**Tonight's Game:** The Nashville Sounds and the Toledo Mud Hens play game five of a six-game series tonight at Fifth Third Field. Nashville evened the series yesterday with a doubleheader sweep. They won game one, 5-0, and game two, 5-4.

**Wade LeBlanc:** 36-year-old Wade LeBlanc gets the ball for Nashville in game five of the series. The southpaw is making his Milwaukee organization debut after beginning the 2021 season with the Baltimore Orioles. He made 6 appearances with Baltimore (1 start) and went 0-1 with a 9.45 ERA in 6.2 innings. He started against Oakland on April 24 and allowed 4 runs in 1.2 innings and was designated for assignment the next day. Milwaukee signed LeBlanc to a minor league contract on May 4 and assigned him to Nashville. The Major League veteran has a career record of 46-47 with a 4.55 ERA in 240 big league games. He was drafted by the San Diego Padres in the 2nd round of the 2006 MLB First-Year Player Draft out of the University of Alabama.

**Wily Peralta:** 32-year-old Wily Peralta starts tonight's game for Toledo. The right-hander is making his 2021 debut as well as his Detroit organization debut. The Tigers signed Peralta to a minor league contract on February 19, 2021. Peralta spent the last two seasons in the Kansas City organization pitching for the Royals and Triple-A Omaha. Prior to that, he was with the Milwaukee Brewers since the onset of his career. Peralta pitched for the Sounds in 2011 and 2012, making 33 starts over the timeframe. He was originally signed as an undrafted free agent by Milwaukee in 2005.

**2021 Standings:** The Sounds have spent the following number of days in the Triple-A East Southeast Division standings in 2021: First: 0, Second: 0, Third: 0, Fourth: 2, Fifth: 2, Sixth: 0, Seventh: 0.

**Power Surge:** With four more home runs in yesterday's doubleheader, the Sounds brought their season total to nine. They are tied with Scranton/Wilkes-Barre for the second-most in the Triple-A East, trailing only Durham's 10 homers. Eight different players have homered for Nashville and Corey Ray leads the club with two.

**Hot Start for Westbrook:** Infielder Jamie Westbrook continues to be locked in at the plate. Through the first four games of the season, he's hitting .636 (7-for-11) with 3 runs, 1 home run, 2 RBI and 4 walks. All four walks drawn by Westbrook came last night as he matched a Nashville Sounds franchise record for most walks in a single game. He's the 21st player in team history to accomplish the feat. Westbrook's .733 on-base percentage is the second highest in the Triple-A East.

**Start the Streaks:** Three Sounds have modest hitting streaks of at least three or more games, led by Dee Strange-Gordon who has hit safely in all four contests. Those with three-game hitting streaks include Zach Green, Corey Ray and Jamie Westbrook.

**Pen Problems:** Nashville's bullpen has started the 2021 campaign a bit shaky. In 16.2 innings, the bullpen has combined to post a 7.02 ERA (13 ER). Relievers have racked up 23 strikeouts but have allowed 13 walks and 4 home runs.

**The Milwaukee Era:** A new era of Nashville Sounds baseball began on February 12, 2021 when the club announced its affiliation with the Milwaukee Brewers. The affiliation with Milwaukee came after the Sounds signed a 10-year Professional Development License (PDL) with Major League Baseball as part of the 20-team Triple-A East League. Within the Triple-A East League, the Sounds are a member of the seven-team Southeast Division.

**There's History Here:** The Sounds enjoyed 10 years as the Brewers' top affiliate from 2005-14. The 2005 season culminated with the Sounds winning the Pacific Coast League Championship – the City of Nashville's most recent championship in any sport. Nashville compiled a 723-713 (.503) record during the 10-year stretch and made three consecutive postseason berths from 2005-07. In 2007, the Sounds won 89 games, the second-most in franchise history (97 in 1980).

**Top Prospects:** Nashville opened the 2021 season with four players on the roster who are listed on MLB Pipeline's Top-30 Milwaukee prospects. Catcher Mario Feliciano is the No. 5 prospect, left-handed pitcher Aaron Ashby is the No. 7 prospect, outfielder Corey Ray is the No. 24 prospect and left-handed pitcher Clayton Andrews is the No. 25 prospect.

**How Sweet It Is:** Manager Rick Sweet is at the helm for the Sounds in 2021, as he was in 2014 when he led the club to a 77-67 record. Sweet has managed for all or parts of 30 seasons in the minor leagues and has compiled a managerial record of 2,033-1,923. The 2,033 wins are 11th-most all-time among all minor league managers. 10th on the list is Lefty O'Doul who won 2,094 games from 1935-57.

**That Doesn't Hurt So Bad:** Three Major League rehabbers joined the Sounds for Opening Day in Toledo. Right-hander Josh Lindblom (April 24 - right knee effusion), outfielder Derek Fisher (April 1 - strained left hamstring) and infielder/outfielder Jace Peterson (April 23 - cryotherapy on left thumb) are all on the current roster.

### THIS DATE IN HISTORY

On May 8, 2019, the Sounds put together a 15-hit attack on their way to a 13-6 win in Oklahoma City. Zack Granite and Andy Ibanez combined to go 7-for-8 with 6 runs scored, 2 doubles, 4 RBI, 3 walks and 2 stolen bases.

**LAST OUTING:** The last time LeBlanc pitched was with the Baltimore Orioles on April 24 against the Oakland A's. He started and took the loss after he allowed 4 earned run on 6 hits in 1.2 innings. LeBlanc threw a season-high 48 pitches in the 7-2 setback.

**AGAINST OPPONENT:** LeBlanc has faced Toledo twice in his career, both times coming in 2016 when he was with Triple-A Buffalo. On May 17, 2016 he started and allowed 1 unearned run over 6.1 innings in a no-decision. 11 days later he started in Toledo and again tossed 6.1 innings. He shut out the Mud Hens and picked up the win.
