History vs. Quad Cities

The Lugnuts are 75-82 all-time vs. the River Bandits, 41-37 at home and 34-45 in Davenport.

After not meeting up at all in 2021 and 2022, the Lugnuts and River Bandits played 12 games against one another in 2023. Lansing went 7-5, 3-3 in QC.

Last year, the Nuts went 2-4 at Quad Cities, held in late August. Future Royal Jac Caglianone went 6-for-25, .240, .589 OPS, with 2 doubles, 1 walk, 4 strikeouts. The Nuts batted .188 and scored 20 runs in the series.

Last Night: River Bandits 8, Lugnuts 4. The Nuts dealt a blow to Quad Cities' postseason hopes, waiting out a 77-minute rain delay and tossing a combined four-hit shutout behind **Jake Garland's** 6 2/3 scoreless innings and a five-out save from **Mark Adamiak**. Former Bandit **Jared Dickey** drove in two runs and scored the third run.

On Deck: The Lugnuts and River Bandits open up the second half tomorrow, playing one another through Sunday. Then the Nuts return home June 24-29 vs. Dayton.

Prospecting: The Lugnuts have six of MLB Pipeline's Top 30 A's prospects: No. 8 prospect (**Tommy White**), No. 11 (**Joshua Kuroda-Grauer**), No. 13 (**Steven Echavarria**), No. 17 (**Ryan Lasko**), No. 18 (**Rodney Green, Jr.**) and No. 28 (**Nate Nankil**). Overall, 21 of the 30 prospects have seen time in Lansing.

All-Star Voting Update: In the first All-Star voting update, 2017 Lugnut **Vladimir Guerrero, Jr.** is 2nd for A.L. first baseman to the Yankees' Paul Goldschmidt, 2023 Lugnut **Jacob Wilson** leads the balloting at A.L. shortstop over Bobby Witt, Jr. (562,696-519,984, with 2017 Lug **Bo Bichette** coming in 4th), and 2019 Lugnut **Alejandro Kirk** is 2nd for A.L. catcher behind the M's Cal Raleigh.

From Lansing to the Majors? Only two players in franchise history have ever gone from the Lugnuts to the Major Leagues in the same season, **Jose Santiago** in 1997 and **Kendall Graveman** in 2014. This year, **Gustavo Rodriguez** is making a bid to achieve the feat. A member of the Peoria Chiefs who was signed as a Minor League free agent in the offseason, Rodriguez made six scoreless relief appearances with the Lugnuts earlier this season, then seven scoreless appearances with Double-A Midland, and yesterday turned in his four straight scoreless outing for Triple-A Las Vegas, striking out the side in a perfect ninth inning in a 7-1 victory. The native Venezuelan has worked 17 scoreless innings in 17 games total this year: seven hits, five walks, 23 strikeouts.

Best in the Minors: Lansing first baseman **T.J. Schofield-Sam** ranks 1st in MiLB with a .353 batting average; closer **Mark Adamiak** is tied for 1st in MiLB in saves (11); Opening Day starter **Gage Jump** is 1st in wins (8); and 2023 Lugnut **Colby Thomas** (currently with Triple-A Las Vegas) ranks atop the minors in base hits (85), total bases (157), runs batted in (63) and extra-base hits (36). Thomas led MiLB in extra-base hits last year with 80.

A Little More on T.J.: Schofield-Sam went 3-for-4 with a walk and two RBI singles last night, giving him a league-leading 78 base hits this season. He also ranks 2nd in OPS (.954), 2nd in total bases (116), 3rd in OBP (.429), 3rd in slugging (.525), tied for 3rd in triples (4) and 4th in runs scored (42).

Hawkeye on the Hill: Lansing starter, Pella native and University of Iowa product **Grant Judkins** returns to pitch in his home state tonight. Judkins – the 2016 Iowa Gatorade Player of the Year, two-time All-Iowa Baseball Player of the Year, and three-time 1st Team All-State – is one of eight Midwest Leaguers with a complete game this season and is 4th in the league with 61 innings pitched. In Grant's first pro start in Iowa, August 23, 2024, at Quad Cities, he tossed 2 1/3 innings in a no-decision, allowing three runs on four hits and two walks, striking out one. The Lugnuts rallied to force extra innings on a Will Simpson home run in the eighth, then beat the River Bandits in the 11th, 7-6, on a Nate Nankil sacrifice fly.

The Men in the Pen: The Lugnuts have four of the six most heavily used relievers in the league. **Blaze Pontes** leads the league with 23 appearances, **Mark Adamiak** is tied for 2nd with 22 appearances, and **Hunter Breault** and **Yehizon Sanchez** are tied for 4th in the league with 21 appearances.

Welcome Back to the QC: Outfielder **Jared Dickey** was drafted by the Kansas City Royals in the 11th round in 2023 from Tennessee, played 82 games for the River Bandits in 2024, was traded to the Athletics at the deadline last year, and returned to Quad Cities last August to slug his 10th home run of the season. Dickey, tied for 5th in the MWL in walks (40), has supplied extra-base RBI hits in each of the first two games of the series: an RBI triple on Tuesday and a two-run double last night.

JUNE 19TH IN LUGNUTS HISTORY

2008: The bad: Luis Perez balked twice. The good: He struck out nine batters in seven shutout innings, allowing four hits and one walk, and the Lugnuts blanked Fort Wayne, 4-0, in front of 7,423 at Oldsmobile Park.

2011: The Lugnuts owned the Eastern Division for the majority of the first half... but late struggles dropped the team into third place. On the final day of the first half, Lansing needed both a win at Dayton and a Great Lakes loss to Fort Wayne in order to make the playoffs. Jake Marisnick set the tone immediately at Fifth Third Field, leading off the game with a home run, and Drew Hutchison extended his shutout streak to 27 innings with six scoreless frames in a dominant 8-2 victory. Meanwhile, the TinCaps upset the Loons, vaulting the Lugnuts into the playoffs.

2018: TThe Lugnuts hosted their fourth Midwest League All-Star Game, drawing 9,396. In the pre-game Home Run Derby, Bowling Green Hot Rods catcher Ronaldo Hernandez put on an impressive power display to capture the title. Then the Eastern Division beat the West, 3-2, in ten innings, thanks to a two-out game-winning RBI single from Dayton Dragons first baseman Montrell Marshall, driving in teammate Stuart Fairchild from second base..

April 19 at Wisconsin: tossed the first complete game of the season in the Midwest League, firing six innings in the series finale, a 2-0 loss... a notable stat: the opposition is 5-for-41 (.122) in the 1st inning – but 4 of the 5 hits are solo home runs... of 11 home runs allowed, six came on the first pitch of an at-bat... eight HRs allowed are solo shots.

Last Game: Woof. On Friday the 13th, pitched two innings plus seven batters into the 3rd... gave up Isaac Pacheco solo home run in the 2nd inning, and then a two-run homer to Seth Stephenson and a three-run homer to Johnny Peck in the 3rd in what turned into a 13-run Whitecaps rally, leading into a 20-6 loss... was tagged for nine hits and eight runs in all.

No-No History: Facing the Cedar Rapids Kernels on June 13, 2024, relieved Jake Garland to open the 6th inning and tossed 2 2/3 hitless innings, walking one and striking out three, as part of the Lugnuts' 8-0 combined no-hitter of the Kernels... it was the 4th no-hitter in franchise history as well as the first home no-hitter since 2003.

At Pella High School: 2016 Iowa Gatorade Player of the Year as a senior... Des Moines Register's All-Iowa Baseball Player of the Year as both a junior and a senior, 2015 and 2016... 2015 Perfect Game Underclass High Honorable Mention... as a senior: 10-1, 0.64 ERA, 123 K, batting .421 with six homers and 12 steals... as a junior: 11-1, 0.56 ERA, 74 IP, 112 K, 10 BB, batting .520 with 14 doubles, nine triples, 13 homers, 57 RBIs, 51 runs, 15 steals... won 28 career games and totaled 337 career strikeouts.

Onward to Des Moines: Entered the 2017 Big Ten season ranked by Baseball America as the No. 8 freshman... two-way player, hitting .270 in 31 starts as a DH (and three starts as a pitcher hitting for himself)... 2018 Academic All-Big Ten... No. 3 starter in 2019; 2019 Collegiate Baseball Player National Pitcher of the Week (Feb. 18), tossing six no-hit innings with 11 strikeouts; ranked 7th in the Big Ten in ERA (2.72)... No. 2 starter in 2020 before season was halted early due to the pandemic: 2-0, 3.00, 4 GS, 21 IP, 24 K, 5 BB.

International Stage: With Iowa, took part in the 2017 World University Games in Taipei City, winning a silver medal (fell to Japan in the gold medal contest)... part of the first American team to ever advance to the gold medal game as well as the first American team to ever medal, period... team finished 5-2, losing only to Japan... started five games, four at first base, one at pitcher.
