### TONIGHT'S GAMES

The Round Rock Express and Reno Aces meet in a straight doubleheader on Wednesday after Tuesday's contest was postponed due to rain in the Reno area. Round Rock LHP Cody Bradford is set to face Reno LHP Blake Walston in game one. The nightcap is scheduled to feature E-Train RHP Nick Krauth up against Aces LHP Tyler Gilbert. First pitch in game one is set for 6:00 p.m. CT. Game two will follow approximately 30 minutes after the conclusion of game one. Both contests will be seven innings in length.

### HANDLING THE RAIN

Tuesday's postponement marks the third time this season that the Express has seen a rain-out on the road after Round Rock and Sugar Land faced rain on April 6 and 7. Prior to April's postponed games, Round Rock had not seen a straight doubleheader since July 27, 2021 in Reno, when a contest was postponed due to poor air quality. The E-Train is 32-16 in doubleheaders, including a whopping 21-3 in game ones, since the start of the 2015 season.

### BRING ON BRADFORD

Express LHP Cody Bradford puts his perfect 5-0 record on the line in Wednesday's game one. Bradford is the only pitcher in the minors with five wins. He owns a 0.64 ERA (2 ER/28.1 IP), which is first in the Pacific Coast League, and is tied for second in innings and eighth in strikeouts (25).

### NEW KID ON THE BUMP

Round Rock RHP Nick Krauth is slated to make his Triple-A debut with a start in game two. Krauth has made four appearances, including three starts, with Double-A Frisco this season and has tossed to a 1-1 record and 2.12 ERA (4 ER/17.0 IP).

### STAYING HOT

The Express earned their fourth consecutive series victory on Sunday as they defeated Albuquerque 13-8. The team has lost back-to-back games only once this year and has won at least three consecutive games four separate times. Their 18-8 start to the season is the best 26-game start since 2001, when the E-Train went 19-7 to open the season. Round Rock leads the Pacific Coast League with a 3.65 ERA (94 ER/232.0 IP) and 1.38 WHIP.

### DOING A DOUBLE TAKE

Round Rock pounded eight doubles on Sunday against Albuquerque en route to a 13-run day. Despite being eighth in the league in slugging percentage (.400), Round Rock is fourth in doubles (58). In their last seven games, they have tallied 23. Since 2015, it's just the fourth time the E-Train has posted eight or more doubles in a game, with the last coming on August 27, 2022 in Albuquerque.

### FOUR-HIT FOSCUE

Express 3B Justin Foscue went 4-for-4 with two doubles, two RBI and two runs scored on Sunday. It was just the second four-hit game of Foscue's career. The last came on July 16, 2021 while playing for High-A Hickory. In his last two games, the righty is 6-for-9 with two doubles, a triple, four RBI, four runs scored, a walk and one strikeout.

### BRADFORD'S BRILLIANCE

Game one starter LHP Cody Bradford is holding opposing hitters to a .135 batting average (13-96), but right-handed hitters are batting a measly .107 (8-75) this year with 22 strikeouts. The lefty has allowed two hits or less in three of his five starts.

### MARTINEZ MASHING

Despite leaving the game in the fourth inning on Sunday with a groin injury, RF J.P. Martinez extended his on-base streak to 22 games. Martinez hit the 7-day injured list on Tuesday, but his 22-game on-base streak is the second longest in the minors this season. Among the PCL, the lefty is fifth in batting average (.350), third in on-base percentage (.485) and first in stolen bases (15).

EXPRESS MANAGER DOUG DAVIS

The 2023 season marks Round Rock Express Manager Doug Davis's Pacific Coast League debut. Davis spent the previous two years as the manager for the Scranton Wilkes-Barre RailRiders, the New York Yankees Triple-A affiliate. Davis brings over 25 years of coaching experience to the Express dugout. Since he began coaching in 1995, he has led a minor league team for 10 total seasons and has accumulated a career 673-588 record. He spent the 2003-2004 seasons as the bench coach for the Florida Marlins, where he won the 2003 World Series.



In two seasons as the manager for Scranton Wilkes-Barre, Davis led the RailRiders to a combined record of 158-119. Last season, he helped oversee a pitching staff that led all Triple-A teams with a 3.89 ERA. Prior to his time as skipper, Davis spent three years in three different roles with Scranton Wilkes-Barre from 2017-2019. In 2017, he was the defensive coach before moving over to bullpen coach in 2018. In 2019, Davis was named the bench coach.

Before joining the New York Yankees organization, Davis spent 11 years in the Toronto Blue Jays system in a variety of roles. Before he was named manager of the RailRiders in 2021, Davis hadn't held a manager title since 2008. He has also been a minor league field coordinator for the Montreal Expos (2001) and Florida Marlins (2002, 2005). His coaching career began in the Yankees system in 1995.

A catcher and infielder in his playing days, Davis was a ninth-round selection by the California Angels in the 1984 MLB Draft. He played professionally for 11 seasons between the Angels, Rangers and Kansas City Royals organizations. He appeared in seven games in the big leagues and tallied six games in 1988 with the Angels, while appearing in one game for the Rangers in 1992. He is a native of Bloomsburg, Pennsylvania.
