Double-A Northeast's Northeast Division, even with the Portland Sea Dogs. For the season, the Somerset offense has hit .244, which is sixth in the circuit. The pitching staff has a 3.05 ERA, which leads all full-season teams in Minor League Baseball. Somerset is playing its first season as an affiliated team after playing in the independent Atlantic League as a founding member of the circuit from 1998-2020, winning six championships. The Somerset roster includes four players ranked in MLB.com's top-30 Yankees prospects, including SS Oswaldo Peraza (No. 4, No. 97 overall), RHP Luis Medina (No. 7), LHP Ken Waldichuk (No. 27) and RHP Hayden Wesneski (No. 30).

FOR RICHMOND: Left-hander **Luis Amaya** makes his third start of the season and the third start of his professional career. Amaya made his first start last Wednesday at Bowie and pitched 3.0 scoreless, hitless innings, working around a career-high five walks. He made another start last Sunday in the series finale and allowed three runs over 2.1 innings in a no-decision. Amaya started the season with a 15.43 ERA in his first two appearances through May 8. He responded by working nine straight appearances without allowing an earned run from May 12 to June 13, covering 10.2 innings. **For more on Amaya, see page two.**

FOR SOMERSET: Left-hander Ken Waldichuk makes his sixth Double-A start and third against the Flying Squirrels. He picked up a win in his last start against Richmond on Tuesday in the series opener, allowing two runs over 6.1 innings with 11 strikeouts. He also faced Richmond on June 17 in his Double-A debut and allowed a season-high three runs over 4.2 innings in a no-decision. Over his last three starts, he has gone 2-0 with a 2.20 ERA (4 ER/16.1 IP). Waldichuk was drafted by the Yankees in the fifth round in 2019 out of St. Mary's. He began his professional career that summer with rookie-level Pulaski of the Appalachian League, going 0-2 with a 3.68 ERA in 10 starts.

POWER SURGE: Over the last 11 games since July 6, the Flying Squirrels have hit 19 home runs, which is the most in the Double-A Northeast. **Vince Fernandez** has hit six homers in his 10 games played during that stretch. **Heliot Ramos** has hit three and **Frankie Tostado** has hit two. **Andres Angulo**, **Sandro Fabian**, **Brandon Martorano**, **Diego Rincones**, **Andy Sugilio**, **David Villar**, **Simon Whiteman** and **Will Wilson** have each homered once in that stretch. For the season, the Flying Squirrels rank seventh in the circuit with 70 home runs. The team is on pace to hit 129 home runs this season in 120 games. The franchise record for the most home runs in a season is 108 in 2013. In 2019, the Flying Squirrels hit 84 homers in 139 games. Fernandez leads the team with 12 home runs this season. In 2019, **Gio Brusa** led the Flying Squirrels with 12 home runs for the season.

RAMOS RAKING: **Heliot Ramos** went 0-for-2 with two walks on Friday to snap his eight-game hit streak. His nine-game on-base streak ended in the rain-shortened game on Saturday. Over his last 10 games since July 4, he is batting .289 (11-for-38) with four home runs, four doubles and nine RBIs while scoring nine runs. He began the season hitting .314 with three homers and 12 RBIs in 22 May games. In June, he posted a .155 batting average and homered twice with three RBIs in 26 games. Ramos is back with the Flying Squirrels this week after missing two games last weekend while traveling to Denver for the SiriusXM All-Star Futures Game as part of MLB's All-Star Week festivities. On Thursday, he hit his ninth home run of the season for the Flying Squirrels, a 448-foot shot over the batters' eye in center field.

TOASTY: Over his last 31 games since June 6, **Frankie Tostado** is batting .319 (38-for-119) with seven homers, eight doubles and 30 RBIs. Tostado is tied for 10th in the league with 40 RBIs this season and ranks tied for seventh with 61 hits. Tostado is playing his first season at Double-A, skipping over the High-A level after spending 2019 with Low-A Augusta.

BREAKING OUT: After going 0-for-14 over four games from June 10-15, **David Villar** has hit .333 (33-for-99) with six homers and 15 RBIs over his last 27 games since June 16. He added a three-run homer last Saturday night at Bowie to put the Flying Squirrels ahead in the eighth inning. For the season, Villar is second on the team with 11 homers and third with 31 RBIs.

SWINGING FOR THE VINCE: In his last 13 games since June 30, **Vince Fernandez** is batting .463 (19-for-41) with six home runs, two doubles and 17 RBIs. Fernandez is ranked first on the team with 12 homers this season and second with 33 RBIs. He has picked up multiple hits in six of his last 13 games. He has homered three times in the last four games against Somerset. On Wednesday against the Patriots, Fernandez went 4-for-5 with a homer, a double, a walk and five RBIs, capping his performance with a walk-off single in the bottom of the 11th inning. It was the 18th five-RBI performance by a Flying Squirrels hitter in the franchise's history and the second this season. On Friday, he hit a game-winning, two-run homer in the bottom of the eighth inning to top Somerset, 6-4. He added a solo home run to center on Saturday night.

PITCHERS WHO RAKE: For the season, the Flying Squirrels lead the Double-A Northeast with nine hits, six walks and six RBIs by pitchers at the plate. On the year, Richmond has gone 26-14 (.650) against National League affiliates, but have gone 9-13 (.409) against affiliates of American League clubs. After back-to-back series against National League affiliates Hartford and Binghamton, the Flying Squirrels now face American League clubs for the remaining four sets in July and will use the designated hitter.

IN THE LEAGUE LEADERS: **Vince Fernandez** is ranked tied for fifth with 13 home runs. **Frankie Tostado** is ranked tied for 10th in the Double-A Northeast with 40 RBIs and tied for seventh with 61 hits. **Shane Matheny** is tied for eighth with 28 walks. **Simon Whiteman** is tied for fifth with 10 stolen bases. **Norwith Gudino** and **Patrick Ruotolo** are tied for seventh in the circuit with five saves. **Frank Rubio** and **Joey Marciano** are tied for fifth with 22 games pitched. **Caleb Kilian** is ranked second in ERA (2.21), first in complete games (2), first in shutouts (1), third in BAA (.216), tied for second in WHIP (0.92) and first in winning percentage (1.000).

PROSPECT WATCH: The Flying Squirrels have five players included in *Baseball America's* Top-30 Giants prospects: **Heliot Ramos** (3), **Will Wilson** (10), **Tristan Beck** (13), **Sean Hjelle** (14) and **Jose Marte** (30). Ramos is also rated by *Baseball America* as the No. 83 overall prospect. **Simon Whiteman** is rated by *Baseball America* as being the "Fastest Baserunner" in the Giants system, Hjelle is rated as having the "Best Control" and **Diego Rincones** is rated as having the "Best Outfield Arm." Five players, including Ramos (3), Hjelle (11), Wilson (12), Beck (20) and **Caleb Kilian** (30) are also ranked in MLB.com's Top-30 Giants prospects.
