CARDS CAN'T CLIMB OUT OF EARLY HOLE, DROP THIRD STRAIGHT:

The NW Arkanss Naturals scored four runs in the 3rd inning and the Cardinals could not score after pushing two runs across in the 1st as Springfield dropped its third straight with a 7-2 setback on Wednesday afternoon at Hammons Field. Lefty **Cooper Hjerpe** took the loss in his Double-A debut surrendering 5 R over 2.2 IP. **RJ Yeager** had two hits and an RBI, and Noah Mendlinger extended his hitting streak to 6 games going 1-for-4. **Jack Ralston** and **Leonardo Taveras** combined to fire 3.1 scoreless innings out of the Cardinal bullpen.



DPPOSING STARTER: Right-hander **Mason Barnett** makes his 12th appearance (11th start) of the season for NW Arkansas...Last pitched on Thursday, June 6 against Wichita and took the loss allowing 3 ER on 7 H (2 HR) over 4.2 IP...Over his last 3 starts has allowed 14 ER on 22 H (5 HR) over 13.2 IP (9.22 ERA)...Took the loss against the Cardinals in game 1 of a doubleheader on May 9 allowing 6 ER on 7 H over 4.2 IP...The Cards won the game 6-3...Spent his first full season in 2023 between High-A Quad Cities and NW Arkansas going a combined 6-7 with a 3.30 ERA...Went 4-6 with a 3.18 ERA over 16 starts with Quad Cities...In 7 starts with the Naturals went 2-1 with a 3.58 ERA...Was named the Royals Minor League Pitcher of the Year...Selected by the Royals in the 3rd round of the 2022 draft out of Auburn... CARDS HOST NATURALS TO START FIRST-HALF STRETCH RUN: Holding a half-game lead in the North Division with 12 to play, the Cardinals host the NW Arkansas Naturals (AA, Kansas City Royals) for the first of two series between the two clubs at Hammons Field. The Cards dropped 4 of 6 at Arvest Ballpark in Springdale at the beginning on May.



CARDINALS CELEBRATE 20 YEARS IN SPRINGFIELD

The 2024 season is a special one at Hammons Field, as it represents the 20th anniversary of the return of Cardinals baseball to Springfield. The franchise moved to Southwest Missouri from El Paso in 2005 and boast one Texas League title in 2012 and two North Division championships (2007 & 2012) since. The first iteration of the Springfield Cardinals spanned from 1931-46, an era that saw the Redbirds bring home five league titles.

CARDS' RADIO HOME

For the second straight season all 138 Cardinals games can be found across the FM airwaves of Southwest Missouri all season long on Classic Rock 106.7, the radio home of the Springfield Cardinals!

FIRST HALF PENNANT RACE: With 10 games to play, the Cardinals are in a tight race for the 1st half title with the Arkansas Travelers and Tulsa Drillers. Springfield leads the division by just a half game over the Travs while the Drillers are 3.0 games back. While the Travelers and Drillers have three more headto-head meetings this week, the Cards will not play either team again until the 2nd half. The Cards' last 1st half title came in 2016 when they went 41-29 and won the division by 3.5 games over Tulsa. Springfield won the 2nd half title last season and lost in the Division Series to the Travelers.

IN A FUNK AT HAMMONS: After winning their first 8 games of the season at home, the Cardinals have struggled of late at Hammons Field. The Cards have dropped 14 of their last 19 games at Hammons Field, bringing the Cardinals to below .500 at home at 13-14. The Cardinals have a 5.70 team ERA at Hammons Field. After playing 4 of their last 6 series away from Hammons Field, the Cardinals begin a stretch of 21 of their next 30 at home heading into the All-Star Break.

GRINDIN': Perhaps the Cardinal offense's greatest attribute is their ability to grind out at bats. The Cards have struck out the 2nd-fewest times in all of full-season Minor League Baseball with 419 whiffs in 59 games. The only team with fewer strikeouts than Springfield is the Wisconsin Timber Rattlers (399 K in 59 games). The Cards are averaging just 7.1 K's per game.

POWER OUTAGE: While the Cardinals have been piling up base hits, not many recently have gone over the wall. Jacob Buchberger's 3-run blast in the 5th inning on Saturday night in North Little Rock snapped a homerless streak for the Cards of 11 straight games. Buchberger's homer was the Cardinals' first since Saturday, May 25 when Mike Antico hit a two-run homer off Orlando Ortiz-Mayr of the Tulsa Drillers at Hammons Field. The Cards, however, have not homered in three games since and Springfield has just one longball over its last 15 games and 2 HR over the last 18 games. The Cardinals are last in the Texas League in home runs with 31 on the season

MOUND TURNAROUND: While the 2024 season has been up and down for the Cardinals pitching staff, Springfield is on a good run of late. Despite allowed 7 ER in game two against NW Arkansas, the Cardinals have put together a 2.79 team ERA over their last 11 games, 2nd in the Texas League behind the Frisco RoughRiders over that stretch.

FOR STARTERS: Over their last 14 games, the Cardinal starting staff gave the club a chance to win nearly every time out. Since Tuesday, May 27 in Wichita, Springfield starters are 4-2 with a 2.96 ERA (22 ER in 67.0 IP), and only twice has a Cards starter allowed more than 2 ER (Tink Hence at Wichita, 4 ER; Cooper Hierpe vs NW Arkansas in Double-A debut, 5 ER). Cardinal starters are averaging 4.2 IP during that stretch, and if Edwin Nuñez, Hence's start last Wednesday (injury) and rehabber Steven Matz's rehab start are all taken out of the equation, that number raises to 5.2 IP per start.

BIG INNINGS, LONGBALL HAUNTING CARDS AGAIN: After not allowing a "big inning" in 11 of the 12 games on their road trip through Wichita and North Little Rock, the Naturals have used a pair of crooked numbers to take the first two games of the series this week at Hammons Field. For the season, Springfield has surrendered 38 innings in which the opponent has scored 3 or more runs. In those 38 innings, the Cardinals have allowed 149 of the 298 total runs scored by the opposition, 50% of the runs the Birds have allowed this season. In the other 466.1 IP Springfield has allowed 145 runs, which comes out to 2.79 runs per 9 innings. The Cardinals are 24-6 in games in which they have not allowed a "big inning".

The Cardinals are tied with Amarillo with 63 HR allowed in 59 games this season, but have surrendered just 4 over their last 8 games and 8 over their last 14.

REDMOND ON DOORSTEP OF SPRINGFIELD HISTORY: With his

go-ahead two-run homer in the 8th inning on April 23 against Arkansas, Cardinals slugger Chandler Redmond tied the franchise record for most home runs. His 59 career home runs in a Springfield uniform bring him even with Xavier Scruggs (2010-13). Redmond already holds the Springfield record for career RBIs with 213.

Since tying the record, however, **Redmond** has gone 30 straight games without a home run.
