#### STARTING NINE- NEWS AND NOTES

- Last Time Out: The Cedar Kernels mashed three homers and plated six runs in the bottom of the fourth to defeat the Chiefs 9-4 Thursday and even up the Midwest League West Division Finals at one win apiece. Chris Rotondo collected two hits and a stolen baseto pace the Peoria offense.
- Ticket Punched: For the first time since 2018, the Peoria Chiefs are in the postseason. The 2018 club finished 76-63 and featured a myriad of future big leaguers, including Luken Baker, Juan Yepez and an 18-year-old Nolan Gorman. The team advanced to the MWL Championship Series before falling to Bowling Green (Rays).
- About the Opponent: The Chiefs will do battle with familiar foe Cedar Rapids in this week's best-of-three series. Peoria went 6-15 against the Kernels this season but saw 12 of 21 games decided by just one run. These clubs met in the 2018 MWL West Division Finals with the Chiefs sweeping the Kernels out of the playoffs.
- Numbers to Know: Peoria enjoyed plenty of all-around success in their run to the playoffs. The pitching staff's 3.86 team ERA was their best in a single season since 2018. Additionally, Peoria's .243 batting average was their best since the 2019 campaign. The Chiefs also swiped 179 bases in 2023, their third most in a single season and one off of last year's total.
- Cardiac Chiefs: You can't tell the story of the 2023 Chiefs without mentioning their tendency to win close games late. Peoria went 31-20 in one-run games, the most for a minor-league club since 2019. As of September 10, the final day of the regular season, the Chiefs were tied with the Cincinnati Reds for the most one-run wins in all of professional baseball.
- To the Victors Go the Spoils: Following Thursday's defeat, the Chiefs will partake in their first winner-take-all playoff game since September 8, 2017 when the Chiefs fell 8-5 at the hands of the Quad Cities River Bandits. Evan Gattis, the former Astros designated hitter, suited up for the Bandits as part of a rehab assignment. He was 0-for-4 in the contest.
- Go In(Zane): Zane Mills takes the ball for Peoria on Friday with the season hanging in the balance. Mills earned the start by turning in an impressive August. Over five starts, Mills was 2-1 with a 2.42 ERA. The sinkerballer enjoyed a long, successful run through the second half of the season. From July 1 to August 26, Mills allowed one earned run or fewer in seven of 10 outings.
- Cream of the Crop: Catcher Jimmy Crooks is the driving force behind the Peoria offense. He was recently named the Midwest League Player of the Month for August. Over 24 games, the Peoria backstop slashed .379/.427/.611 and became the first Chief to win the award since July of 2019 when Brendan Donovan won the honor. Crooks finished the year with 73 RBIs, tied for second most in the MWL.
- X-Factor: Ramon Mendoza's two-run homer on Tuesday served as a game-winning blast and continued his hot streak. Mendoza ended the regular season by lifting his BA 60 points dating back to August 10. Since August 22, Mendoza is slashing .455/.552/.691.
