Keeping it Rolling

Tonight, Reading seeks its fourth-straight win on the road at the Hartford Yard Goats. It is the second series of the season between the teams and Reading's first repeat opponent. Hartford took 4/6 from the R-Phils in the first series at FirstEnergy Stadium from April 11-16. Hartford comes to Reading again from June 13-18 and the season series finishes in Hartford from August 1-6.

A "Storm" of Runs

Last night, Reading captured a rain-shortened 12-6 victory to take the 2-0 series lead over Hartford this week. Fightins starter David Parkinson allowed four runs in the bottom of the first inning, but the R-Phils responded with five runs in the second and would never give up the lead. Reading tacked on crooked numbers the next three innings and with a 12-6 lead in the sixth, the game went into a rain delay and was then called.

Newcomers "Pouring" It On

The emergence of new faces Drew Ellis and Garrett Whitley conitnued last night. After homering on Tuesday, Whitley chipped in with a hit, RBI and run to now reach base in both of his starts so far. Ellis introduced himself to the Reading fans with a two-run home run in the third inning last night. Whitley and Ellis have now each homered in back-to-back games.

Ethan's "Rain" of Excellence

Ethan Wilson homered for the second-straight game last night. Marking the second time he has homered in back-to-back games this season. Prior to this season, Wilson had never homered in back-to-back contests, and now he has done it twice in a one-week span. Wilson now has four home runs in just 11 games and 41 plate appearences. Last year, Wilson didn't his hit fourth home run until June 25, his 64th game of that season.

Lopsided Wins

Reading has now picked up three lopsided vicories in its last three series. The R-Phils had a 10-1 win at Portland two-weeks ago, an 11-5 win against Altoona last week and now a 12-6 victory last night. With those victories, Reading now holds a +2 run differential this season and leads the league in hitting at .252. But, the R-Phils sit six-games below .500 after a slow start to the season.

Around the Organization

The Philadelphia Phillies suffered a heartbreaking 10-6 loss at the Dodgers yesterday afternoon. The Phillies are off today before opening a weekend series with Boston on Friday. Lehigh Valley and Syracuse were rained out last night. Jersey Shore fell 4-0 to Hickory, but Clearwater picked up its ninth-straight win with a 13-7 victory over Lakeland. The Threshers are in first in the FSL West with a 17-6 record on the season.

This Day in Baseballtown History

May 4, 2021: After a 607-day hiatus without baseball at FirstEnergy Stadium due to the Coronavirus pandemic, the R-Phils returned home in front of 2,620 fans. Despite the Opening Day loss, the offense gave the fans plenty to cheer for, as Arquimedes Gamboa, Luke Miller and Dalton Guthrie all went deep.

Hey Hartford

This is the second time in just four weeks that Reading and Hartford match up. Hartford enters tonight with an 11-10 record on the season. Last week, Hartford took four-of-five games on the road at New Hampshire, including four-straight win to finish the series. After this week, Hartford hits the road for seven games in six days at Binghamton, which includes a doubleheader on May 10, where Hartofrd will be home for one of the games, due to a postponement on April 23 in Hartford.

The Ruff Report

Righty Mike Ruff gets the ball for Hartford tonight. He is making his fourth start of the season and owns a 4.38 ERA. Ruff allowed seven hits and three runs in 3.2 innings at Reading on Apr. 14. He last pitched one-week ago today and allowed four hits and three runs at New Hampshire.
