Starting Matchup: Lansing starts right-hander **Jake Walkinshaw**, making his seventh start of the season and eighth overall appearance, against Loons left-handed opener **Ben Harris**, making his third start for Great Lakes.

Last Night: Loons 12, Lugnuts 3. **Damon Keith** hit two solo home runs, and **Eddys Leonard** and **Aldrich De Jongh** hit two-run shots to lift the Loons, who scored 11 unanswered runs. In defeat, the Lugnuts received roundtrippers from **Denzel Clarke** and **Shane McGuire**.

Skipper for the Series: Lugnuts manager **Phil Pohl** is away for this week; **Veronica Alvarez** steps in as interim Lugnuts manager through Sunday. A standout at Villanova, Alvarez served as the starting catcher for Team USA Baseball Women's National Team, winning medals in 2008 (bronze), 2010 (bronze), 2012 (silver) and 2015 (gold). She joined the Team USA's coaching staff as assistant coach in 2018, rising to manager of the Women's National Team beginning in 2019, when she led Team USA to a 7-0 record and the gold medal at the Women's Baseball World Cup Qualifier in Mexico, earning her the honor of 2019 USA Baseball Rod Dedeaux Coach of the Year. Since 2019, she has worked as a coach in Spring Training for the Oakland Athletics.

Welcome to the Show: The first 2021 Lansing Lugnut to reach the Major Leagues, **Norge Ruiz**, was called up today to the Majors by the Oakland Athletics. Born in La Habana, Cuba, the 28-year-old Ruiz made four appearances in relief for the Lugnuts last season, tossing 5 2/3 innings. This year, he had a 3.83 ERA in 30 appearances with the Las Vegas Aviators. When he makes his MLB debut, he'll become the 171st Lugnut to reach The Show all time and the tenth this season.

Updated Prospect List: MLB Pipeline has updated its Top 30 A's Prospects, with **Max Muncy** moving to No. 7, **Denzel Clarke** jumping up to No. 11, **Joey Estes** remaining stable at No. 16, **Euribiel Angeles** now at No. 16, **Brayan Buevas** now at No. 23 and **Cooper Bowman** remaining No. 29. **Jorge Juan** fell off the list entirely (though if yesterday's three hitless innings with five strikeouts serves as an indicator, only temporarily). The Athletics' top five 2022 draft picks, all likely future Lugnuts, were each ranked: first-round catcher **Daniel Susac** at No. 5, second-round outfielder **Henry Bolte** at No. 6, compensatory second-round outfielder **Clark Elliott** at No. 13, third-round outfielder **Colby Thomas** at No. 16 and fourth-round pitcher **Jacob Watters** at No. 27.

Running Men: The Lugnuts have 24 steals in 30 attempts through 15 games in August, averaging two stolen bases attempts per game. The increasingly aggressive Lugnuts had eight stolen bases in April, 14 steals in May, 18 steals in June and 31 steals in July.

Amongst the League Leaders: The Lugnuts are third in the Midwest League in team batting average (.244) and third in base hits (886). Reliever **Kumar Nambiar** has 38 appearances, second only to West Michigan's **Andrew Magno**. Infielder **Euribiel Angeles** is sixth with 96 base hits.

• Phil briefly played for the independent Laredo Lemurs in 2015, managed by Pete Incaviglia, hitting .311/.407/.473 with three home runs in 23 games. Laredo finished 57-43 and won the American Association championship.

• Since Phil is a native of Cooperstown, the National Baseball Hall of Fame is following his career closely. His gameworn Lugnuts baseball cap from the season's first weekend was sent to the Hall of Fame, by request.

Inside the Park and Out of This World: On August 2-3, 2022, CF **Denzel Clarke** joined Fred Bello (Everett, July 2-3, 2010) as the only Minor Leaguers since 2005 to have inside-the-park home runs in back-to-back games. The feat has never occurred in the Major Leagues.

Roster Crunch: The Lugnuts have used 51 different players this year: 25 position players and 26 pitchers (plus two position players pitching), with 18 different starting pitchers.

From Far and Wide: The Lugnuts include players from 10 different countries: USA, Brazil, Canada, Colombia, Cuba, Dominican Republic, Japan, Mexico, Panama and Venezuela in addition to Puerto Rico and 11 different states: Arizona, California, Colorado, Connecticut, Hawaii, Idaho, New York, Pennsylvania, South Dakota, Texas and Washington.

They Know Their Trade: Lansing has four players acquired by the Athletics via trade: **Cooper Bowman** (New York Yankees, acquired 8/1/22); **Christian Fernandez** (Tampa Bay Rays, 7/9/22); **Euribiel Angeles** (San Diego Padres, 4/3/22); and **Joey Estes** (Atlanta Braves, 3/14/22).

To the Show: Nine former Nuts have debuted in MLB in 2022, 170 all-time: A's pitchers **Zach Logue** (2018) and **Zach Jackson** (2017) and infielder **Christian Lopes** (2013); Blue Jays utilityman **Vinny Capra** (2018), catcher **Gabriel Moreno** (2019) and pitcher **Max Castillo** (2018); M's reliever **Danny Young** (2016); and Red Sox pitcher **Josh Winckowski** (2019) and Marlins pitcher **Jake Fishman** (2017).

TODAY IN LUGNUTS HISTORY

2016: Manager John Schneider mandated that the Lugnuts show up only two hours before Saturday's series opener against South Bend at Cooley Law School Stadium. The offense showed up late during the game – but scored five runs in the bottom of the 8th for a 5-2 victory, ending a four-game losing streak, before a roaring crowd of 8,404. The rally included two run-scoring wild pitches from Cubs reliever Jared Cheek and a two-run tie-breaking triple from Justin Atkinson.

Take Two: Joined Lugnuts in initial flight from Spring Training and was scheduled to be part of the starting rotation, but was placed on Injured List on Opening Day and flew back to Arizona (elbow)... made two Arizona Complex League starts in rehab, totaling 4 2/3 IP... flew to Double-A Midland on June 24 to be ready in case of emergency, but was not needed... returned to Lugnuts on June 28, tossing three scoreless innings at Lake County.

Back to the Rotation: Allowed just two runs in 20 innings in first five starts with the Lugnuts (5 BB / 26 K, .181 avg.)... made first relief appearance on August 12, taking over for Jorge Juan one out into the 2nd inning... blanked the West Michigan Whitecaps through the 3rd, 4th and 5th innings, but then allowed seven runs in the 6th, capped by a three-run homer to center field by Trei Cruz.

In the Classroom: Attained Bachelor's degree in Sport Management in three years at SNHU, posting a 3.88 GPA, then attained his MBA, focusing on project management, with a 4.0 GPA... interned in the SNHU athletic department, filming sporting events... twice was named Northeast 10 (NE10) Academic All-Conference and was named Academic All-District as a grad student.

On the Field: In high school, played shortstop when not pitching, batting second in the lineup... turned in an outstanding college career at SNHU, finishing 23-5, 16 saves – 11 in 2016, 2nd most in a season in school history – 1.93 career ERA, 76 G, 22 GS, 233 IP, 168 H, 62 BB, 234 K... finished 2nd in career wins, 2nd in ERA, 4th in strikeouts and 5th in innings pitched in SNHU record books... other NE10 rivals included Lake County's Zach Hart (Franklin Pierce University) and former Lugnut and current Stockton Port Edward Baram (Adelphi)... in 2019, named D-II East All-Region First Team, ABCA East All-Region Second Team, NCBWA East All-Region Second Team, and NE10 All-Conference First Team... SNHU was ranked No. 17 in the nation, but lost in the NCAA East-Super Regional to NYIT, finishing one victory shy of punching its ticket to the D-II College World Series in Cary, N.C.

The Penmen? Yes, SNHU's nickname is the Penmen, created by the editorial cartoonist of the Union Leader, Bob Murphy. Southern New Hampshire University was originally founded as New Hampshire College of Accounting and Commerce. The "pen" refers to the quill used by an accountant of colonial New Hampshire. The current logo, however, shows a Revolutionary War patriot holding an American flag bravely rushing forward.

Into the Workforce: Currently serves as Special Project Coordinator at Advanced Theory & Performance (ATP)... first came to ATP while rehabbing from Tommy John surgery in 2017, leading to post-college work opportunity.

Going Pro: Signed with the Athletics for \$1,000... debuted in 2019 with A's Green in the Arizona League, making 18 relief appearances, holding lefties to .200 avg. while righties hit .302... moved up to Stockton in 2021, converting from relief pitcher to starter, and had similar success vs. lefties (.248) compared to righties (.320)... worked this past offseason to change the spin of his slider to get more horizontal and vertical movement, seeking increased swing and miss.
