YESTERDAY: The Flying Squirrels lost to the SeaWolves, 1-0. The SeaWolves scored the game's only run with a two-out, RBI single in the bottom of the eighth inning. Erie pitchers Ty Madden, Andrew Magno and Angel De Jesus combined to shut out the Flying Squirrels. Mason Black worked his first scoreless start of the season, allowing one hit over four innings with four strikeouts. Nick Swiney pitched a scoreless fifth inning. Juan Sanchez threw two scoreless innings and struck out three.

TDDAY'S GAME: The Richmond Flying Squirrels play the third of a six-game series against the Erie SeaWolves, Double-A affiliate of the Detroit Tigers. The two teams met for a six-game series at The Diamond from April 18-23, with Richmond winning four-of-six. The SeaWolves return to The Diamond for a six-game set from May 30-June 4 and the Flying Squirrels close the regular season at UPMC Park from September 12-17. The Flying Squirrels are 13-12 against opponents from the Southwest Division and 7-4 in games following a loss.

THE FLYING SQUIRRELS are in first place in the division, 2.0 games ahead of Akron. They split last week's six-game series at home against the Curve and have dropped three-of-their-last-four games. The Flying Squirrels offense is ranked fourth in the Eastern League in batting average (.237). The Richmond pitching staff is ranked second in ERA (3.29) and third in strikeouts (272).

THE SEAWOLVES were swept in five games against the Sea Dogs from April 26-30 before taking four-of-six against the Baysox in Bowie last week. They have won six-of-their-last-eight games overall. The Erie offense ranks second the Eastern League in runs (147), homers (35) and RBIs (137). Erie's roster includes 10 of MLB.com's top-30 Tigers prospects, including RHP Wilmer Flores (No. 3), INF Colt Keith (No. 4), RHP Ty Madden (No. 5), INF Wenceel Perez (No. 8), C Dillon Dingler (No. 14), RHP Dylan Smith (No. 15), LHP Brant Hurter (No. 21), RHP Elvis Alvarado (No. 23), RHP Austin Bergner (No. 27) and INF Gage Workman (No. 29). Baseball America's top-30 Tigers prospects list includes Flores (No. 3), Madden (No. 4), Keith (No. 5), Dingler (No. 7), Smith (No. 17), Perez (No. 19), Hurter (No. 26) and Workman (No. 27). Baseball America also including the following Erie players on their Best Tools list: Perez (best hitter for average), Andrew Magno (best curveball), Flores (best control), Dingler (best defensive catcher) and Workman (best defensive infielder and best infield arm).

FOR RICHMOND: Right-hander Kai-Wei Teng makes his sixth start of the season and his second this year against the SeaWolves. Last time out, Teng worked four scoreless innings, working around a walk with a double play to face the minimum on 44 pitches. He last faced the SeaWolves on April 22 at The Diamond and pitched four scoreless innings with eight strikeouts. Teng is ranked eighth in the Eastern League with 32 strikeouts. He leads all EL pitchers (min. 15 IP) in strikeout percentage (43.2) and K/9 IP (14.9). Since the start of the 2022 season, Teng leads all Double-A pitchers with 201 strikeouts. Last year, Teng led the Eastern League and set a Richmond franchise record with 169 strikeouts. Over the last 2021 and 2022 seasons, Teng combined for 311 strikeouts, which was the fourth-most in the minor leagues during that span. For 2022 in his first Double-A season, Teng went 6-12 with a 5.22 ERA. He tied the Flying Squirrels' franchise record for the most starts in a season with 28. A native of Taiwan, Teng was originally signed by the Minnesota Twins before being traded to the Giants at the deadline in 2019 along with RHP Prelander Berroa for RHP Sam Dyson. Prior to the 2023 season, Teng pitched for Chinese Taipei in the World Baseball Classic at Taichung Intercontinental Stadium in his hometown. For more on Teng, see page two.

FOR ERIE: Right-hander Sawyer Gipson-Long makes his appearance start of the season and his second against the Flying Squirrels. In his last start, he threw five innings and allowed one run in a win at Bowie on Friday. At The Diamond on April 22, Gipson-Long threw five innings and allowed one run but was charged with a loss. Gipson-Long was selected by the Minnesota Twins in the sixth round of the 2019 MLB Draft out of Mercer. He was traded to the Detroit Tigers on August 2, 2022 for RHP Michael Fulmer. After the trade, he made seven starts last season for the SeaWolves, going 2-2 with a 4.54 ERA. Prior to this season, Gipson-Long has made one other start in his career against the Flying Squirrels, allowing two runs over 4.2 innings on September 13, 2022 at The Diamond in a no-decision. This year, he is tied for second in the Eastern League with three wins and he sits third with a 1.04 WHIP.

LUCY, I'M HOME: Shortstop Marco Luciano was activated with the Flying Squirrels on May 2 and made his official Double-A debut on May 3. He joined the Richmond roster for last year's Eastern League playoffs, going 1-for-8 at the plate in the Division Series against Erie in September. Luciano is rated by Baseball America as the Giants' No. 1 prospect and the No. 30 prospect in baseball. MLB.com has him rated as the Giants' No. 2 prospect and No. 20 overall. Baseball America also rates Luciano as the Giants' top power-hitting prospect. Last Thursday night, Luciano drove a 394-foot solo homer for his first Double-A hit. He has reached base in each of his five games started this season, including a double on Tuesday.

FULL MUNGUIA: After going 0-for-15 over a three-game stretch from April 23-26, Ismael Munguia is batting .349 (15-for-43) with a homer, five doubles and five RBIs over his last 11 games, including six two-hit games. He kicked off the stretch on April 27 in Bowie with a homer on the third pitch of the game, his second Double-A home run. Munguia is tied for sixth in the league in hits (30) and tied for sixth in runs scored (18). For the year, he is batting .360 (9-for-25) in the first inning.

MATDS MANIA: Luis Matos reached base in each of his first 17 Double-A games, the second-longest on-base streak in the Eastern League this season. He has reached base in seven-of-his-nine games since then and in 25-of-27 games overall this season. For the year, Matos has struck out just 11 times in 114 plate appearances (9,7 percent), the second-lowest rate in the league. Matos clubbed his second Double-A homer in Sunday's win over the Curve and collected two hits, including a double, on Tuesday night to open this series against the SeaWolves.

BURGOS THE KING: Reliever Raymond Burgoshas pitched nine games without allowing an earned run this season, tied for the longest streak in the Eastern League, even with Harrisburg's Amos Willingham. The only run Burgos has allowed overall this season was a extra-innings placed runner in a loss to the Curve on May 3. Among Eastern League relievers (min. 8 G, no starts), Burgos ranks first in runners left on base (94.1%). He is one of two EL pitchers (min. 10 IP) with a 0.00 ERA this year, along with Bowie's Jensen Elliott.

OLD FRIENDS: Erie's roster includes former Flying Squirrels outfielder Diego Rincones, who signed with the Tigers as a free agent in December. Rincones played 142 games with Richmond over the 2021 and 2022 seasons, batting .269 (140-for-520) with 20 homers and 80 RBIs. Three total former Flying Squirrels are playing with other teams in the Eastern League this year. Pitcher Gray Fenter, who was with Richmond last season and with Bowie in 2021, is now with Somerset. First baseman Frankie Tostado, a member of the Flying Squirrels in 2021 and 2022, is now playing for Harrisburg.

IN THE LEAGUE LEADERS: In the Eastern League, Tyler Fitzgerald is ranked fourth in batting average (.324), seventh in OBP (.410), fifth in SLG (.588), third in OPS (.998), tied for ninth in doubles (6), first in triples (3) and tied for eighth in extra-base hits (11). Ismael Munguia tied for sixth in hits (30) and tied for sixth in runs scored (18). Andy Thomas is tied for seventh in walks (19). Luis Matos is tied for eighth in hits (28). Kai-Wei Teng is eighth in strikeouts (32). Juan Sanchez and Nick Swiney are tied for second in wins (3). Evan Gates is tied for seventh in saves (3).

WHERE THE SEAWOLVES RANK: Among the Eastern League leaders, Wenceel Pérez is eighth in batting average (.305). Colt Keith is second in RBIs (20), fifth in hits (31), tied for fourth in extra-base hits (12) and tied for fourth in total bases (54). Trei Cruz is 10th in SLG (.488). Gage Workman is tied for second in triples (2). Sawyer Gipson-Long is tied for second in wins (3) and third in WHIP (1.04). Angel De Jesus is tied for first in games pitched (11).

PRDSPECT WATCH: The Flying Squirrels have eight players ranked in Baseball America's Top-30 Giants prospects, including Marco Luciano (No. 1, No. 30 overall), Luis Matos (No. 5), Mason Black (No. 9), Carson Seymour (No. 12), Landen Roupp (No. 13), Ryan Murphy (No. 20), Nick Swiney (No. 24) and Randy Rodriguez (No. 30). Luciano is rated by Baseball America as the organization's best power hitter and Roupp is rated as having the best curveball. MLB.com's Top-30 Giants prospect list includes Luciano (No. 2, No. 20 overall), Matos (No. 7), Black (No. 10), Roupp (No. 13), Seymour (No. 17), Rodriguez (No. 26) and Murphy (No. 27).

RDAD TO THE SHOW: Infielder Casey Schmitt made his MLB debut for the San Francisco Giants on Tuesday night at Oracle Park. He hit a solo homer in the fourth inning for his first major league hit in his second at-bat. He finished the game 2-for-4. Schmitt played 29 games for the Flying Squirrels in 2022, batting .342 with three homers and 16 RBIs. He was also named the MiLB Rawlings Gold Glove Award winner as the top defensive third baseman in the minors last year. With his MLB debut, Schmitt became the 86th Flying Squirrels alum in franchise history to reach the majors. He is the second alum to debut in the big leagues this year, joining 2021-22 Richmond pitcher Tristan Beck.
