TODAY'S HEADLINES

LAST GAME'S RESULT - The St. Paul Saints allowed seven runs in the first three innings and couldn't ever come back losing 7-3 to the Iowa Cubs. The bullpen was fantastic going 7.0 innings allowing one run on three hits while fanning seven. Alex Kirilloff picked up an RBI in his Major League rehab while Mark Contreras and José Godoy each collected two hits.

MIRANDA MANIA: Jose Miranda collected his first Major League hit in his second Major League game, an RBI double in the fourth inning. He's the first St. Paul Saints player this season to collect his first Major League hit.

THE WAY OF THE K: After a slow start piling up strikeouts this season Saints pitchers are finding their whiff groove over the last two weeks with a total of 116 strikeouts in their last 12 games. Over their last eleven 9 inning games Saints pitchers have struck out 10 or more batters seven times. The Saints pitching staff also boasts the International League's third best strikeout rate over the past two weeks, averaging 10.44 strikeouts per nine innings pitched over their last 12 games.

DOMINATING THE I-35 RIVALRY: In their first season as the Minnesota Twins Triple-A affiliate, the Saints found their first rival, the Iowa Cubs. The team closest in proximity to the Saints faced off 35 times a season ago with the Saints going 23-12, including a six-game sweep in Iowa from May 25-30. Overall, the Saints went 3-0-3 in their six series. Jose Miranda hit .319 with two homers and 13 RBI. Ryan Mason went 1-0 and didn't give up a run 4, 1 innings while Ian Hamilton was 2-0 with a 1.15 ERA in 11 relief appearances.

HOME WRECKED: The St. Paul Saints never had a chance to even up their series against the Nashville Sounds. After losing three of five, the Saints were hoping to even the series, but because of unsafe playing conditions the series ended after five games with the Saints losing the series. It was the first time in the last nine home series they had lost. They had gone 6-0-2 dating back to last season. Their last home series loss was to Omaha from June 8-13, 2021.

TROUBLED TWO WEEKS: The St. Paul Saints got off to a great start offensively over their first two series, but in the last two they have struggled. The Saints rank dead last in Triple-A in average (.202), runs (34), hits (69), total bases (103), RBI (29), slugging (.302) and OPS (.608) since then.

IF YOU'RE NOT FIRST, YOU'RE LAST: The St. Paul Saints made a habit out of scoring first over the first two series, but over the last 12 games they have scored first just twice in 12 games. During those 12 games the Saints are just 4-8.

THAT 70s THROW: Through 23 games no Saints pitcher has thrown more than 78 pitches in a game. JC Ramirez has thrown the most in a game at 78, Devin Smeltzer threw 77 and Jake Farria and Daniel Gossett have each thrown a high of 76.

DAY OF SERVICE: Believed to be Major League Baseball's first-ever coordinated effort across an entire organization, the Minnesota Twins Week of Service involves front office staff and clubhouse personnel from the Twins and each of Minnesota's minor league affiliates. The St. Paul Saints will had their day on Wednesday morning when 16 players packaged and served food to the homeless at the Saint Paul Opportunity Center with Catholic Charities of St. Paul and Minneapolis.

TWINS UPDATE - The Twins continued rolling winning their 11th in the last 12, 7-2 over the Baltimore Orioles. Jose Miranda collected an RBI double while Byron Buxton and Carlos Correa each collected two hits.

LAST APPEARANCE: 4/28 vs. NAS...pitched 2.2 innings allowing four runs on three hits, giving up two home runs, while walking four and striking out one...received the loss in a 6-2 Sounds victory.

APPEARANCE PRIOR: 4/21 @ TOL...pitched 3.0 innings of hitless, shutout relief while walking one and striking out four...did not receive a decision in a 2-1 Mud Hens victory.

SIX DEGREES OF CARLOS CORREA: On March 12, 2022, Ronny Henriquez was traded to the Minnesota Twins along with SS Isiah Kiner-Falefa in exchange for catcher Mitch Garver. Kiner-Falefa was then flipped, along with 3B Josh Donaldson and C Ben Rortvedt, to the New York Yankees for C Gary Sanchez and 3B Gio Urshela. That trade helped get rid of Donaldson's large contract. The Twins then went out and signed SS Carlos Correa.

BUT WHAT DOES THE AP TOP 25 SAY: Following the trade to the Twins, Henriquez immediately made his mark within the organizations Top 30 prospects. MLB Pipeline has him ranked #14 while Baseball America lists him at #28. In the Texas Rangers system, MLB Pipeline had him ranked #30 in 2019, #17 in 2020. Baseball America had him ranked #10 in 2020 and #15 in 2021.

QUITE THE FIRST IMPRESSION: In his first appearance for the St. Paul Saints on April 21 @ Toledo, Henriquez came on in relief of Devin Smeltzer to start the sixth inning. He promptly struck out the first two hitters he faced and then got a fly out to end the inning. To start the seventh, he walked the leadoff man, but retired the final six batters he faced getting two more strikeouts.

BRINGING THE HEAT: While his fastball has been clocked in the high 90s, the strikeout has been a big part of Henriquez' game. In his first three professional seasons, he has never had a strikeout per nine inning ratio of less than 10.1. In his first three seasons he's gone 12.3, 10.9 and 10.1 strikeouts per nine.

IN THE YEAR 2000: As the years go on more and more players that play for the Saints will be born in 2000 or later, but for now Henriquez is just the second player ever to don a Saints uniform and be born in 2000. Infielder Daniel Ozoria joined the Saints from Single-A Fort Myers on May 11, 2021. He was born on August 24, 2000 becoming the first player born in 2000 to play for the Saints. Henriquez is just about two months older than Ozoria born on June 20, 2000.
