Tonight's Game: The Nashville Sounds and Indianapolis Indians play game four of a six-game series tonight at First Horizon Park. The Indians took last night's game, 4-3. Reigning International League Pitcher of the Week Ethan Small starts for Nashville, facing Indianapolis' Mike Burrows.

Ethan Small: 25-year-old Ethan Small will toe the rubber for the Sounds this evening. The southpaw is 4-3 with a 3.18 ERA (56.2 IP/20 ER) in 12 previous starts with Nashville. He also is 0-0 with a 6.75 ERA (2.2 IP/2 ER) in one start for Milwaukee in 2022. Small is coming off his best performance of the season. He earned the win on June 25 vs. Gwinnett, allowing just one run over 7.0 innings. Small yielded three hits and one walk while striking out 10 on 88 pitches (61 strikes). He was named the International League Pitcher of the Week after tying a career high in innings pitched and strikeouts. The Lexington, Tenn. native enters tonight's game as the No. 8 prospect in the Brewers system (MLB Pipeline). He went 2-2 with a 1.96 ERA in eight starts with Biloxi and 2-0 with a 2.06 ERA in nine starts with Nashville in 2021. Milwaukee selected Small in the First Round (28th Pick) of the 2019 MLB First-Year Player Draft out of Mississippi State University.

Mike Burrows: 22-year-old Mike Burrows gets the ball for Indianapolis tonight. The right-hander is making his third start of the year with the Indians and is 0-0 with a 3.68 ERA (7.1 IP/3 ER) after joining the team from Double-A Altoona on June 16. In 12 games (all starts) with Altoona, Burrows was 4-2 with a 2.94 ERA (52.0 IP/17 ER). Overall in 2022, he has thrown 59.1 innings and has limited opponents to 47 hits while racking up 77 strikeouts. He last pitched on June 25 and got a no decision against Memphis (4.1 IP, 5 H, 1 R, 1 ER, 0 BB, 4 K). Burrows is currently listed by MLB Pipeline as Pittsburgh's #10 prospect. The Pirates drafted him in the 11th round of the 2018 MLB First-Year Player Draft and signed him after he bypassed his commitment to the University of Connecticut.

It's A Small World: Ethan Small was named the International League Pitcher of the Week (June 20-26) after turning in one of the best outings of his career last Saturday with a 10-strikeout performance. It was Small's third career double-digit strikeout game (also - 12, 6/12/21 w/ Biloxi vs. Mississippi and 10, 6/1/21 w/ Biloxi at Montgomery). It was also the second time in Small's career he went 7.0 innings (also - 6/18/21 w/ Biloxi at Rocket City).

The Halfway Point: Tonight's game is Nashville's 75th of the season, halfway through the 150 scheduled regular season games. The Sounds have played 39 of their 74 games at home (25-14) and 35 of 74 on the road (19-16).

Whitley and Wilson Run: Garrett Whitley stole his 6th base of the season last night and has a steal in each of the last three games he has played. It's the second time this year he has gone consecutive games with a stolen base (also, 4/16 at Gwinnett and 4/19 vs. Charlotte). Weston Wilson logged his 8th stolen base of the season last night. It's the third time this year he has swiped a bag in consecutive games (also, 4/26 and 4/27 at St. Paul and 5/19 and 5/21 vs. Louisville).

The Dog Days of June are History: The Sounds finished the month of June with a record of 11-15 after going 17-8 in May and 16-7 in April. Nashville's team ERA in June was 4.82, 14th in the International League. They also finished 14th in batting average with a .249 mark as a team.

The Sad Man: Reliever Connor Sadzeck continued his brilliant season out of the pen with a pair of scoreless innings last night. In 22 games with the Sounds, the right-hander is 1-1 with a 1.07 ERA (25.1 IP/3 ER) with 33 strikeouts. Sadzeck sports a 0.99 WHIP and opposing batters are hitting just .178 against him.

Sweet's Managerial Watch: Rick Sweet has 191 wins as Nashville's manager, good for 5th-most in franchise history. Don Money has the 4th-most wins in franchise history with 223.

Earn It: The Nashville pitching staff leads Triple-A with a 3.72 ERA. Scranton/Wilkes-Barre checks in at second with a 3.96 ERA. The Sounds also lead Triple-A with eight shutouts.

The Future Brew Crew: Nashville has five players on the roster who are listed on MLB Pipeline's Top-30 Milwaukee prospects. Infielder Brice Turang is the No. 5 prospect, left-hander Ethan Small is the No. 8 prospect, catcher Mario Feliciano is the No. 20 prospect, right-handed pitcher Alec Bettinger is the No. 22 prospect and right-handed pitcher Dylan File is the No. 24 prospect.

LAST OUTING: Small had his best outing of the year, pitching 7.0 one-run innings in Nashville's 2-1 win over Gwinnett last Saturday. He tied a professional career high with 10 strikeouts and yielded only three hits and one walk on 88 pitches (61 strikes). Small was named the International League Pitcher of the Week after his stellar performance.

AGAINST OPPONENT: Small has faced Indianapolis once with his lone start coming on September 30, 2021 at Victory Field. Small picked up the win, allowing a couple of runs (both earned) over 5.0 innings (5 H, 3 BB, 4 K).
