Tonight's Game

The Clippers will send LHP **Ryan Webb** to the mound tonight, as they attempt to even Andy Tracy's record as manager with Columbus at 385-385. Toledo will counter with RHP **Carl Edwards**. Columbus is 23-12 (.657) versus right handers this year. Edwards has pitched against Columbus four times in his career (2024 with Iowa), going 0-2 with a 4.76ERA (5.2IP, 7H, 5R, 3ER, 2BB, 2K).

vs. the Mud Hens

Columbus has pulled ahead in the season series vs. Toledo (5-4) after going 10-11 opposing the Mud Hens last year (have not won a season series since going 11-10 in 2022). The Clippers have scored first in six of nine against Toledo this year (4-2), compared to 16 times (9-7) in their other 44G. Individually, **Bo Naylor** has hit .288 (17x59, 1HR and 9RBI) in 16G against Toledo in his career.

Crazy Eighthths

Columbus had an 8th inning scoring streak snapped at 7G on 5/12, but has scored in 13 of the last 17G (also scored in seven of 11 last 9ths). On the year, the Clippers have 89 runs from the 8th inning on (16 more than 2nd place), crafting a collective .968OPS (+121 points on 2nd). In the 8th alone, Columbus has 24 runs in the last 17G (more than 11 teams have all season, including Toledo).

Too High

Though **Cooper Ingle** reached base twice last night, his OBP dipped to .485 (2nd best in pro baseball among players with at least 100PA). Since going deep in consecutive games at St. Paul on 5/16, Ingle is slashing .314/.419/.600 with 3HR and 13RBI in 9G, as he is already closing in on a personal best in homers (8; had 11HR in 2024). He is a pair of walks away from reaching 200 in his career.

Juan Gone

Juan Brito snapped his hitless streak at 19AB with a single last night and is batting just .167 (8x48) in 13G since a 9G hit streak to begin May (.316, 12x38 with 4HR and 13RBI). He owns just a pair of XBH on the cold spell, but has been putting the bat on the ball (4K in last 46PA), while producing a .305OBP (10BB). His multi-RBI game last night was his first since back to back games at Iowa (5/8-5/9).

Watch Out for Watson

Kahlil Watson is hitting .291/.378/.591 with 19XBH in his last 33G (1XBH in first 12G), having reached base in each of 13G from 4/23-5/13 (.453OBP). Watson has 6HR and 17RBI in 14G since 5/10 (.267, 16x60); however, he has not drawn a walk in his last 14G (61PA, 22K; 36%), his longest walkless stretch since a 17G run from 5/21-6/17/22 (career long, 76PA; hit .189, 14x74).

Gaining Steam

George Valera enters tonight on a 15G on base streak, turning in a .364OBP since 5/5. Over the first 8G of the streak, Valera had a .250OBP (36PA; hit .182, 6x33 with 3BB and 11K), but he has reached half the time in the last 7G (30PA; hitting .318, 7x22 with 8BB and 4K). His walk rate is down a tick this season (11.8%; 13.3% from '22-25), while his K-rate is down considerably (17.6% from 26.5%).

Hot Huff

Kody Huff rebounded from a pair of hitless games to end April with hits in each of his first 12G this month (.476, 20x42, 14RBI). The hit streak, from 5/1-5/16, set a new career best, topping his streak in the first 10G of April, 4/1-4/12 (.316, 12x38; hit .220, 11x50, in last 13G of April). Huff is 3x15 (.200) in 6G since the streak ended, but has 4RBI (37RBI in 43G; had career high 47RBI in 101G last season).

POW Hangover

Since being named the IL's Batter of the Week for 4/14-4/19 vs. Iowa (10x20, 4HR, 10RBI), **Milan Tolentino** is hitting .198/.284/.275 with 1HR and 14RBI in 26G. He's starting to snap out of it, with Saturday's grand slam ending an 83AB homerless drought and back to back multi-hit games in this series (2K in last 3G, 12PA; had 16K in 7G prior, 24PA). He had 2SB last night (12th multi-SB game of career).

Back on Track

In the last 15G, the Columbus bullpen has a 3.04ERA (56.1IP, 19ER), 3rd best in the IL (3ER or fewer in all 15G, longest streak of the year). Clipper relievers allowed 21ER in 10.1IP of the 2G prior to the streak, as the relief ERA rose to 6.08 (worst in the IL, currently 17th at 5.32; starters have a 5.46ERA, 16th). Relievers allowed 1HR to 182BF from 5/10-5/22, but have given up 3HR to 68BF since.

This Date in Clipper History

5/29/2017

Eric Stamets homered in both of his at bats (3RBI) to lead the Clippers to a 12-4 victory over Norfolk, while **Adam Moore** added a grand slam. Stamets was a man among boys in the Memorial Day Weekend series vs. Norfolk, collecting multi-hit games in all four (.846, 11x13), including nine extra-base hits (four doubles, 5HR). He also had 12RBI, including three straight with at least 3RBI.

Huntington (Small) Park

In each of the first 11 seasons after the move downtown (2009-19), Huntington Park ranked among the top two in the IL in homers per game. With the arrival of six new parks to the IL in 2021, Huntington Park finished 4th, 6th and 10th from 2021-23, respectively. The 2024 season saw a return to the top (2.96; 108HR hit by the Clippers, most for the home team in HP's existence), but it dropped back to 7th last year (2.31). Including the postseason, the Clippers have been out-homered over the life of the park (1,429 to 1,376).

Challenging Times

The Clippers are 77-71 (.520) in pitch reviews, with batters going 43-46 (.483) and pitchers/catchers going 34-25 (.576). They have run out of challenges in 29G and have not challenged in 3G. Last season, they were correct 43.1% of the time (2nd worst in the IL).

Extras, Read All About Them

Columbus is 1-3 in extra innings this season, after having gone 5-5 in 2025 and 9-9 in 2024 (most losses since 2013, 12). Since the start of the 2018 season, when baserunners started appearing at second base, the Clippers are 51-36 when playing past regulation (.586, best in the IL; no other team above .570), including 26-17 at home (.605, but 4-7 in last 11G). Of the 87G to require extra play, 69 have been resolved after one frame (including eight DH games) and only one has gone past the 12th (5-4 loss in 13 innings on 9/20/22 at Toledo). From 7/31/19-6/26/21, Columbus played 85 straight within the allotted innings.

On the Runs

Starting with the embiggened 150G schedule in 2022, the Clippers scored over 800 runs in three consecutive seasons from 2022-2024 (855, 808 and 805 runs, respectively; accounting for the 3rd, 4th and 5th best totals in team history). Following a steep decline last season (670, fewest scored in a full season since 2018), Columbus is looking to easily top 800 again, with an outside chance to establish a new team high (on pace for 846, would rank as 4th most all-time; 898 scored in 1983).

On the Run

On the basepaths, the Clippers are making a run at the franchise mark in stolen bases, with 76 through the first 53G (on pace for 214SB). The team record was set in 2024 when Columbus swiped an even 200, but the team speed was throttled last year (129SB; still, the 2nd highest total since the Cleveland affiliation started in 2009). However, with 18CS so far, the Clippers are also pacing (51) for the most times caught stealing of the Cleveland affiliation (nabbed 79 times in 2008, last time over 51).

Juiced is Loose

In the Huntington Park Era (since 2009), Columbus leads the IL with 78 grand slams and 1,929RBI (led IL in RBI in 2010, '11, '12, '17, '18 and '22). Collecting an IL-best 10 grand slams last season, it marked their fifth straight season with at least four (118RBI last year; had only 97RBI in 2024, worst in a 140+G season since 2016).

Hits the Spot

When turning in as many or fewer hits than their opponents last season, the Clippers went 18-64 (.220), coming in 13th out of 20 in the IL. The 2024 season saw them post an IL-worst .185 (12-53) winning percentage in such games. When allowing at least 10 hits last year, Columbus was 7-41 (.146, 20th in the IL; started the season 1-20).

In Big Trouble

The Clipper pitching staff is trending toward the worst ERA in club history, sitting at 5.39 through the first 53G. Since the reorganization of the minor leagues in 2021, Columbus has twice finished the season with a 5+ ERA (current record is 5.32, set in 2023), after having done so just once in the first 43 seasons (5.08 in 1983). However, the staff is pacing to give up only 147HR (lowest total since 133HR in 2018; averaging 182 per season since the Year of the Homer in 2019).

Department of Defense

The Columbus defense is sitting at 12th in the IL this year (.978), following a 2025 that saw a franchise record (.985, led the IL). On 4/10 at Worcester, the defense collapsed for the first 5E game since 8/27/24 (topped out at 3E in a game twice last year and had fewer than 5E in 21 of 26 series). The Clippers have played flawlessly in 28G this season (17-11, .607), after doing so in nearly 60% of games last year (44-42, .512), including 16 straight from 6/20-7/8/25 (longest streak in the IL over the last 20 years).

Key to Victory

From 2022-23, Columbus owned the best record in the IL when holding opponents to three runs or fewer, going 95-8 (.922, no other team was above .880). The Clippers were 43-10 in such games in 2024 (.811, 13th in the IL), accumulating four losses by 4/14, and were just 47-10 (.825, 9th) last year, collecting four losses over 14G from 4/23-5/9 (had four losses total in both 2022 and 2023).

Good Baseball

Kody Huff bunted a run in, while moving another to scoring position in a 5/24 win vs. Louisville. Since the start of the 2018 season, Columbus is 87-23 (.791) in games in which a run is scored after a good bunt attempt, including a 4-2 mark this season (.667, blew 7-run lead in one of the losses; went 23-2 in 2018).

To the End

The Clippers had the 6th most last at bat losses last season (17), after pacing the circuit with 23 in 2024 (tied with Toledo). They also suffered the 4th most walk-off losses (8), watching three in a row slip away at Rochester from 5/29-5/31. The 2024 season saw 41G decided in the last at bat (tied for 2nd most in the IL, one off lead), with Columbus going 18-23 in those contests (-17th, .439).

Manager Profile

Andy Tracy made his Clippers debut in 2021, following **Tony Mansolino's** championship rookie year in 2019 (sixth Clipper skipper to win Governors' Cup in first season; **Gene Michael**-'79, **Joe Altobelli**-'80, **Frank Verdi**-'81, **Bucky Dent**-'87 and **Mike Sarbaugh**-'10). This season marks Tracy's sixth year as a manager (first was with Williamsport in the Philadelphia system), as he holds a career record of 414-431 (.490), 384-385 with Columbus (.499).
