SETTING THE SCENE: Springfield and Wichita (MIN) play 2 games on Sunday afternoon at Hammons Field to wrap up their season-opening 3-game series ... RHP Max Rajcic (0-0) starts Game 1 for the Cards opposite LHP Aaron Rozek (0-0) ... RHP Zane Mills (0-0) will open a bullpen game in Game 2 against former Cardinal RHP Trent Baker (0-0) ... both games will be 7 innings.

LET'S PLAY TWO: April weather didn't waste much time in handing the Cards their 1st twin bill in 2025 ... Springfield went 7-3 in doubleheaders last season ... elsewhere in the organization, St. Louis (MLB) and Memphis (AAA) will play twice today after rain outs earlier this weekend ... in the Texas League, Arkansas and Midland were rained out yesterday and also play two today.

ABOUT LAST NIGHT: Springfield opened the season with a 6-2 victory over Wichita ... the Cardinals pulled away with 3 runs in the 3rd and took a 6-0 lead in the 5th thanks to a 2-run homer from IF Jeremy Rivas ... IF Dakota Harris and C Leonardo Bernal each recorded 2 hits including a double ... RHP Edwin Nuñez (1-0) earned the win with 2.0 scoreless innings of relief ... Wichita starter LHP Connor Priellip (0-1) took the loss.

HAVE SOME CHILL: The first pitch temperature for Saturday night's contest was 43° with a "feels like" temperature of 29° making it unofficially the coldest home opener in Springfield according to those "who have been around long enough to remember" ... Friday's rain out marked the first Opening Night postponement in the 21-year history of Hammons Field.

NEW CHIEF IN TOWN: Saturday's win marked the 1st-career Double-A win for new Cards skipper Patrick Anderson ... "P.A." spent the last 3 seasons managing the Peoria Chiefs (A+) ... also spent 7 seasons managing in the Washington organization with Hagerstown (2014-19) and the GCL Nationals (2013) ... owns a 662-619 career managerial record overall.

ROBY ROLLS: RHP Tekoah Roby tossed 4-shutout innings as Springfield's opening night starter ... struck out 5 while allowing 2 hits and 1 walk ... recorded 9-straight outs to finish off his outing ... enters the season as the #6-ranked Cardinals prospect according to *Baseball America* ... went 2-2 with a 6.75 ERA over 7GS with Springfield in 2024 before an injury cut his AA season short.

CHECK THE WETHER: Inclement weather may have halted Opening Night but the Cardinals hope the Texas League won't halt IF JJ Wetherholt ... St. Louis' 1st-round pick in 2024 went 0x3 in his Double-A debut Saturday ... the shortstop enters the season as the top-rated prospect in the St. Louis organization and is the 22nd-ranked prospect in the game according to *Baseball America* ... assigned to Springfield for his 1st full professional season after playing 29 games for FSL-champion Palm Beach (A) in 2024.

HIT THE ROAD: The Cardinals will dip down into Texas for their 1st road series of 2025 ... take on Amarillo (ARI) for 6 games beginning Tuesday ... it's Springfield's only trip to Amarillo in 2025 ... club was a franchise-best 42-26 on the road in 2024 ... went 4-5 in Amarillo.
