For the second night in a row, the Wichita Wind Surge struck for a run in the first inning and held the lead the entire game, as the Northwest Arkansas Naturals lost 4-2.

- Both Naturals runs came off the bat of third baseman Nate Eaton, who scored Seuly Matias on a Wind surge error in the fourth, then tripled home Michael Massey in the sixth inning.
- Robbie Glendinning and Tucker Bradley each reached base as well, with Glendinning drawing two walks and Bradley walking and singling.
- Leadoff hitter Maikel Garcia reached for the seventh consecutive game with a fifth inning single, the only Natural to reach base in every game this season.
- Starting pitcher Anthony Veneziano allowed all four runs, striking out three batters across 3.0 innings. After Veneziano, relievers Yefri Del Rosario and Zack Phillips combined for 6.0 scoreless innings, keeping Northwest Arkansas within striking distance for the rest of the night.
- Del Rosario is one of two Naturals pitchers who has not allowed a run yet this season, his 5.1 scoreless innings just barely edge out **Ándres Sotillet**'s 4.2 scoreless innings. However, Del Rosario has walked four batters and struck out two, while Sotillet has not walked a batter and struck out four.

# This Day in Naturals History

# The Naturals are 2-11 all-time when playing on April 16

On April 16, 2009, the Northwest Arkansas Naturals walked off on the San Antonio Missions, a 5-4 win at Arvest Ballpark for the fifth walkoff win in club history. All nine Naturals hitters in the starting lineup recorded hits, with **Jose Duarte** collecting two hits and **Corey Smith** hitting his first home run of the season. After Duarte singled to lead off the bottom of the ninth, stole second base and advanced to third on a wild pitch, Joe Dickerson singled him in for the victory.

# THE CHAMPS ARE HERE!

Of the 28-man roster the Naturals rolled out for the Double-A Central Championship Series in 2021, seven players are on the Naturals' 2022 active roster, with a total of 10 returning players with the Naturals this season.

- Pitchers Yefri Del Rosario, Drew Parrish, Andrés Sotillet, Stephen Woods Jr. and Angel Zerpa were all a part of the championship celebration last year, as was catcher Tyler Cropley and outfielder Seuly
   Matias.
- Additionally, development list player Holden Capps was on the Naturals' championship Series roster, while development list player Gavin Stupienski and pitcher Alec Marsh both played for the Naturals in 2021.

# FOLLOW THE LEADER

Manager Chris Widger enters his first season at the helm of the Naturals, after previous stops in *Advanced Rookie* Burlington (2019) and *High-A* Quad Cities (2021) managing Royals affiliates.

- 19 of the Naturals' 28 active players played for Widger with the Quad Cities River Bandits last season.
- 10 of the Naturals' 28 active players played under Widger with the Burlington Royals, then in Quad Cities and now in Northwest Arkansas:
   Dante Biasi, Jonah Dipoto, Maikel Garcia, Michael Massey, Jake Means, Drew Parrish, Zack Phillips, Logan Porter, John Rave and Angel Zerpa.

# STAR-STUDDED ROTATION

All five of the Naturals starting pitchers to open the season are consensus top prospects in the Royals' organization, with all five listed in MLB Pipeline's Top-30 rankings for Kansas City.

- LHP Drew Parrish started Thursday for the Naturals ... MLB Pipeline lists him at No. 29 in the system, while Baseball America has him at No. 38.
- LHP Anthony Veneziano started yesterday for the Naturals ... MLB Pipeline lists him at No. 17 in the system, while Baseball America has him at No. 21.
- LHP Angel Zerpa starts today, April 16th, for the Naturals ... MLB Pipeline lists him at No. 13 in the system, while Baseball America has him at No. 20.
- LHP Asa Lacy started the home opener on Tuesday and will go again on Sunday, April 17th for the Naturals ... MLB Pipeline lists him No. 72 overall in baseball, No. 4 in the system and the No. 5 left-handed pitching prospect, while Baseball America has him at No. 4 in the Royals' minor league system, the No. 4 left-handed pitching prospect.
- RHP Alec Marsh started yesterday, Wednesday, April 13th for the Naturals
   ... MLB Pipeline lists him at No. 12 in the system, while Baseball America
   has him at No. 11.

# **TOOLSY TEAM**

Six active Naturals players were listed in *Baseball America*'s 2022 Best Tools Survey of the Kansas City Royals' organization.

- CF Nick Loftin is rated as having the "Best Strike-Zone Discipline" in the system.
- C Sebastian Rivero is rated as being the <u>"Best Defensive Catcher"</u> in the system
- SS Maikel Garcia is rated as having the "Best Infield Arm" in the system.
- RF **Seuly Matias** is rated as having the "Best Outfield Arm" in the system.
- LHP **Asa Lacy** is rated as having the <u>"Best Slider"</u> in the system.
- LHP **Angel Zerpa** is rated as having the "Best Control" in the system.

# WALK THIS WAY

Shortstop **Maikel Garcia** has drawn 10 walks through the season's first five games, which is not just the most in the Texas League but also all of Double-A.

- Garcia drew at least one walk in each of the first five games he played, while walking twice or more four times. He collected his first three-walk game on Wednesday 4/13 in the Naturals' 8-5 win over Wichita.
- In 35 plate appearances, the Venezuelan has reached base 19 times, for a
  cool .543 on-base percentage (9 hits + 10 walks) ... his OBP ranks third in
  the league and is the best among qualified Naturals hitters ... he is the only
  Natural that has reached base in all seven games this season.

# SNIDER DEBUTS AND EARNS THE DUB!

Last Saturday, right-handed pitcher **Collin Snider** made his Major League debut for the Kansas City Royals, the 111th Naturals alum to reach the Majors.

- Snider is one of 16 former Naturals on the Royals' 28-man Opening Day roster, one of 15 that has made their MLB debut after playing in Northwest Arkansas
- Snider's first MLB appearance was a high-leverage situation, as he came on to pitch the 10th inning of a game tied 0-0 at Kauffman Stadium against Cleveland. He kept the Guardians off the board, with some defensive help from fellow 2021 Natural and 2022 debutante Bobby Witt Jr. and after the Royals walked it off in the bottom of the 10th for a 1-0 win, Snider was awarded his first MLB win in his debut.
- The full list of former Naturals on the Royals' active roster is: Scott Barlow, Jake Brentz, Dylan Coleman, Hunter Dozier, Cam Gallagher, Jackson Kowar, Nicky Lopez, Whit Merrifield, Adalberto Mondesi, Ryan O'Hearn, Salvador Perez, Brady Singer, Collin Snider, Gabe Speier, Josh Staumont and Bobby Witt Jr. ... note that Barlow pitched in MLB before he played for the Naturals.

# FALL LEAGUE PHENOMS

The Kansas City Royals sent nine players to the Arizona Fall League in 2021 to play for the Surprise Saguaros ... of those nine, seven are on the Naturals roster.

- Zach Haake pitched in six games (five starts) and went 1-1 with a 6.61 ERA (12 ER in 16.1 IP) and 14 strikeouts ... Asa Lacy made four starts and went 2-0 with a 2.35 ERA (2 ER in 7.2 IP) and 15 strikeouts ... Alec Marsh made one start and went 1-0 with a 27.00 ERA (4 ER in 1.1 IP) and three strikeouts ... Stephen Woods Jr. pitched in 10 games (one start) and went 0-0 with a 4.67 ERA (9 ER in 17.1 IP) with 17 strikeouts.
- Nate Eaton played in 20 games, hitting .317 (26-for-82) with a .815 OPS and 13 runs batted in, he finished fourth on the team with 38 total bases ... Seuly Matias played in 22 games, hitting .188 (15-for-80) with a .712 OPS, six home runs and 20 runs batted in, both of which were tied for the team lead ... Jake Means played in 19 games, hitting .171 (12-for-70) with a .515 OPS and five runs batted in.


