INTERNATIONAL LEAGUE LOVE

The Omaha Storm Chasers won the International League 1st Half title with a 49-24 record, the best Minor League team in the 1st half of the 2024 season. Winning the first half in the league secures the Storm Chasers home field advantage in the International League Championship Series and the Storm Chasers won the series vs. Columbus 2 games to 1.

NOTES AND NUGGETS

CLIPPING COLUMBUS

After falling behind in the International League Championship Series with a 3-2 loss in Game 1, the Storm Chasers came back to win Games 2 & 3, advancing to today's game. Omaha trailed for 14 of the first 16 innings this week, for 8 innings Tuesday, then 6 on Wednesday ... the Chasers did not take their first lead until the walk-off victory Wednesday ... the Chasers led for 7 of the 29 innings played against the Clippers.

IN GOOD STANDINGS

After winning the first half with a 49-24 record, Omaha finished the regular season as the best overall team in the International League as well, 30 games over .500 with an overall 89-59 record (.601 winning percentage). Of 120 full season Minor League teams, Omaha's .601 winning percentage overall this year ranked as the 9th-best ... the Palm Beach Cardinals (Cardinals Single-A) were the best team in Minor League Baseball at 83-47 (.638 winning %).

TOO CLOSE FOR COMFORT

88 of Omaha's 151 games this year have been decided by 3 runs or less (58%), including 35 of 60 losses in 2024 (57%) ... Games 1 & 2 of the ILCs were 1-run games. Omaha was 27-18 in 1-run games in the regular season ... the Chasers were tied for the 4th-most 1-run wins of any MiLB team ... Akron led the Minors with 33 wins by 1 run.

I'M DIFFERENT, YEAH, I'M (RUN) DIFFERENT (IAL)

Omaha outscored its opponents 792 to 662 in the regular season, a +130 run differential. A +130 run differential this year ranks as the best mark both in the International League and at the Triple-A level, just ahead of Scranton/Wilkes-Barre (+127).

RELIEF AID

Omaha's bullpen was one of the best across the entire Triple-A level in 2024. The Storm Chasers relievers led all Triple-A bullpens in the regular season with a 3.71 ERA, 1.33 WHIP and .220/.323/.347 opposing slash line ... the 218 opponents' batting average ranked tied 20th among all 120 full-season Minor League teams.

COMEBACK KIDS

Between the regular season and postseason, Omaha had 48 come-from-behind wins this season, meaning over half (52%) of this year's wins were games where the Chasers trailed at some point. Omaha has trailed for 3 innings or more in 18 of those 48 comeback wins.

TODAY'S START

- Avila is making his 2nd start with Omaha, his 21st overall start this season... after opening the season in Double-A with Northwest Arkansas, Luinder made 19 starts for the Naturals (and missed 48 days on the IL) before being promoted to Omaha on Tuesday, September 17, following the conclusion of the Double-A regular season.
Since the start of the 2022 season, his 310.1 innings are the 2nd-most of any Royals Minor League pitcher, while 284 strikeouts rank 4th... of 18 pitchers with at least 200.00 innings in the system over the last 3 years, ranks 1st in HR/9 (0.49), 5th in opponents' average (.235)... 2nd in that group in ground ball rate (49.5%).
Is 1 of 9 Royals prospects (1 of 5 pitchers) that will be headed to the Arizona Fall League next month... he is one of just two Royals representatives going that has Triple-A experience (also: Anthony Simonelli).
Ranked by MLB Pipeline as the No. 26 Royals prospect.

LAST OUTING: SATURDAY, SEPTEMBER 21 @ LOUISVILLE

Made his Triple-A debut with Omaha, having joined the Chasers for the final week of the regular season... struggled in the 1st inning, walked 2 batter with one out, then a double, single and sac fly each scored one run for the Bats, a three-run inning... settled down with a 1-2-3 inning in the 2nd, then worked a scoreless 3rd, around a two-out single... stranded a leadoff single on in the 4th inning for his 3rd straight scoreless inning... a leadoff walk in the 5th scored on a double, got a strikeout and walk, then was removed at 4.1 innings.

2024 HIGHLIGHTS

- Opened the season in the starting rotation for Double-A Northwest Arkansas and made 16 starts before landing on the 7-Day Injured List July 12 (retroactive to July 10)... missed 47 days, activated from the Injured List August 27 and made 3 more starts.
Made 3 quality starts for the Naturals, including tying a career-high with 7.0 scoreless innings June 21 vs. Tulsa (LAD)... also made quality starts back-to-back starts May 17 @ Arkansas (SEA) and May 23 vs. Amarillo (AZ).
7 of 19 starts in Double-A were scoreless, including 3 straight around a stint on the IL, for a 10.1-inning scoreless streak (7/9 to 9/3).

CAREER NOTES

- Spent the entire year at High-A Quad Cities, going 4-7 with a 4.39 ERA over 22 appearances (20 starts)... on the Injured List June 16 to 27, missing 2 starts... ranked 2nd on the River Bandits with 102 strikeouts, while leading the team with 108.2 innings pitched.
In the month of April, pitched to a 1.56 ERA (3 ER in 17.1 IP) over 4 games (2 starts), holding opponents to a .183 batting average with 29 strikeouts and 5 walks.
Was one of 20 minor league pitchers who allowed three home runs or less while working over 75.0 innings (583 pitchers had 75.0 innings in MiLB last year... Royals organization teammate Eric Cerantola was also on that list.
Ranked 8th among qualified Royals Minor League pitchers in 2023 with a 4.39 ERA, 5th in opponents' average (.248) and 6th in WHIP (1.33)... ranked 7th in the organization in innings pitched (108.2).
Made 5 quality starts, each time pitching exactly 6.0 innings, did not pitch into the 7th... threw 6.0 scoreless frames July 22 @ Beloit (MIA), allowing just 2 hits with 0 walks and 3 strikeouts.

- Spent the entire year at Single-A Columbia, making 26 starts for the Fireflies, going 6-10 with a 4.54 ERA (58 ER in 115.0 IP)... struggled in the 1st half, to the tune of a 5.94 ERA over 13 starts, but worked a 3.34 over his 13 starts in the 2nd half.
Among qualified Royals Minor League pitchers, ranked 3rd in ERA (4.54), 2nd in opponents' average (.234) and 2nd in WHIP (1.31)... 2nd in starts (26), 6th in innings pitched (115.0), and 8th in strikeouts (97).
Made 4 quality starts, the first 4 of his career, one in each month between May and August... threw 7.0 shutout innings August 9 @ Myrtle Beach (CHC), the longest start of his career to that point, allowing just 3 hits with 2 walks and 2 strikeouts.
Named the Carolina League Pitcher of the Week, for the week of June 27 - July 3... on July 1 @ Augusta (ATL), pitched 6.0 innings and allowed 2 unearned runs on 1 hit and 1 walk, while striking out a career-high 9.

- Opened his season in the Arizona Complex League, before finishing the year with Single-A Columbia... combined to appear in 14 games (10 starts and go 3-6 with a 4.66 ERA (30 ER in 58.0 IP) and 51 strikeouts to 17 walks (3.0 K/BB).
Pitched in 8 games (4 starts) between the ACL Royals Gold and Blue teams, going 1-2 with a 5.12 ERA (18 ER in 31.2 IP with 27 strikeouts to just 7 walks... earned his first promotion to a full-season affiliate August 17, assigned to Single-A Columbia to finish the season and made 6 starts with the Fireflies between mid-August and September.

- Returned to the Dominican Summer League for a second season and pitched in 12 games (2 starts), with 3 scoreless appearances.

- Began his professional career in the Dominican Summer League, making 9 appearances (2 starts), with 3 scoreless appearances.
