**FOR STARTERS:** The Rocket City Trash Pandas continue their six-game series against the Birmingham Barons on Wednesday night at Toyota Field after taking Tuesday's opener. Winners of four straight and eight of their last 11 games, Rocket City also won four of six last week at Columbus and enters play atop the Southern League North second-half standings, holding a 1.5-game lead over Knoxville.

**PANDAS OPEN SERIES WITH WIN:** RHP Austin Gordon matched a career high with 10 strikeouts over 6.0 innings to earn his fifth win of the season in Tuesday's 8-3 victory. Tucker Flint reached base in four plate appearances, scoring twice while driving in two runs, and Jake Munroe extended his on-base streak to a season-best 23 games, surpassing Raudi Rodriguez for the longest streak by a Trash Panda in 2026.

**BULLPEN BRILLIANCE:** Rocket City's bullpen has not allowed an earned run over its last 16.1 innings (four games), posting a .127 opponent batting average with 20 strikeouts, two walks, and a 33.9% strikeout rate.

**STREAKING WITH JAKE:** INF Jake Munroe is riding a 23-game on-base streak, the longest active streak in the Southern League, batting .348 with three home runs, eight doubles, 16 RBIs, nine walks, and a .422 OBP. Munroe has reached base in 32 of 33 games since joining Rocket City on June 23, batting .325 with three homers, 10 doubles, 23 RBIs, 14 walks, 12 multi-hit games, and a .400 OBP.

**TRASH CAN FULL OF DOUBLES:** The Trash Pandas lead the Southern League with 160 doubles this season. Nick Rodriguez leads the league with 26 two-baggers.

**BATS HEAT UP IN JULY:** Rocket City went 12-12 in July and led the league with 48 doubles. Jake Munroe led Rocket City in July with a .372 average, 32 hits, eight doubles, and a 1.021 OPS while tying Tucker Flint for the team lead with 18 RBIs ... On the mound, Rocket City posted a 4.08 ERA, which was 2nd in the league, and 8th in Double-A. RHP Austin Gordon paced Rocket City's starters with a 3.70 ERA and 27 strikeouts in 24.1 innings, while out of the bullpen, RHP Lucas Mahlstedt tossed 12.0 scoreless innings with 14 strikeouts and two holds.

**FLINT'S FRANCHISE:** Tucker Flint finished July with a .402/.424/.826 slash line, with 18 RBIs, 16 walks, and eight extra-base hits. Flint (59 RBIs) is four RBIs away from matching his single season club record with 63, which he did in 2023.

**PANDA PITCHING:** Over the last 76 games since May 3, the Trash Pandas own a 4.04 ERA, ranking 2nd in Double-A and 5th-best among all full-season Minor League clubs ... The bullpen posted a 5.38 ERA with six blown saves over the first 26 games. Since May 3, the bullpen owns a 3.64 ERA, 1st in Double-A and 3rd among all full-season Minor League teams, while ranking 2nd with 26 saves.

**ALONE AT THE TOP:** The Trash Pandas have held sole possession of first place in the Southern League North second-half standings since Saturday's victory, their first time atop the standings alone in 754 days, dating back to July 9, 2024 (9-4).

**17 ROSTER MOVES IMPACT PANDAS:** The Angels made sweeping changes to Rocket City's roster this week, promoting RHP Ryan Costeiu, LHP Leonard Garcia, RHP Joel Hurtado, and OF Raudi Rodriguez to Triple-A Salt Lake while selecting the contract of LHP Blake Weiman. The Trash Pandas welcomed RHP Tyler Bremner, LHPs Dylan Phillips and Nicolo Pinazzi, and OF Randy De Jesus from High-A Tri-City, along with trade acquisitions INF Arjun Nimmala, C Jacob Cozart, OF Eddie Micheletti Jr., and RHP Kyle Robinson. Additionally, OFs David Calabrese, Elijah Dunham, and C Yeremi Villahermosa were released, while C J.J. D'Orazio was placed on the Development List.

**PROSPECT POWER:** The roster moves were highlighted by the arrivals of MLB Pipeline's No. 1 prospect Tyler Bremner (from High-A Tri-City) and No. 2 prospect Arjun Nimmala (acquired from Toronto), who rank No. 42 and No. 43 overall on MLB Pipeline's Top 100 Prospects list, marking the first time in franchise history the Trash Pandas have had two Top 50 overall prospects on the active roster. Catcher Jacob Cozart (joined from Cleveland), while outfielder Eddie Micheletti Jr., while outfielder Eddie Micheletti Jr. (acquired from Toronto) and right-hander Kyle Robinson (acquired from Pittsburgh) arrived via trades, and left-handers Dylan Phillips and Nicolo Pinazzi along with outfielder Randy De Jesus were promoted from High-A Tri-City.

# ROCKET CITY TRASH PANDAS

## 2026 GAME INFORMATION

**THANK YOU, DAVID:** OF David Calabrese was given his unconditional release by the Angels after spending parts of four seasons with the organization. A third-round pick in 2020, he ranks second in Trash Pandas history with 311 games played and third in franchise history in hits (211), home runs (29), and runs scored (133).

**THOMPSON'S FAST START:** OF Jake Thompson has made an immediate impact since joining the Angels organization from the Atlantic League's Lancaster Stormers on June 30, driving in 16 runs over his first 20 games with Rocket City. The former Pensacola Blue Wahoos owns a .380 OBP with seven extra-base hits, including a grand slam.

**THE TAMPA TERROR:** INF Nick Rodriguez was named Southern League Player of the Week for July 7-12, becoming the first Trash Pandas position player to earn the honor since Sam Brown in July 2025. He leads the Southern League with 25 doubles, the third-most in a single season in franchise history behind only Preston Palmeiro (31 in 2022) and David MacKinnon (30 in 2021).

**SCULL STREAKING:** After starting his time in Rocket City 1-for-17, Anthony Scull hit in seven-straight games starting on June 17, batting .333 with a home run, and three RBIs.

**PROMOTED:** The Angels promoted four key contributors from Rocket City to Triple-A Salt Lake on August 3, including RHPs Joel Hurtado and Ryan Costeiu, LHP Leonard Garcia, and OF Raudi Rodriguez. The quartet combined to earn Southern League All-Star honors while helping the Trash Pandas to first place, with Hurtado ranking second in the league in ERA, Costeiu recording 96 strikeouts, Garcia leading the Southern League with 11 holds, and Rodriguez producing 12 home runs, 72 runs scored, and 27 stolen bases as one of Double-A's most complete offensive players.

**LET'S GET RAUDI:** OF Raudi Rodriguez earned his first promotion to Triple-A after batting .261 with 12 home runs, 42 RBIs, 72 runs scored, 27 stolen bases, and a .791 OPS in 95 games with Rocket City. The Angels' No. 17 prospect ranked among the Southern League leaders in runs, walks, on-base percentage, and stolen bases, becoming the only Double-A player this season to record at least 85 hits, 10 home runs, 70 runs scored, 40 RBIs, 55 walks, and 25 stolen bases.

**RECORD SETTING NIGHT:** Rocket City set new Toyota Field single-game records with 16 runs and 16 hits in Thursday's win over Pensacola. The eight-run sixth inning was the first eight-run frame by the Trash Pandas at Toyota Field and their biggest inning since scoring eight runs at Chattanooga on June 28, 2024.

**KRUZEL REACHES 500 CAREER WINS:** The June 6, 2-1 victory over Columbus at Toyota Field marked the 500th career managerial win for Joe Kruzel. In his first season with Rocket City, Kruzel reached the milestone in his ninth year as a manager across stops in the Reds, Cardinals, and Angels organizations.

**RETURN OF THE MECK:** Anaheim native Wade Meckler was promoted from Rocket City to Los Angeles on May 22, and homered off Jacob deGrom in his first MLB at-bat since 2023. Meckler added his first career grand slam on May 30. He's finished 13th in All-Star voting among AL outfielders with 306,875 votes.

**LOST PRODUCTION:** Over the last two months, the Trash Pandas have lost three key pieces of their lineup. Wade Meckler (promoted to Los Angeles), Matthew Lugo (claimed off waivers by KC), and Gustavo Campero (right hand fracture) combined for 116 hits, 36 extra-base hits, 78 runs, 66 RBIs, and 28 stolen bases.

**MEANINGFUL MAY:** After completing the May 31 suspended game on Tuesday, the Trash Pandas set a new club record for wins in May, going 16-11 (15-11 in '22), and posted a 3.50 ERA as a team, which was the tops in Double-A, and 4th in all of Minor League Baseball.

**HIGH SCHOOL TEAMMATES REUNITE:** RHP Camden Minacci, and INF Nick Rodriguez reunite in Rocket City after being teammates at Tampa Jesuit High School. Minacci was the Florida 6A Player of the Year in 2020, and Rodriguez, a year younger, graduating in 2021. Both played under head coach Miguel Menendez.

**GLOBAL BASEBALL SERIES:** The Trash Pandas picked up a 6-3 win over Japan's Toyota Red Cruisers on April 1 at Toyota Field. Tucker Flint led the way offensively, homering twice and reaching base four times. The victory capped the three-game Global Baseball Series in front of a crowd of 4,355. The Red Cruisers are the official industrial team for TOYOTA Japan.

**SEASON TURNAROUND:** The Trash Pandas went 45-92 in 2025, a 32.8% winning percentage, which was the worst in Southern League history. The club finished fourth in the Southern League's North Division, 35.5 games out of first place, and was 24-45 at Toyota Field and 21-47 on the road. The Trash Pandas have already won 37 games in 2026.

**NEW TO THE ANGELS ORGANIZATION:** Elijah Dunham (NYY), Blake Weiman (HOU), Lucas Knowles (WAS), Jose Gonzalez (TEX), Eybersson Polanco (Rule 5, BOS), and JJ D'Orazio (ARI), and Jake Thompson (MIA) are all making their Angels organizational debut this season.

**LAUNCHED TO THE LEAGUE:** RHP Luke Murphy became the 52nd former Trash Panda to make his Major League debut after appearing for the Angels on July 31 against Milwaukee. He joins Brett Kerry (June 17), Samy Natera Jr. (June 6), Coleman Crow (April 17, Brewers), George Klassen (April 5), and Walbert Urena (March 26) as former Trash Pandas to debut in the Majors this season. Murphy led all of Minor League Baseball with 18 saves and posted a 0.71 ERA in 34 appearances before his promotion, while Kerry remains Rocket City's all-time leader in wins (13), innings pitched (292.1), strikeouts (310), and starts (49). Natera became the franchise's 50th Major Leaguer after tossing 2.0 hitless innings with three strikeouts in his debut, Crow was part of Rocket City's combined no-hitter in 2023, and Klassen and Urena both debuted with the Angels earlier this season.

**NEW COACHING STAFF:** Joe Kruzel was named manager of the Rocket City Trash Pandas prior to the 2026 season, becoming the third manager in franchise history following Jay Bell (2021) and Andy Schatzley (2022-25). Kruzel enters the role with more than 30 years of coaching experience at the professional and collegiate levels. The 2026 season marks his first year managing in the Angels' system after serving four seasons in a developmental leadership role. His all-time managerial record is 473-472. Joining Kruzel in Madison this season are Daren Brown (Coach), Tim Leveque (Pitching Coach), Doug Henry (Assistant Pitching Coach), Tony Jaramillo (Hitting Coach), Dylan Culwell (Athletic Trainer), Chase Galloway (Assistant Athletic Trainer), Matt Gabriel (Strength and Conditioning Coach), Tristan Saglime (Game Planning Strategist), and Joe Wike (Video Assistant).
