Today's Game

The Clippers will send LHP **Logan Allen** to the mound today, looking to bounce back from yesterday's sweep (4-1 when Allen starts after a loss; 4G win streak). St. Paul will counter with RHP **Ryan Gallagher**. Columbus is 17-10 (.630) versus right handers this year. Gallagher has never faced Columbus in his career (today is fourth career start in IL, second against IL; had 2GS at Las Vegas last week).

vs. the Saints

Columbus went 4-2 against the Saints in Minnesota last year, on the way to a 9-7 series record, and has won 46 of the last 75 overall opposing the Saints (405-323 run differential; 13 of 29 losses by a single run, only 10 losses by more than two runs). Individually, **Kahlil Watson** is 11x39 (.323) with 4HR and 12RBI against the Saints in his career (9G) and **Stuart Fairchild** has hit .344 (11x32) in 9G.

Always an Answer

St. Paul scored in the bottom half of every inning in which Columbus plated a run yesterday, keeping the Clippers from establishing any momentum. On the roadtrip, the Clippers have scored in the top half of 32 innings and the opposition has answered in the bottom on 13 occasions (45%, taking out bottoms of the 9th that didn't happen). A loss today will drop the Clippers to a season worst 2G under .500.

Crazy Eighthths

Columbus had an 8th inning scoring streak snapped at 7G on Tuesday, but scored a trio in the 8th Wednesday (zero in the 9th for the first time since 5/7). On the year, the Clippers have scored 75 runs from the 8th inning on (18 more than 2nd place), crafting a collective .966OPS (134 points ahead of 2nd). In the 8th alone, Columbus has 15 runs in the last 9G (more than three IL teams have all season).

Watch Out for Watson

Kahlil Watson is hitting .322/.436/.656 with 15XBH in his last 24G (1XBH in first 12G), having reached base in each of 13G prior to yesterday (.453OBP, 4/23-5/13). Since Sunday, Watson has an IL-best 12RBI and is tied atop the IL with 4HR. However, he has failed to draw a walk in each of his last 5G (23PA), his longest walkless stretch since a 6G run from 8/12-8/17/25 (22PA).

Since the Option

Juan Brito is hitting .247/.329/.516 with 4HR and 16RBI in 15G since getting optioned on 4/28 (9G hit streak snapped Tuesday: .316, 12x38). All of Brito's homers have come from the right side of the plate this year, as he is slugging just .338 from the left (.426SLG vs. RHP from '24-25). **George Valera** is at .174 (8x46) with 2RBI in 11G since his option on 4/30 (.294, 10x34 with 12RBI in 8G April rehab).

Misleading Streaks

Nolan Jones has reached base in 11 consecutive games, posting a .354OBP since 5/3, but has seen his OBP drop 10 points over the course of the streak, while his batting average has dipped 15 points (.225, 9x40). **George Valera** owns an 8G on base streak since 5/5, but has recorded only a .250OBP on the streak (lost 13 points on his season line), while hitting .182 (6x33; lost 30 points on average).

Not Seeing It

Since his return from injury (sore right hip, 4/24-5/2), **Cooper Ingle** has drawn only 3BB in 35PA (20BB in 54PA prior), going down on strikes 12 times (9K in first 15G). His on base percentage is in danger of falling below .500 for the first time since his second game of the year (.444, season low). As a team, Columbus has 11BB this series (19th in the IL; dropped to 2nd for the year, -4 on Worcester).

UnFairchild

Stuart Fairchild's on base streak was snapped at 10G in the nightcap last night, when he got only 3PA due to the shortened game (.500OBP, 5/2-5/15). Combined with his 2x4 (HR) effort in game one, he was able to boost his slugging over .500 last night and now he is one of 10 players in the IL with a line of .300/.400/.500 (25 batters are hitting .300; IL had 12 such hitters through this time last year).

Hot Huff

Kody Huff rebounded from a pair of hitless games to end April with hits in each of his first 11G this month (.500, 19x38, seven multi-hit, 14RBI). The hit streak is a new career best, topping his streak in the first 10G of April, 4/1-4/12 (.316, 12x38; hit .220, 11x50, in last 13G of the month). In May, Huff leads the IL in hitting and OBP (.604), ranks 3rd in doubles (6), 4th in SLG (.816) and tied for 6th in RBI.

This Date in Clipper History

5/16/2010

Columbus beat Durham 5-0 at Huntington Park, with **Carlos Santana** strumming a 2-run HR to lead the way. Santana played in only 57 games for the Clippers in 2010, receiving a permanent promotion to the Big Leagues on 6/11. In his short time with Columbus, he batted .316 (62x196) with 13HR and 51RBI, while posting a .447OBP and .597SLG.

Huntington (Small) Park

In each of the first 11 seasons after the move downtown (2009-19), Huntington Park ranked among the top two in the IL in homers per game. With the arrival of six new parks to the IL in 2021, Huntington Park finished 4th, 6th and 10th from 2021-23, respectively. The 2024 season saw a return to the top (2.96; 108HR hit by the Clippers, most for the home team in HP's existence), but it dropped back to 7th last year (2.31). Including the postseason, the Clippers have been out-homered over the life of the park (1,423 to 1,372).

Challenging Times

The Clippers are 56-59 (.487) in pitch reviews, with batters going 33-43 (.434) and pitchers/catchers going 23-16 (.590). They have run out of challenges in 25G and have not challenged in 2G. Last season, they were correct 43.1% of the time (2nd worst in the IL).

Extras, Read All About Them

Columbus is 1-3 in extra innings this season, after having gone 5-5 in 2025 and 9-9 in 2024 (most losses since 2013, 12). Since the start of the 2018 season, when baserunners started appearing at second base, the Clippers are 51-36 when playing past regulation (.586, best in the IL; no other team above .570), including 26-17 at home (.605, but 4-7 in last 11G). Of the 87G to require extra play, 69 have been resolved after one frame (including eight DH games) and only one has gone past the 12th (5-4 loss in 13 innings on 9/20/22 at Toledo). From 7/31/19-6/26/21, Columbus played 85 straight within the allotted innings.

On the Runs

Starting with the embiggened 150G schedule in 2022, the Clippers scored over 800 runs in three consecutive seasons from 2022-2024 (855, 808 and 805 runs, respectively; accounting for the 3rd, 4th and 5th best totals in team history). Following a steep decline last season (670, fewest scored in a full season since 2018), Columbus is looking to easily top 800 again, with an outside chance to establish a new team high (on pace for 876, would rank as 3rd most all-time; 898 scored in 1983).

On the Run

On the basepaths, the Clippers are making a run at the franchise mark in stolen bases, with 65 through the first 43G (on pace for 227SB). The team record was set in 2024 when Columbus swiped an even 200, but the team speed was throttled last year (129SB; still, the 2nd highest total since the Cleveland affiliation started in 2009). However, with 17CS so far, the Clippers are also pacing (59) for the most times caught stealing of the Cleveland affiliation (nabbed 79 times in 2008, last time over 51).

Juiced is Loose

In the Huntington Park Era (since 2009), Columbus leads the IL with 77 grand slams and 1,920RBI (led IL in RBI in 2010, '11, '12, '17, '18 and '22). Collecting an IL-best 10 grand slams last season, it marked their fifth straight season with at least four (118RBI last year; had only 97RBI in 2024, worst in a 140+G season since 2016).

Hits the Spot

When turning in as many or fewer hits than their opponents last season, the Clippers went 18-64 (.220), coming in 13th out of 20 in the IL. The 2024 season saw them post an IL-worst .185 (12-53) winning percentage in such games. When allowing at least 10 hits last year, Columbus was 7-41 (.146, 20th in the IL; started the season 1-20).

In Big Trouble

The Clipper pitching staff is trending toward the worst ERA in club history, sitting at 5.79 through the first 43G (6.75ERA in last 14G, since 4/30). Since the reorganization of the minor leagues in 2021, Columbus has twice finished the season with a 5+ ERA (current record is 5.32, set in 2023), after having done so just once in the first 43 seasons (5.08 in 1983). However, the staff is pacing to give up only 147HR (lowest total since 133HR in 2018; averaging 182 per season since the Year of the Homer in 2019).

Department of Defense

The Columbus defense is sitting at 14th in the IL this year (.977), following a 2025 that saw a franchise record (.985, led the IL). On 4/10 at Worcester, the defense collapsed for the first 5E game since 8/27/24 (topped out at 3E in a game twice last year and had fewer than 5E in 21 of 26 series). The Clippers have played flawlessly in 22G this season (13-9, .591), after doing so in nearly 60% of games last year (44-42, .512), including 16 straight from 6/20-7/8/25 (longest streak in the IL over the last 20 years).

Key to Victory

From 2022-23, Columbus owned the best record in the IL when holding opponents to three runs or fewer, going 95-8 (.922, no other team was above .880). The Clippers were 43-10 in such games in 2024 (.811, 13th in the IL), accumulating four losses by 4/14, and were just 47-10 (.825, 9th) last year, collecting four losses over 14G from 4/23-5/9 (had four losses total in both 2022 and 2023).

Good Baseball

Stuart Fairchild moved a runner into scoring position with a bunt single on 5/13 at St. Paul and that runner came around to score in a win. Since the start of the 2018 season, Columbus is 86-23 (.789) in games in which a run is scored after a good bunt attempt, including a 3-2 mark this season (.600, blew 7-run lead in one of the losses; went 23-2 in 2018).

To the End

The Clippers had the 6th most last at bat losses last season (17), after pacing the circuit with 23 in 2024 (tied with Toledo). They also suffered the 4th most walk-off losses (8), watching three in a row slip away at Rochester from 5/29-5/31. The 2024 season saw 41G decided in the last at bat (tied for 2nd most in the IL, one off lead), with Columbus going 18-23 in those contests (t-17th, .439).

Manager Profile

Andy Tracy made his Clippers debut in 2021, following **Tony Mansolino's** championship rookie year in 2019 (sixth Clipper skipper to win Governors' Cup in first season; **Gene Michael**-'79, **Joe Altobelli**-'80, **Frank Verdi**-'81, **Bucky Dent**-'87 and **Mike Sarbaugh**-'10). This season marks Tracy's sixth year as a manager (first was with Williamsport in the Philadelphia system), as he holds a career record of 407-428 (.487), 377-382 with Columbus (.497).

Workhorse

Allen is the only Clipper averaging over 80 pitches a start this season, at 86.9 (along with **Trenton Denholm**, only pitchers to throw more than 90 in a game multiple times). Averaging almost 93 pitches per outing in the Majors last season, Allen hit triple digits six times (Columbus has not had a pitcher reach 100 since **Peyton Battenfield** on 9/2/22, 507G ago)

Stellar Support:

Through 7GS, the bullpen has graced Allen with a 1.69ERA in relief (26.2IP, 5ER), stranding one of two runners inherited. The defense has committed only 5E in Allen's starts, while the offense has put forward 4.9 runs per game. That all adds up to a 6-1 record for Columbus when he takes the hill.

2026 Spring Training:

Allen pitched four times for Cleveland during spring training, going 0-2 with an 18.00ERA (10.0IP, 25H, 20R, 20ER, 8BB, 9K). He was optioned to Columbus on 3/22, but did not join the team until 3/31.

Last Season:

Pitched the entire season with Cleveland... after season opening loss at San Diego on 4/1 (5.1IP, 7H, 4R, 4ER, 5BB, 1K), went 1-0 with a 0.56ERA (16.0IP, 1ER) in next 3GS (4/9-4/20), before loss vs. Boston on 4/27 (4.1IP, 9H, 7R, 7ER, 3BB, 2K)... won with a scoreless start on 5/13 vs. Milwaukee (6.0IP, 3H, 1BB, 6K) and earned a win in a relief outing on 5/31 vs. Los Angeles (1.0IP, 2K)... went 3-3 with a 3.34ERA (35.0IP, 13ER) in 6GS (4QS) prior to the All-Star Break (6/11-7/11)... lost a pair out of the Break before winning vs. Colorado on 7/29 (7.0IP, 8H, 2R, 2ER, 1BB, 3K)... struggled over 5GS from 8/12-9/4, turning in a 6.66ERA (25.2IP, 19ER)... won a scoreless start on 9/20 at Minnesota, following a nine-day layoff (8.0IP, 4H, 1BB, 7K)... did not pitch in the AL Playoffs.
