TONIGHT'S GAME

The Round Rock Express and Sugar Land Space Cowboys (Houston Astros) get set for Opening Day 2026. This will be the second consecutive year Round Rock has opened the season on the road. They opened 2025 in Tacoma for a three-game series and were swept. The Express and Space Cowboys have faced each other one other time on Opening Day (2024) but it was at Dell Diamond. Sugar Land earned a 4-2 victory. Space Cowboys CF Joey Loperfido had a first-inning homer and went 1-for-4 with 3 RBI, R. Only two players who appeared on Opening Day for the Express in 2024 remain in the Rangers organization (INF Justin Foscue, RHP Cole Winn).

TOP 30 RANGERS PROSPECTS

The club features three of the top 30 prospects in the Texas Rangers organization, according to MLB.com. The E-Train is led by INF Cameron Cauley who checks in as the No. 13 prospect in the Rangers organization. RHP Emiliano Teodo is labeled as the No. 17 prospect while RHP Gavin Collyer rounds out the group as the No. 30 prospect.

HOME COOKING

INF Cameron Cauley grew up 56 miles from Constellation Field in Mont Belvieu, Texas where he attended Barbers Hill High School. Cauley was drafted in the third round (73rd overall) in the 2021 MLB Draft out of high school. During 2026 Cactus League play with the Texas Rangers, Cauley hit .300 (12-40) with five doubles and a home run. On March 14, he led all hitters in Spring Training and the World Baseball Classic in hard hit balls (23). INF Bobby Witt Jr. (22) was second on the list with INF Matt McLain (20) and INF Junior Caminero (20) at third and fourth.

TEXAS TIES

The roster features five players born in Texas. RHP Ryan Brasier (Wichita Falls), INF Cameron Cauley (Houston), RHP Josh Stephan (DeSoto), RHP Trey Supak (Bryan) and RHP Mason Thompson (Round Rock). Cauley won the 2021 5A UIL State Championship at Dell Diamond for Barbers Hill High School.

GETTING OFF ON THE RIGHT FOOT

The E-Train have lost on Opening Day for the past four seasons. Their last win came against Oklahoma City on May 6, 2021 at Dell Diamond. Round Rock's all-time record on Opening Day is 9-16 and 4-8 when starting on the road. They have never played on March 27 as today marks the earliest start in club history.

WE KNOW THOSE GUYS

INF Jax Biggers and OF Kellen Strahm will open the season with the Space Cowboys after appearing in a combined 294 games with the Express over parts of the previous four seasons. Both players signed minor league contracts with the Houston Astros in the offseason.

HOME OPENER ON TUESDAY

The Express will open the 2026 home slate at Dell Diamond on Tuesday, March 31 at 7:05 p.m. against the Gwinnett Stripers (Atlanta Braves). It will be the second consecutive year they will open at home against an International League opponent (Toledo Mud Hens).

ON THIS DAY IN NOLAN RYAN HISTORY - SATURDAY, MARCH 27, 1982

In St. Petersburg, Florida, Nolan Ryan made one of his final starts of the 1982 Houston Astros Spring Training as the Astros took down the St. Louis Cardinals, 2-1. Ryan went 7.0 innings with one earned run and seven hits to earn the win. The Cardinals scored on a fielder's choice from INF Ken Oberkfell. C Alan Knicely, a converted pitcher, had a solo homer to break the tie for Houston. Ryan had to face the Cardinals 10 days later on Opening Day 1982 and got the loss. The Cardinals earned a 14-3 win as Ryan allowed six earned runs in 3.0

- Was named PCL Pitcher of the Month for Aug., posting a league-best 1.71 ERA (5 ER/26.1 IP) and 0.99 WHIP in 5 GS for RR during the month.
- Best start of campaign came with RR on 9/3 at ABQ (7.0 IP, 3 H, 0 R, 0 BB, 6 SO), earning him PCL Pitcher of the Week honors for 9/1-7.
- Has spent time in the Pittsburgh (2014-2015), Milwaukee (2016-2020), Athletics (2021-2023) and Cubs (2024) organizations prior to joining Texas.
- Selected by Pittsburgh in Competitive Balance Round B of the First-Year Player Draft in 2014 (73rd overall).
- Traded to the Milwaukee Brewers with minor league outfielder Keon Broxton for infielder Jason Rogers, December 17, 2015.
- Helped La Grange High School win the 3A 2013 UIL Texas State Baseball Championship...3A was played at Disch-Falk Field...Supak was named to the All-Tournament team.
- Was the first player drafted from La Grange since pitcher Homer Bailey by Cincinnati in 2004.
