BIRDS BATS QUIET, THREE-GAME WINNING STREAK SNAPPED: The

San Antonio Missions tallied four of their five hits and all of their runs in the bottom of the 4th inning and the Cardinals went 0-for-5 with runners in scoring position as Springfield saw a three-game winning streak come to an end with a 4-1 loss on Thursday night at Nelson Wolff Stadium. Leonardo Bernal clubbed his first Double-A home run with a solo shot to lead off the top of the 7th inning for the Cards' only run. Leonardo Taveras and Edwin Nuñez each tossed 2.0 scoreless innings in relief for Springfield.



OPPOSING STARTER: Right-hander **Braden Nett** makes his Double-A debut for the Missions...Made 18 starts (19 appearances) at High-A Fort Wayne and went 5-2 with a 4.03 ERA, racking up 70 K to 35 BB in 60.1 IP...Opponents batted just .215 against him...Last start with the TinCaps came last Friday, September 6 at home against South Bend and allowed just one unearned run on 3 H with 5 K and 5 BB over 4.0 IP...Over his last 8 starts in the Midwest League went 5-1 with a 1.59 ERA allowing just 25 H with 45 K over 39.2 IP...Was 0-1 with an 8.71 ERA over his first 11 appearances...Spent a month on the Injured List from May 9-June 2 and did not throw more than 4.0 IP or 60 pitches until July 26... Split the 2023 season between the ACL and Low-A Lake Elsinore and went a combined 2-2 with a 4.46 ERA in 14 appearances (11 starts), striking out 45 while walking 37 in 40.1 IP...Went 1-1 in 5 appearances (4 starts) with Peoria in the Arizona Fall League and was named an AFL Rising Star by MLB.com...Made his pro debut with 3 appearances in the ACL in 2022...Signed with the Padres as an undrafted free agent after a strong showing with the Williamsport Crosscutters of the MLB Draft League...Played college ball at St. Charles CC in Cottleville, MO in the St. Louis metro area...22 years old

CARDS CLOSE OUT 2024 REGULAR SEASON IN THE ALAMO CITY: Springfield hits the road for the final series of the regular season before beginning the postseason next week. The Cards meet the San Antonio Missions (Double-A, San Diego Padres) for a six-game series at Nelson Wolff Stadium. The 2024 season is a special one at Hammons Field, as it represents the 20th anniversary of the return of Cardinals baseball to Springfield. The franchise moved to the Queen City of the Ozarks from El Paso in 2005 and boast one Texas League title in 2012 and two North Division championships (2007 & 2012) since. The first iteration of the Springfield Cardinals spanned from 1931-46, an era that saw the Redbirds bring home five league titles.



For the second straight season all 138 Cardinals games can be found across the FM airwaves of Southwest Missouri all season long on Classic Rock 106.7, the radio home of the Springfield Cardinals!

HISTORIC CARDS MAKE HISTORY AGAIN: With their 2-1 win over the Missions on Wednesday, the Springfield Cardinals collected their 78th victory set a new franchise record for wins in a season. The 2024 club surpassed the 2012 & 2017 teams who each won 77 games. The wins record caps a season that has seen the Cards notch several franchise firsts.

- » Springfield has won 41 road games this season to set a new franchise record, eclipsing the 38 road wins in 2008.
- » The Cards began the season with a franchise record 9-game winning streak.
- » Cooper Hjerpe and Andrew Marrero combined to throw the first no-hitter in franchise history in a 5-0 win in game one of a doubleheader on June 20 at Corpus Christi.
- Chandler Redmond set the new franchise record with his 60th home run in a Springfield uniform.

ON PACE...: With just 3 games remaining in the 2024 regular season, the Cardinals are on pace for several team and individual franchise records:

- » Springfield's pitching staff is currently 12 strikeouts from the franchise record for K's in a season fo 1,263 set in 2019. The strikeout pace for the Cardinals pitching staff is 1,279.
- With an average of .334, Bryan Torres is on pace to break the record for highest batting average held by Tyler Minges who hit .324 in 2005.
- With 26 saves, Matt Svanson is one save shy of the franchise record of 27 (Mark Worrell, 2006 & Chris Perez, 2007).

GRINDIN': All season long, the Cardinals have been one of the toughtest teams to strike out in Minor League Baseball. The Birds have whiffed 985 times in 135 games and have a strikeout rate of just 19%. Both of those numbers rank as 2nd-best in the minor leagues. The Wisconsin Timber Rattlers (High-A, MIL) have the fewest whiffs in MiLB (946 in 131 G), while the Reno Aces (Triple-A, ARI) have the lowest K-rate at 18.9%.

HOLDING 'EM DOWN: While the 2024 campaign has been a roller coaster ride of sorts for the Cardinal pitching staff, the Birds' arms have been at their best since the beginning of August, compiling a 3.36 ERA over their last 37 games, a mark that is 3rd-best in the Texas League. Through the end of July the Cardinals sported a 4.64 ERA, 9th in the circuit.

RUN PRODUCER: Through 7 games in the month of September, Cardinals 1B/ OF **Matt Lloyd** is batting .324 (12-for-37) with 2 HR and is 2nd in the Texas League with 11 RBIs. For the season, the Canadian product has been one of the top run producers in the Texas League. His 77 RBIs ranks 2nd in the circuit behind only **AJ Vukovich** of Amarillo who has 80.

WHAT A FIND: Given the season Bryan Torres has had, it's hard to believe he was playing in the American Association. In his first season back in affiliated baseball after being signed by the Cardinals this offseason, **Torres** leads the Texas League in batting average (.334), hits (147), and OBP (.419).

CARDS WELCOME BIG BAT BACK INTO FOLD: Cardinals C Jimmy

Crooks was activated from the IL on Tuesday, putting perhaps Springfield's most productive hitter back into the middle of the lineup. At the time he was placed on the IL August 27, **Crooks** was leading all qualified hitters the Texas League with a .359 average, 10 HR and 39 RBIs since June 23. **Crooks** is 3-for-6 with a double in the first two games of the series.

MAKING A SPLASH: In his first game at Double-A on Saturday, 2023 1st-round pick Chase Davis announced his presence with his very first swing. The 21st overall pick homered on the first swing he took in a Springfield uniform, a solo shot to give the Cards a 1-0 lead in the 2nd inning. After hitting safely in each of his first 4 games, Davis went 0-for-4 against the Missions on Thursday.

SLAM THE DOOR: Cardinals closer **Matt Svanson** has been lights out so far in the 2024 campaign in save situations. **Svanson** is a perfect 26-for-26 and his 51 appearances lead all of Double-A while his 24 saves is 2nd in MiLB. So far in the 2nd half, the Birds closer is 16-for-16 in save opportunities. **Svanson** had a run of 19 apperances without allowing an earned run snapped on Sunday afternoon in Wichita when he allowed 2 ER on 4 H in the 8th inning of Springfield's 5-2 win. The Cardinals are 58-1 when leading after 8 innings this season.
