PLAYOFF BOUND

The Omaha Storm Chasers won the International League 1st Half title with a 49-24 record and 3.5-game lead on second-place Syracuse to end the half, the best Minor League team in the 1st half of the 2024 season.

- Winning the first half in the league secures the Storm Chasers home field advantage in the International League Championship Series, a best-of-three series that will be played at Werner Park from September 24 to 26.
- This September will mark Omaha's first appearance in the playoffs since 2014, when the Chasers won their 2nd of back-to-back Triple-A National Championships.
- The Triple-A Omaha franchise has 17 playoff appearances in the last 55 years, including most recently four straight seasons: 2011 to 2014.

NOTES AND NUGGETS IN GOOD STANDINGS

While the standings reset for the start of the 2nd half on June 25, Omaha's enters today's game 28 games over .500 with an overall 71-43 record (.623 winning percentage).

- 71 wins are the 2nd-most of any team in Minor League Baseball this season, just behind 74 from the Sugar Land Space Cowboys, Houston's Triple-A affiliate.
- Of 120 full season Minor League teams, Omaha's .623 winning percentage overall this year is the 3rd-best in the Minors ... the top team in Minor League Baseball is Sugar Land (74-41 / .643).
- The Storm Chasers have still been 1st or 2nd in the Minors in wins every day since May 25 ... Omaha previously held sole possession of the best winning percentage in full-season Minor League Baseball for 30 days, June 5 to July 5.
- Omaha is currently on pace for 92 wins ... the franchise record is 86 wins from the Omaha Royals in 1990 ... the best winning percentage in Triple-A Omaha history was .607 (85-55) in the inaugural 1969 season ... over 54 seasons of Triple-A Omaha baseball, there have been seven 80-win seasons, most recently the 2012 (83 wins) and 2015 (80 wins) Storm Chasers.

TOO CLOSE FOR COMFORT

70 of Omaha's 114 games this year have been decided by 3 runs or less, including 27 of 42 losses in 2024, with 14 of 42 losses by just one run (33%).

- Close games have been a struggle for Omaha in recent weeks, with the bullpen converting just 12 of its last 24 save opportunities, since June 5 (50%).
- Omaha is 22-14 in 1-run games this season, which ranks as tied for the 4th-most 1-run wins of any Minor League team ... Akron leads MiLB with 24 1-run wins.
- As a team, Omaha's 32 saves are the most in the league, 2nd-most at the Triple-A level and tied 7th in the Minors ... Evan Sisk has recorded the team's last 6 saves, but 7 different Storm Chasers arms have 2 or more saves this year.

I'M DIFFERENT, YEAH, I'M (RUN) DIFFERENT (IAL)

Omaha has outscored its opponents 625 to 514 this season, a +111 run differential.

- A +111 run differential this year ranks as the both the mark in the International League and at the Triple-A level as well, well ahead of Sugar Land (+95).
- Omaha is 8th in Minor League Baseball in run differential ... three teams are tied for the Minor League lead with a +143 run differential.

COMEBACK KIDS

Omaha has 40 come-from-behind wins this season, meaning over half (56%) of this year's wins have been games where the Chasers trailed at some point.

- Omaha has trailed for three innings or more in 16 of the 40 comeback wins.
- The Storm Chasers have 6 wins where the club had to overcome multiple deficits.
- Omaha has 11 victories in games where the Chasers trailed after the 6th inning.
- The Storm Chasers have come back from down as many as 5 runs to win and have overcome a 3+ run deficit to win on 11 occasions.

RELIEF AID

Omaha's bullpen has been one of the best across the entire Triple-A level in 2024.

- The Storm Chasers relievers lead all Triple-A bullpens with a 1.36 WHIP and 216/327/351 opposing slash line ... a 3.84 bullpen ERA ranks 2nd in Triple-A.
- Omaha's bullpen has combined to not allow a run in 29 games this year, roughly one in every 4.93 games ... the bullpen also has 16 games without a walk this season, including 8 times in the 2nd half of the season.

KICKSTART MY GAME

Storm Chaser starting pitchers have been some of the best in Triple-A in August.

- Omaha's starters have combined for a 2.45 ERA (17 ER in 62.1 IP) over 12 games this month, the 3rd-best in Triple-A this month.
- Omaha has a quality start in 5 of 12 games this month, with 2 each from Daniel Lynch IV and Noah Cameron ... 9 of 12 August starts have been at least 5.0 innings.
- 62.1 innings this month from Omaha's starting pitchers rank as the 5th-most in Minor League Baseball this year ... in the 2nd half, Omaha has averaged 4.94 innings per start from its starters, with 26 of 41 starts being at least 5.0 innings.

TODAY'S START

- Marsh is making his 4th start with Omaha, his 23rd overall start this season and his 24th appearance in 2024... he opened the year as the 5th starter in Kansas City's rotation and made a rehab start with Omaha in May...

LAST OUTING: FRIDAY, AUGUST 9 vs. IOWA

In his second start back in Triple-A since being optioned, began the game with 2.0 scoreless innings, including a 1-2-3 inning in the 1st... stranded a single and walk on base in the 2nd inning...

2024 HIGHLIGHTS

- Won the fifth starting pitcher spot in Kansas City's rotation in Spring Training, pitched to a 3.57 ERA (7 ER in 17.2 IP) with 20 strikeouts in 6 Cactus League appearances (2 starts)...

CAREER NOTES

- Opened the season in NW Arkansas (AA) for the third straight year, made 11 starts with the Naturals and was promoted to Omaha on June 3, making just 3 starts with Omaha before he was recalled to Kansas City on June 30 to finish the year.

COLLEGE (2017-2019)

- Attended Arizona State University, where he was named to the Golden Spikes Award Mid-Season Watch List and the Collegiate Baseball Hall of Fame Watch List of the National Pitcher of the Year as a junior in 2019, team won 21 straight to start the season.

MISCELLANEOUS

- 2016: Graduated from Ronald Reagan High School in Milwaukee, where he posted a 1.21 ERA, while batting .474 during his senior campaign and served as team captain.

SEASON & CAREER HIGHS
