NASHVILLE, TENN. – The Omaha Storm Chasers dropped their third straight game to the Nashville Sounds, losing 3-2 at First Horizon Park on Friday night.

- For the first time in this series, the Sounds scored first, when as **Yonny Hernández** scored crossed home in the bottom of the 2nd inning on a fielder's choice and **Cam Devanney** throwing error to give Nashville a 1-0 lead.
- Omaha's first 10 hitters were retired in order until the top of the 4th inning, when **Drew Waters** tied the game up 1-1 with his second home run of the season as he got the Chasers' first hit and run of the game all on one pitch ... Waters earned his seventh multi-hit of the season and helped the team stay in this game until the later frames, also adding a single in the 6th inning and walk in the 9th.
- Starting pitcher **William Fleming** earned a no-decision but offered a strong start, as he struck out three over 5.0 innings of one-run ball and stranded seven runners on base over his last four innings of work ... Nashville threatened in the 4th inning, but catcher **Brian O'Keefe** picked Hernández off at third for the first out of the inning to kill a rally the Sounds were trying to mount.
- The Chasers took their first lead of the game in the top of the 7th inning, when **Devin Mann** walked to open the frame, then scored on an RBI double from Devanney for a 2-1 Chasers lead, Devanney's first hit of the week against his former team.
- Mike Jirschele replaced Fleming with **Dan Altavilla** in the 6th inning and the reliever retired his first five batters, but Sounds shortstop **Vinny Capra** tied the game in the bottom of the 7th with a home run off Altavilla to tie the game at 2-2.
- Omaha went quietly in the top of the 8th inning, then **Steven Cruz** entered the game for Altavilla in the bottom of the 8th and former Storm Chaser **Brewer Hicklen** promptly put the Sounds ahead for good as he opened the inning with a solo home run to give Nashville a 3-2 lead that ended up being the final score.
- The Storm Chasers made some noise in the top of the 9th inning, putting a pair of runners on with a walk and a hit batter, but left the tying run on third base and the go-ahead run by first, as Devanney grounded out to end the game.
- The loss was Omaha's third straight, the second straight night with just three hits.

NOTES AND NUGGETS

RUSHING WATERS

- Outfielder **Drew Waters** went 2-for-3 yesterday, responsible for 2 of Omaha's 3 hits and his 11th straight game on base.
- His streak of 11 games in a row reaching base is the longest active stream among Storm Chasers hitters, tied with **Nate Eaton** for the longest on the team this year ... Eaton's 11-game on-base streak ended yesterday.
- Waters currently leads the Storm Chasers in hits (19), as well as batting average (.333), on-base percentage (.406), slugging percentage (.561) and OPS (.967).
- Of the 22 players that have at least 200 plate appearances with Omaha since the start of the 2022 season, Waters has the highest slugging percentage (.597), OPS (.967), BABIP (.407) and wRC+ (.150).

ALEXANDER THE GREAT

- Infielder **CJ Alexander** has been one of Omaha's top hitters early in the season, leading the team in many categories.
- Alexander is tied for the Triple-A lead with 22 batted balls over 100mph or greater, the most of any International League hitter ... the next-closest Storm Chaser is Drew Waters with 12.
- He leads the Storm Chasers in extra-base hits (10) and total bases (36), tied for the team lead in runs scored (14), doubles (6) and home runs (4).

PUSHING PORTER

- Storm Chasers catcher **Logan Porter** was named the International League's Player of the Week last week, after one of the top offensive performances in Minor League Baseball.
- Porter led the league last week with a 1.400 slugging percentage and 2.050 OPS, going 8-for-15 (.533 average) at the plate against the Strippers ... 6 of his 8 hits last week went for extra bases, with 2 doubles, 1 triple and 3 home runs for a team-best 21 total bases ... he homered in three straight games – April 9, 11 and 12 – with 7 RBI.
- Porter is the only Storm Chaser with an active hitting streak entering pay today, he has hit safely in his last 7 games ... since April 4, he is batting .464 (13-for-28), with 9 extra-base hits and a 1.652 OPS in that span.
- The catcher has also seen some success catching runners stealing this season, with 7 runners caught stealing in 24 tries (29.17%) ... he is tied 2nd in the league in CS.

BIG NICK ENERGY

- Back in the lineup today, **Nick Pratto** leads the active roster with 9 total bases through the first four games of this week's series with Nashville.
- Pratto homered in the first two games of this week's series, for home runs in three straight games going back to Sunday ... he is the second Storm Chaser to homer in 3 straight games this year, after **Logan Porter** did so last week vs. Gwinnett.
- Pratto has 2 of Omaha's 5 home runs this week, tied with Michael Massey for the team lead with 4 runs batted in.
