YESTERDAY: The Flying Squirrels beat the Curve, 7-6, in 11 innings. Down, 6-5, entering the bottom of the 11th, Justin Wishkoski doubled home Carter Howell to tie the score. With runners on second and third later in the inning and one out, Victor Bericoto hit a groundball that was misfielded by second baseman Kervin Pichardo, scoring Wishkoski from third to end the game. The Flying Squirrels took a 2-0 lead in the bottom of the first inning. Ismael Munguia led off the inning with a double and scored on a single by Andy Thomas. Diego Velasquez followed with an RBI single. In the third, Matt Higgins brought home Turner Hill with a sacrifice fly to open a 3-0 lead. Richmond starter John Michael Bertrand took a no-hit bid into the seventh inning before the Curve rallied to put up four runs in the inning, taking a 4-3 lead. In the bottom of the eighth, Thomas led off with a walk and later scored on a single by Velasquez to tie the score, 4-4. The Flying Squirrels loaded the bases with two outs in the bottom of the ninth inning, but Jaden Woods struck out Thomas to force extras. Altoona moved ahead, 5-4, in the top of the 10th with a two-out single by Jase Bowen. The Flying Squirrels answered in the bottom of the inning with a run-scoring single by Velasquez, hit fourth hit and third RBI of the game. Pinch-hitter Sammy Siani gave the Curve a 6-5 lead with a single in the top of the 11th.

**TODAY'S GAME:** The Flying Squirrels face the Altoona Curve, Double-A affiliate of the Pittsburgh Pirates in the fourth of a six-game series at The Diamond. The two teams first met for a six-game series in Richmond from June 4-9 with Richmond winning the first two before Altoona won the last four. From July 30-August 4 in Altoona, the Curve won the first four games before the Flying Squirrels won the final two. The two teams will also face off to close the season at Peoples Natural Gas Field from September 10-15.

**THE FLYING SQUIRRELS** snapped a six-game losing streak with their win on Wednesday night. They are 4-10 in their last 14 games since August 9. In their last four games dating back to Sunday's series finale in Harrisburg, the Flying Squirrels are batting .308 (41-for-133), which is the highest in the Eastern League. In that span, they have scored a league-best 26 runs (6.5 runs per game) and homered five times. They had only hit six home runs in their previous 19 games from July 27-August 17.

**THE CURVE** have gone 4-13 in their last 17 games since August 3. Last week, the dropped four-of-six against the Baysox at home. Altoona's roster features four of Baseball America's top-30 Pirates prospects, including LHP Anthony Solometo (No. 5), SS Tsung-Che Cheng (No. 7), OF Jase Bowen (No. 27) and OF Tres Gonzalez (No. 28). Chen is also rated by Baseball America as having the best change-up in the Pirates system. MLB.com's top-30 Pirates prospects list including two Altoona players, including Solometo (No. 7) and Cheng (No. 18).

FOR RICHMOND: Left-hander Jack Choate makes his fourth Double-A start and his first against the Curve. Last time out, he pitched in Harrisburg on Saturday and threw a Double-A-high 4.2 innings, allowing three runs (two earned) in a loss. Choate was promoted from High-A Eugene on August 1. With the Emeralds, he went 1-3 with a 2.90 ERA in 19 outings (18 starts). For the season, Choate ranks ninth in the Giants organization in strikeouts (97). Choate was selected in the ninth round of the 2022 MLB Draft out of NCAA DII Assumption University in Massachusetts. For more on Choate, see page two.

FOR ALTOONA: Left-hander Dominic Perachi makes his fifth Double-A start and seventh appearance. In his three starts since returning to the Curve, Perachi is 0-1 with a 9.64 (10 ER/91 IP). He began the season with High-A Greensboro and made three appearances before being promoted to Double-A in late-April. In his three games with the Curve, he posted a 4.91 ERA before being sent back to the South Atlantic League in mid-May. Perachi was selected by the Pirates in the 11th round of the 2022 MLB Draft out of Salve Regina University in Rhode Island.

**DOUBLE TROUBLE:** The Flying Squirrels have turned 82 groundball double plays this year, which is the most in the Eastern League. Richmond pitcher **John Michael Bertrand** has induced 19 double plays this year, which is the most in the minor leagues. The Flying Squirrels turned four double plays on July 27 against Binghamton, which is tied for the most in a game this season in the league. They matched that feat with four double plays in the first four innings at Harrisburg last Friday night with Bertrand pitching. Those four double plays were tied for the most induced by a pitcher in the Eastern League dating back to 2005, which is the first year those statistics are readily available. It has been accomplished by three other Richmond pitchers, including **Daryl Maday** in 2010, **Clayton Blackburn** twice in 2014 and **Garrett Williams** in 2019. Bertrand's 19 GIDPs this year are tied for the fourth-most in a season in franchise history, trailing 27 by **Craig Westcott** in 2012 (second-most in the Eastern league since at least 2005), 21 by **Clayton Tanner** in 2010 and 20 by **Mike MacDonald** in 2010.

**BERICOTO BASHING:** In his last 54 games dating back to June 6, **Victor Bericoto** is hitting .295 (64-for-217) with four homers, 12 doubles, nine walks and 30 RBIs. After leading the Giants organization in homers (27) last year, Bericoto hit just one homer in his first 34 games this season through May 21. From May 22-28, he homered three times in five games. He went deep again on June 14 at New Hampshire and added a homer on June 18 at Portland, but he had not homered in 34 games before belting a two-run shot on August 9 off the scoreboard in left-center at The Diamond. Bericoto has picked up multiple hits in 19-of-47 games dating back to June 15.

**TAKE THE JAIRO:** On Sunday, **Jairo Pomares** hit his team-leading 11th home run of the season, a 445-foot blast at FNB Field in Harrisburg. It snapped a stretch of 29 games without a home run. He went deep again in his next game on Tuesday at The Diamond against the Curve. For the season, Pomares' 12 homers are tied for fourth-most in the Giants organization. He is also tied for sixth with 32 extra-base hits. Last homestand, Pomares hit a walk-off double for an extra-innings win over the Yard Goats in the second game of a doubleheader on August 10.

**TO THE MUNGUIA:** In his 15 August games, **Ismael Munguia** is batting .357 (20-for-56), tied for third-highest in the Eastern League, with five doubles and five RBIs, adding four stolen bases. He has at least one hit in 13-of-15 games played this month. Last year, he hit .282 over 75 games with the Flying Squirrels. In his Richmond career, Munguia is batting .288 (122-for-423) in 107 games, which is the fifth-highest career mark in franchise history (min. 450 PA).

**PACKING THE HOUSE:** The Flying Squirrels drew an average of 7,113 fans in April for their home games at The Diamond to open the season, their highest April average in franchise history. The previous high was 6,891 in 2014 followed by 6,571 in 2019. This season, the Flying Squirrels are leading all 30 Double-A teams and are ranked 10th among the 120 minor league clubs in average home attendance (6,513), just shy of the highest average attendance in franchise history (6,689 in 2013).

BOULEVARD TO THE BAY: This season, 12 former Flying Squirrels players have reached the majors for the first time. That is the most in a season in franchise history. In 2014, 11 alumni made their MLB debuts, including Joe Panik, Adam Duvall, Andrew Susac, Matt Duffy, Jackson Williams, Edwin Escobar, Hunter Strickland, Chris Dominguez, Gary Brown, Brett Bochy and Chris Heston. The Flying Squirrels alumni to debut in the majors this season are Erik Miller (2023 Flying Squirrels), Landen Roupp (2022-23), Kai-Wei Teng (2022-23), Nick Avila (2022), Randy Rodriguez (2022-23), Mason Black (2023), Gerson Garabito (2021), Spencer Bivens (2023), Raymond Burgos (2023), Hayden Birdsong (2023-24), Parker Dunshee (2023) and Grant McCray (2024). Dating back to 2022, 21-of-the-last-23 Flying Squirrels alumni who have reached the majors have debuted with the San Francisco Giants, with Garabito (Rangers) and Dunshee (Braves) being the only exceptions. Last year saw 10 former Flying Squirrels players debut in the big leagues, including a team-record five from that season's Richmond roster.

**LOTTA INS, LOTTA OUTS, LOTTA WHAT-HAVE-YOUS:** The have been 60 players who have seen action for the Flying Squirrels this year, which ties the franchise record for a single season. In 2018 and 2019, the Flying Squirrels also had 60 different players see time on the field. This season, there have been 31 different pitchers used by the Flying Squirrels, which includes appearances by **Andy Thomas** on June 1 against the SeaWolves and **Luis Toribio** on August 10 against the Yard Goats. There have been 31 different hitters who have seen at least one plate appearance with Richmond this season.

**PROSPECT WATCH:** Two of Baseball America's top-30 Giants prospects are on the Richmond roster, including OF **Vaun Brown** (No. 11) and SS **Diego Velasquez** (No. 26). On Baseball America's Best Tools list, LHP **John Michael Bertrand** is rated as having the best control. MLB.com's top-30 Giants prospects list features two Richmond players, including Velasquez (No. 17) and LHP **Jack Choate** (No. 21).
