LANGFORD HOMERS TWICE IN BIG RIDERS WIN:

LANGFORD HOMERS TWICE IN BIG RIDERS WIN: Wyatt Langford homered twice, including a go-ahead home run, propelling the Frisco RoughRiders to a 10-1 victory over the Amarillo Sod Poodles on Wednesday from HODGETOWN. Langford also walked twice and was only retired in one of his five plate appearances. His two-run homer in the third inning broke a 1-1 tie. He launched a solo shot in the eighth inning to score the 10th run for Frisco (32-33, 63-70). His two walks and his second home run were all on 3-2 pitches. Langford homered on Tuesday for his first Double-A long ball and now has ten hits with three doubles and two homers in eight games with the Riders. Amarillo (40-25, 74-60) had tied the game in the first inning on a solo home run but did not score again the rest of the game. Dane Acker lasted four innings in his start for Frisco, allowing one run on two hits and striking out four. Aidan Anderson tossed two innings without a score, followed by two more scoreless frames from Triston Polley (3-3) to earn the win. Josh Hatcher racked up three hits and a walk, including an RB single in the third and a leadoff double in the fifth. He scored in the fifth on Chris Seise's RBI ground ball. Kellen Strahm went 3-for-4 on Wednesday with a double. He put the RoughRiders ahead in the first inning on a sac fly to score Rodriguez. Strahm doubled in the sixth inning and scored on Aaron Zavala's two-run double. Keyber Rodriguez went 2-for-5 with a double and three runs. His first run came when he singled to set up Langford's two-run homer. After being limited to four hits on Tuesday, Frisco rallied for 12 hits in the second game of the series. All three of Frisco's home runs this series belong to Langford. Gunnar Groen (0-1) took the loss in his Double-A debut, conceding three earned runs and six hits in three innings.

WELCOME, WYATT:

WELCOME, WTATT: Wyatt Langford, who was taken with the No. 4 pick by the Rangers in the 2023 draft, was promoted to Frisco on Monday. He is the No. 2 prospect in the Rangers system and No. 13 in MLB.com's top 100 prospects. At the University of Florida, he was a Unanimous First Team All-American selection after leading the Gators to the College World Series Championship Finals, where they fell to the LSU Tigers. On the season, the outfielder hit an astounding .373/.471/.746/1.217 with 21 home runs and 57 RBIs over 64 games. In his Double-A debut on Monday against Northwest Arkansas, he went 0-for-4, and he went 2-for-2 with a walk and a sac fly in his second game on Wednesday. On Wednesday, he had his first two-homer game.

THE CARTER STORY GETS EVAN BETTER:

THE CARTER STORY GETS EVAN BETTER: On Thursday, the Texas Rangers announced that No. 1 prospect and former RoughRiders outfielder **Evan Carter** was called up to the Major League roster. A second-round selection in 2020 by the Rangers out of Elizabethton High School in Elizabethton, Tennes-see, Carter spent the last week of 2022 and the playoffs with Frisco before beginning the season with the RoughRiders in 2023. During the 2022 season, he won the Tom Grieve Texas Rangers Minor League Player of the Year award, batting .295/.397/.489/.886 with 21 doubles, 10 triples, 12 home runs and 28 steals over 106 games. In 97 games with the RoughRiders in 2023, Carter hit .284/.411/.451/.862 with 15 doubles, six triples, 12 home runs, 62 runs, 74 walks, 68 runs scored and 22 steals. When he was promot-ed to Triple-A Round Rock, Carter was second in the Texas League in walks (74) and on-base percentage (.411) while he was sixth in OPS (.862). In his MLB debut, he went 1-for-3 with a single, a walk and a stolen base.

BROKEN BATS

DEVICEN DATE: Since the exit of **Thomas Saggese** and **Luisangel Acuña** at the end of July, the RoughRiders have had a tough time scoring runs on the offensive side. Since August 1st, the RoughRiders are second-to-last in the Texas League with just 4.7 runs per game, last with a .238 batting average, 24 home runs and a .712 OPS over their 36 games. Frisco's record since August 1st is 17-20. The 24 home runs during that time frame are the fewest in Double-A.

DRIVERS, START YOUR ENGINES:

The RoughRiders have scored in the first inning in eight of the last 17 games. The Riders are first in the Texas League in first-inning runs with 98 over their 133 games. As a team, Frisco is hitting .273/.370/.435/.805 in the first inning with 15 home runs.

WALK IT LIKE I TALK IT:

For almost the entire season, the RoughRiders have lead the Texas League in walks as an offense. Frisco has already shattered their franchise record for most walks in a season with 666 and counting (5.0 per game). Frisco's .356 on-base percentage is on pace to set a new franchise record as well. The Riders already have four players who have cracked the top 10 in single-season walks in franchise history: Evan Carter (74, 5th), Trevor Hauver (71, 6th), Aaron Zavala (71, 6th) and Kellen Strahm (70, 7th). In 2015, Drew Robinson set the single-season record with 83 walks. Strahm is also third in career walks in RoughRiders franchise history with 135. Next up is **Preston Beck**, who walked 143 times over his four seasons with the Riders.

HICKS IS THE CORRECT PICK:

Liam Hicks has been as hot as anyone at the plate for the RoughRiders. Over the last 47 games, Hicks is batting .302 (48-for-159)/.432/.390/.822 with nine doubles, a triple, a home run, 23 RBIs, 29 walks and 21 runs scored. In August, he hit .338 (26-for-77) with a .890 OPS

ONE HOME RUN, PLEASE. AND MAKE IT GRAND: The RoughRiders have had a knack for grand slams this year with Evan Carter hitting Frisco's ninth grand slam of the season. They are one of five teams with at least nine grand slams in all of Minor League Baseball. Seven different players have accounted for the grand slams (Liam Hicks, Luisangel Acuña, Jax Biggers, Dustin Harris, Trevor Hauver, Thomas Saggese (3) and Evan Carter). On July 5th, the Riders allowed their first grand slam this year, becoming the final Texas League team to do so.

-Seth went to Mountain View High School in Arizona, which has produced four MLB players. Scott Lydy (MLB in 1993), Brian Banks (1996-2003), Shea Hillenbrand (2001-2007) and Brad Mills (2009-2015) all were Mountain View Toros.

-Nordlin was the highest-drafted pitcher alumni (13th round in 2017) from of Mountain View since Spencer Moran was drafted in the 11th round in 2014 out of Concordia.

-In his sophomore season at GateWay Community College, Nordlin went 4-3 with a 1.91 ERA before being drafted by the Rangers. That season, he had 123 strikeouts to 17 walks in 85.0 innings for Geckos.

2023 SEASON

-Selected in the Minor League Rule 5 draft by the Minnesota Twins in December of 2022 and assigned to Double-A Wichita.

-Released by the Twins on June 4th and signed by the Rangers on June 6th.

2022 SEASON

-Designated as one of two "long relief" pitchers for Frisco, along with Tai Tiedemann at the beginning of the year.

-Promoted to Triple-A Round Rock for spot start on July 14th at El Paso, throwing 3.0 innings, allowing two runs on five hits while striking out three and walking one.

-Made first Double-A start on July 27th at Springfield, throwing four shutout innings in a 5-2 win.

2021 SEASON

-Pitched in 20 games with 11 starts for High-A Hickory.

-Struggled as a starter, going 0-5 with a 6.48 ERA, but pitched well in relief: 3-0, 3.27 ERA.

-Nordlin's 83.0 innings were the second-most on the Crawdads, just trailing Avery Weems (85.1).

2019-2020 SEASON

-Missed entire 2019 season with "Tommy John" surgery.

-Was one of team's most-used relievers in Arizona Fall League in 2020, (16.0 IP, 14 H, 9 R, 5 BB. 20 K).

2018 SEASON

-Playing with Short-Season Low-A Spokane, he led the Northwest League in strikeouts with 79 while being fourth in innings (68.1) and tied for fifth in ERA (3.82).
