SILENTLY CATCHING FIRE: OF Dairon Blanco is having an incredible month of September at the plate. He is hitting .451 during this month, with a .725 slugging percentage and 1.234 OPS. He is riding a five-game hit streak, earning at least three hits in each of his last three games. Last night's 5-for-6 performance tied a career-high for Blanco and he joins **INF Vinnie Pasquantino** as the only Storm Chasers to earn five hits in a single game this season. Blanco has also earned an RBI in five consecutive games, the first player for Omaha to hit that benchmark this season. He needs just one more RBI to tie his single-season career best in RBIs at 53.

ROLLING IN COLUMBUS: For the first time this season, the Storm Chasers have opened a road series with three consecutive wins. Omaha has outscored Columbus by 17 runs through the first three games of this series. The Storm Chasers are outhitting the Clippers by more than 120 points, .319.198. **OF Dairon Blanco** is hitting .800 in two games this week, while **INF Maikel Garcia** is leading the team among the players that have played all three games, hitting .429.

FERMIN FINDS A WAY ON BASE: C Freddy Fermin used a double and two walks last night to extend his on-base streak to 33 games, the longest active on-base streak in the International League. Fermin is now trailing **OF Brewer Hicklen's** 34-game on-base streak by just one game for the longest on the team this season. Fermin currently holds the fourth longest on-base streak for Triple-A Omaha during the modern franchise era (2005-pres.). During his streak, Fermin is slashing .336/.429/.630 with eight doubles, nine home runs, and 23 RBIs. He is also drawing walks at nearly the same rate he is striking out, walking 20 times and striking out 21 times since the streak started on August 3.

SAVE MACHINE: RHP Andrés Núñez earned his sixth save over his last six appearances with a perfect ninth inning on Tuesday. His six-game save streak is the longest acive save streak in the International League, and he is just one of four players in the league with a save streak of six or more games this season. Scranton/Wilkes-Barre's Greg Weissert earned a save in eight consecutive games from July 27-August 20 to lead the league. Núñez leads the Storm Chasers in appearances this season with 51. He is the first player since Allen McDill pitched in 61 games in 1998 to appear in 51 or more games for Triple-A Omaha.

30-30 IN SIGHT: OF Brewer Hicklen is closing in on another milestone that is quite rare in minor league baseball. Hicklen needs just two more home runs to become the seventh player in affiliated Minor League Baseball since 2005 to hit 30 home runs and steal 30 bases in a single season. Hicklen would join Kyle Tucker (2019) and Joc Pederson (2014) as the only players to accomplish the feat solely at the Triple-A level. Hicklen's 28 home runs lead the team this season, needing two more to become the third player in the Storm Chasers era (2011-pres.) to hit 30 homers in a single season, joining **Ryan McBroom** (32, 2021) and **Carlos Peguero** (30, 2014) in the Storm Chasers' 30-HR club.

FOR OMAHA: LHP Drew Parrish toes the rubber for his 15th start and 16th overall appearance for the Storm Chasers this season. In his last start, Parrish went 5.1 innings and allowed three runs (one earned run) on four hits and two walks with six strikeouts. Parrish has gone 6.0 innings four times with the Storm Chasers, most recently a 6.0-inning quality start in which he allowed two earned runs with six strikeoutson August 18. Left-handed hitters have had more success against Parrish, with lefties hitting .284 compared to .234 from righties. Southpaws hold better walk and strikeout rates against Parrish. The 24-year-old started he season with Double-A Northwest Arkansas, earning a 4-3 record and a 2.13 ERA in 10 starts for the Naturals.

FOR INDIANAPOLIS: LHP Logan Allen looks to make his 12th start of the season for the Clippers. Allen went 5.0 innings on Sunday, earning the win after allowing two earned runs on five hits and no walks with four strikeouts. Allen is still looking for his first quality start at the Triple-A level this season after earning seven quality starts in his 13 Double-A starts this season. The 24-year-old started the season with the Akron RubberDucks before getting transferred to Columbus at the end of June. Allen was a second round pick by Cleveland in 2020 out of Florida International.
