STEPHAN, HATCHER STEER RIDERS TO 2-1 VICTORY:

The Frisco RoughRiders edged the San Antonio Missions 2-1 on Thursday night from Nelson W. Wolff Municipal Stadium. Frisco (37-28) starter **Josh Stephan** (5-2) earned the victory while pitching a career-high tying seven innings, allowing one unearned run while striking out five. The RoughRiders struck first in the top of the third when Josh Hatcher muscled a two-run homer to give to grab a 2-0 lead. San Antonio (37-29) then answered in the bottom of the fourth when Romeo Sanabria served a single, trimming Frisco's lead to 2-1. In the bottom of the ninth, Missions designated hitter Brandon Valenzuela hit a lead-off single. RoughRiders reliever Skylar Hales then picked up a strikeout, induced a fielder's choice and another strikeout to earn the save. Frisco reliever Travis MacGregor pitched a scoreless eighth inning to earn his 10th hold of the season, tied for the most in MiLB. San Antonio starter Jared Kollar (0-2) picked up the loss, yielding two runs across four frames.

CHASE FOR THE TITLE:

The RoughRiders are in first place by 0.5 games ahead of San Antonio in the Texas League South with three games remaining in the first half. They now have a 0.5-game lead on Midland as well. They still control their own destiny in the chase and would capture a playoff spot with either two wins and a Midland loss in the last three games or three wins. If they win the first half title, their seventh time in franchise history that they clinched a playoff spot in the first half and their second-straight season doing so.

TOUGH START IN THE ALAMO CITY ON OFFENSE:

Frisco has just three extra-base hits in the first three games of this series with while hitting .221 (23-for-104)/.283/.269/.552 with only four runs scored, the fewest in the league. Frisco is just 2-for-21 with runners in scoring position this week. On Wednesday, the Riders struck out 19 times, which is a franchise record for their most strikeouts in a nine-inning game. Both walk-off losses for Frisco have been at the hands of the Missions this season.

After homering 15 times in their previous 12 games, the Riders have homered just once in their nine games without a home run. Frisco has hit just two home runs in their last 10 games while averaging 2.7 runs per game and slashing .206/.288/.274/.562. They are 5-5 in those games because of a 3.09 ERA on the pitching side, which is second in the league. Their three home runs allowed in the last 10 games are the fewest in the league.

MISSION ACCOMPLISHED:

The RoughRiders dominated the San Antonio Missions all season and the Riders have had plenty of head-to-head success against the Missions over the years. In 2024, Frisco went 20-4 against San Antonio and have gone 65-34 against them since they rejoined the Texas League in 2021, including 38-14 at the Wolff. In those 51 games in San Antonio, Frisco has a 2.55 ERA, which is the best of any team in the Texas League. At the end of this six-game series in San Antonio, only Corpus Christi (60) will have played more games by a visting team at The Wolff than Frisco (55).

SAVE TONIGHT:

The RoughRiders have had 11 different pitchers record a save in 2025. Frisco was the first team in Minor League Baseball to accomplish the feat this season. Gavin Collyer are leads the team saves (six) for the Riders, a mark that is tied for third in the Texas League. Their 23 saves are the second-most in all of Minor League Baseball, just trailing Triple-A Jacksonville's 25. Their 4.24 bullpen ERA is sixth in the league. In June, their 3.28 reliever ERA is fourth in the Texas League.

OVER THE WALL-COTT:

Rangers top prospect **Sebastian Walcott** has been displaying the power as of late. In his last 31 games, he has blasted six home runs while slashing .267/.362/.483/.845 with eight doubles, 20 RBIs, 20 runs scored and 18 walks to 23 strikeouts. This season, his walk rate of 12.9 percent is a career high while he is striking out at just 20.4 percent, a career low. His 16 doubles lead the league and his 24 extra-base hits also pace the league. His 16 doubles through 65 games are tied for the fifth most by a Double-A teenager since 2005, trailing just Oscar Taveras (19), Vladimir Guerrero Jr. (18), Fernando Martinez (18) and Fernando Tatís Jr. (18). In 16 June games, he has walked 14 times and struck out 10 times.

DOUBLE-A DOUBL-A RON:

Aaron Zavala has been on fire at the plate for the Riders. After a dreadful start, batting just .077 (2-for-26) through 10 games, he is hitting .302 (49-for-162)/.415/.475/.890 over his last 45 games. He leads the Texas League in walks (44) and is third in OBP (.409) while leading the league in walk rate (18.6 percent). In his last 19 games, he is hitting .307 (23-for-75)/.388/.480/.868 with two doubles, three home runs and seven RBIs. In his Frisco career, he has earned 200 walks over four seasons (297 games), which is second in franchise history. He is just six walks away from tying the franchise record for walks, held by Guilder Rodriguez with 206 from 2009-2015 (527 games).

ABOUT DAVID

-In 2021, he was signed by the New York Mets for \$30,000 as a free agent, but did not pitch. After the contract was voided, he then signed with the Rangers for \$10,000 in 2022.

-Father, David, has spent 16 seasons as an MiLB coach in the Mets organization and was named the 2019 Mets MiLB Coach of the Year as the NYM Culf Coast League manager. Both his grandfather, Pompeyo, and great-uncle, Vic, played Major League Baseball. His younger brother, Gabriel, signed with the Angels in January of 2025 as a catcher and is currently their No. 14 prospect.

2025 SEASON

-Entered the season as the No. 16 prospect in the Rangers organization by Baseball America. He also was listed as having the best curveball in the organization by Baseball America.

-No. 28 prospect in the Rangers system by MLB.com.

-Dominated in first 10 starts in High-A Hub City, going 4-0 with $1.09\ ERA$ while striking out 68 batters in 49.1 innings to just $11\ walks$.

-Went 3-0 with 0.96 ERA over five May starts, whiffing 35 in 28.0 innings to just four walks while holding opponents to a .152 batting average against. He was named South Atlantic League Pitcher of the Month.

-Won South Atlantic League Pitcher of the Week on 4/20.

-Struggled in final High-A start, allowing a career-high six runs over 1.2 innings against Wilmington on 6/13.
