**YESTERDAY:** The Flying Squirrels beat the Rumble Ponies, 5-1. **Tyler Fitzgerald** started the scoring with a solo homer in the first inning to open a 1-0 lead. Binghamton tied the game, 1-1, with an RBI single by Jeremy Vasquez in the second inning. In the fourth, **Carter Aldrete** moved Richmond to a 2-1 lead with a sac fly and a third run scored on a double steal. Fitzgerald hit an RBI double later in the fourth to extend the lead to 4-1. In the seventh, Fitzgerald hit an inside-the-park home run, his 21st homer of the season, to push the lead to 5-1. Relievers **Nick Avila**, **Clay Helvey** and **Chris Wright** combined for seven scoreless innings.

**TODAY'S GAME:** The Flying Squirrels play the finale of a six-game series against the Binghamton Rumble Ponies, Double-A affiliate of the New York Mets. This series is the first and only set between the two teams this season. Last year, Richmond and Binghamton met for a six-game series at The Diamond from June 29-July 4, 2021. The Rumble Ponies won the first three games before the Flying Squirrels took the last three, outscoring the Rumble Ponies, 20-9, to close the series. The Flying Squirrels were supposed to play a six-game series in Binghamton from August 31-September 5, but the entire set was canceled. With this series, the Flying Squirrels have now played every team in the Eastern League this year.

**TICKET PUNCHED:** The Flying Squirrels clinched the Eastern League Southwest Division First-Half title with a win on May 26 paired with a loss by the Akron RubberDucks against the Harrisburg Senators. Richmond finished the first half tied with Akron, but held the tiebreaker with a 7-5 head-to-head record. The league adopted the split-season format in 2019. After playing a full-season system last year, they returned to the split-season format this year. The Flying Squirrels will play in the Eastern League playoffs for the third time in franchise history. In 2011, they swept the Senators in the division series before falling to the Fisher Cats in the ELCS, three games to one. In 2014, they eliminated the RubberDucks in four games before being swept in the championship series by the Binghamton Mets.

**THE FLYING SQUIRRELS** have gone 15-28 in the second half. They are 9-20 in the last 29 games, including a season-high six-game losing streak from July 14-23. The Flying Squirrels have won seven series, lost eight and split four this year. Richmond hitters lead the league with 1,215 strikeouts and rank fourth with 141 homers. The Flying Squirrels are 30-25 at home this year. Richmond is 24-22 in games decided by two-or-less runs. They are 16-24 overall against teams from the Northeast Division, including a 4-8 record in road games and an 12-16 record at The Diamond.

**THE RUMBLE PONIES** hold the worst overall record in the Eastern League and are in last place in the Northeast Division second-half standings. After posting a season-high five-game winning streak at Somerset from August 2-5, the Rumble Ponies are 3-10 in their last 13 games since August 6, including dropping four-of-five to the Curve at home last week. Binghamton's roster includes four of MLB.com's top-30 Mets prospects, including SS Ronny Mauricio (3), INF/OF Carlos Cortes (15), C Hayden Senger (20) and C Nick Meyer (27).

**FOR RICHMOND:** Right-hander **Landen Roupp** makes his Double-A debut. He last pitched on Tuesday with High-A Eugene at Hillsboro and picked up a win after allowing one run in five innings and tied a career high with nine strikeouts. Over his last six starts with the Emeralds, Roupp went 3-0 with a 0.95 ERA (3 ER/28.1 IP) with 45 strikeouts and six walks. Among pitchers with at least 80.0 innings pitched in MiLB this year, Roupp is ranked sixth in K/9 IP (13.4), fourth in strikeout percentage (37.6) and fourth in xFIP (2.85). He also has the second-highest strikeout-to-walk percentage in the minors this year (min. 80.0 IP) at 37.6%, trailing only teammate **Kyle Harrison** (30.1%). During his time with the Emeralds from July 3-August 16, Roupp led the Northwest League in ERA (1.67) and strikeouts (52). He began the year with Low-A San Jose and went 5-2 with a 2.59 ERA in 14 outings, including two starts, before being promoted to High-A on June 30. Roupp was selected in the 12th round by the Giants in 2021 out of UNC Wilmington. **For more on Roupp, see page two.**

**FOR BINGHAMTON:** Right-hander Jesus Vargas makes his 11th Double-A start and his second appearance of the series. He pitched out of the bullpen in the series-opener on Tuesday and worked three scoreless innings with five strikeouts. In the month of August, Vargas has pitched 9.2 scoreless innings across three outings, including six scoreless innings in a win over the Patriots on August 3. Vargas was originally signed by the Los Angeles Dodgers as an international free agent on December 2, 2014. He reached free agency after last season and signed as a minor league free agent with the Mets on December 6. Vargas started the season with High-A Brooklyn, going 2-1 with a 2.03 ERA in seven outings.

**PACKING THE HOUSE:** This season, the Richmond Flying Squirrels are leading all of Double-A in average attendance (6,242) and total attendance (330,849). Richmond is 14th of the 120 MiLB teams in average attendance. The 9,810 fans at The Diamond on Opening Night and again on July 4 are the largest crowds in all of Double-A this year.

**POWER SURGE:** The Richmond offense has hit 141 home runs this season, which is fourth in the Eastern League. On August 7 in the 101st game of the season, **Riley Mahan** hit a grand slam to give the Flying Squirrels their 128th homer of the season, breaking the previous franchise record. Last year, the Flying Squirrels broke the team record for homers with 127 in just 113 games, passing the previous record of 109 from 2013. This year, the Flying Squirrels are on pace to hit 172 home runs. **Sean Roby** is tied for third in the league with 23 homers on the season, with 19 coming at The Diamond.

**CASEY AT THE BAT:** Infielder **Casey Schmitt** was promoted to Double-A Richmond prior to last week's series in Portland. After going 0-for-3 in his Double-A debut on August 10, Schmitt has hit .455 (15-for-33) with four doubles, a triple and three RBIs in his last eight games. He picked up three hits in Sunday's series finale against the Sea Dogs. On Friday night, he tied a career high with four hits against the Rumble Ponies and collected two more hits on Saturday night.

**SMITH STREAKING:** **Armani Smith** is currently riding a 17-game on-base streak since July 29, which is the fourth-longest active streak in the Eastern League. It is also the second-longest on-base streak for a Richmond player this year, trailing a 24-game streak by **Shane Matheny** in May and June. During the streak, Smith is batting .281 (18-for-64) with three doubles, a homer, six RBIs and 11 walks. He posted a 12-game hitting streak from August 4-18, which was the longest active streak in the league at the time, but it was snapped with an 0-for-3 game with two walks on Friday night. He hit .313 (21-for-67) in his first 18 Double-A games from May 15-June 16 before batting .168 (17-for-101) in his next 29 games through August 2.

**MARTY PARTY:** **Brandon Martorano** homered in back-to-back games on Thursday and Friday, slugging a solo shot on Thursday night against Binghamton before adding a two-run homer on Friday night. He now has 10 homers this season, including three in his last eight starts since August 6. In his last 13 games since July 28, Martorano is batting .304 (14-for-46) with three homers, three doubles and 10 RBIs.

**FITZ ON FIRE:** Over his last 29 games since July 10, **Tyler Fitzgerald** has homered 11 times. He now has 21 homers this season, which ranks as the second-most in a season in franchise history, one homer ahead of **David Villar**'s previous franchise record of 20 set last year and trailing 23 by **Sean Roby** this year. Over his last 19 games since July 28, Fitzgerald is batting .370 (27-for-73) with six homers, five doubles and 18 RBIs, which has raised his season batting average from .194 to .230. On Saturday night, Fitzgerald hit a solo homer in the first inning and added an inside-the-park homer in the seventh. Fitzgerald is the third player in franchise history to hit an inside-the-park homer, joining **Brandon Crawford** (2010) and **Tyler Graham** (2014). Fitzgerald is hitting .643 (9-for-14) with three homers and six RBIs.

**ROBUST:** **Sean Roby** hit his 21st homer of the year on July 4 against the Fightin' Phils, moving him ahead of **David Villar** for the most home runs in a season in Flying Squirrels franchise history. He added his 22nd homer on July 7 and his 23rd on July 9. Roby is tied for third in the EL in homers. He has hit 19 homers at The Diamond this season, which is a new record for the most at home for a Flying Squirrels player in franchise history, ahead of 10 by **Adam Duvall** in 2013. It is also a new franchise record for the most career homers at The Diamond. He has also set the franchise record for the most multi-homer games in a season and a career with four.

**IN THE LEAGUE LEADERS:** **Frankie Tostado** is ranked second in batting average (.284). **Sean Roby** is tied for in homers (23). **Mike Gigliotti** is 10th in on-base percentage (.366), tied for ninth in walks (51) and sixth in stolen bases (24). **Tyler Fitzgerald** is eighth in homers (21) and is tied for eighth in runs scored (61).

**WHERE THE RUMBLE PONIES RANK:** In the Eastern League, Brett Baty is ranked first in batting average (.312), tied for eighth in homers (19), first in OBP (.406), second in SLG (.544), first in OPS (.950), tied for fourth in hits (106), tied for ninth in doubles (22), ninth in extra-base hits (41), third in total bases (185) and first in runs scored (73). Ronny Mauricio is tied for third in homers (23), second in RBIs (73), ninth in SLG (.475), eighth in hits (103), tied for seventh in doubles (23), second in extra-base hits (47) and second in total bases (197).

**PROSPECT WATCH:** The Flying Squirrels have five players ranked in *Baseball America's* Top-30 Giants prospects, including **Kyle Harrison** (2), **Casey Schmitt** (6), **Ryan Murphy** (15), **Cole Waites** (21) and **Ricardo Genoves** (30). **Franklin Labour** is rated by *Baseball America* as having the "Best Outfield Arm." Harrison is rated by *Baseball America* as having the "Best Slider" in the organization. Waites is listed as having the "Best Fastball." Schmitt is listed as the "Best Defensive Infielder" and "Best Infield Arm." MLB.com's Top-30 Giants prospect list includes Harrison (2), Schmitt (6), Murphy (15), **Tristan Peters** (21) and **Landen Roupp** (28). Harrison is *Baseball America's* No. 20 overall prospect and MLB.com's No. 22 overall prospect.
