Reading begins a six-game series this afternoon against the Binghamton Rumble Ponies. Binghamton won five-of-six in Reading back in June.

## Quiet Sunday

Reading was shutout for the second time last week in a 1-0 loss to Altoona Sunday. Zach Haake was excellent again, tossing five shutout innings. Reading loaded the bases in the ninth with no outs, but could not score. It was the third time Reading was shutout this season, with all three coming in the last month after not being shutout at all in the season's first half.

## Skipper Milestone Watch

Reading Manager Al Pedrique sits just eight wins shy of 1,000 in his Major/Minor League managerial career. Pedrique's win totals with each organization have been: Royals (102), Astros (158), Diamondbacks (225), Yankees (394), Miami (75) and Phillies (38).

## Pitching Powers

Reading's pitching has been strong as of late, especially the starting staff. Last week at Altoona, Reading's pitchers threw 51 innings, allowed 43 hits ( $0.8 /$ inning), walked 20 batters ( 3.5 per nine) and had 49 strikeouts ( 8.6 per nine). In the Altoona series, the staff had a 2.29 ERA, which was best in the Eastern League last week. Reading's starters combined to allow just four-earned runs. Mick Abel (5.0), Griff McGarry (7.0) and Zach Haake (5.0) all did not allow an earned run in their respective outings.

## Off the Board

Between the start of the second inning on Saturday, until the bottom of the seventh inning Sunday, Reading pitching did not allow a run. It was a 14-inning shutout streak, marking the longest such streak Reading pitching has had in 2023.

## Got 'Em

Reading's catchers have combined to be very difficult to run against as of late. Over the last ten games, the group of Max McDowell, Cody Roberts and Herbert Iser have thrown out 17 of 38 would-be base stealers. That's good for a $45 \%$ clip.

## Around the Organization

The Phillies fell to Baltimore 3-2 last night as Johan Rojas had two hits and two stolen bases. Lehigh Valley finished off a strong series at Toledo winning 6-2. Jordan Qsar had three hits and Kody Clemens doubled and homered. Jersey Shore beat Winston-Salem 7-5 on Sunday as Kendall Simmons had two hits and Nick Ward homered and had three RBI. Clearwater won the first game of Sunday's doubleheader against Tampa 12-3, but fell in game two 5-1. In game one, Emaarion Boyd had three hits, Otto Kemp had two doubles and Ryan Leitch homered.

## This Day in Baseballtown History

July 24, 2014: At Reading, the largest fireworks show in the history of FirstEnergy Stadium draws a record crowd of 9,967. Reading wins, 6-1, as Ryan O'Sullivan tosses 5.0 shutout innings for the victory and Jake Fox goes 2 -for- 3 with a double, home run, 3 RBI and 2 runs. The homer is Fox's 5th in as many games.

## Ponies Rumbling into Town

Binghamton enters today with a 7-13 record in the second half and 42-47 overall record in 2023. Binghamton split a six-game series last week at home against Erie, posting wins on Wednesday, Thursday and Sunday. After this week, the Rumble Ponies return home for a six-game series against New Hampshire. Brandon McIlwain leads the team offensively with a .267 average and 44 RBI entering today. Binghamton ranks last in the Eastern League with a .227 average and is 10th with a 4.49 ERA. Luke Ritter is currently with triple-A Syracuse after a strong start with Binghamton.

## Throw A "Curve" Ball

Righty Jose Chacin gets the start today for Binghamton. He threw against Reading on June 8, earning a win over six-innings pitched (6 IP, $7 \mathrm{H}, 4$ ER, $1 \mathrm{BB}, 6 \mathrm{SO}$ ). In 2023, Chacin is 2-5 with a 4.98 ERA over 15 games/ 13 starts. Across 59.2 innings, he's allowed 54 hits, 16 walks and 53 strikeouts. He last pitched last Wendesday against Erie, earning a win over 5.2 shutout innings ( $4 \mathrm{H}, 2 \mathrm{BB}, 4 \mathrm{SO}$ ). Chacin has also made one appearence with triple-A Syracuse this season. He spent 2022 between high-A Brooklyn and Binghamton and 2021 between three Mets levels. He signed with the Dodgers in 2015 as an International Free Agent, was released in April of 2021 and signed with the Mets in June of 2021.
