JACKSONVILLE SPLITS SERIES WITH INDIANAPOLIS

Kyle Tyler set season-highs with seven innings pitched and six strikeouts as the Jacksonville Jumbo Shrimp blanked the Indianapolis Indians 5-0 Sunday afternoon to split the series. Jacksonville (31-38) opened the scoring in the bottom of the fourth inning. Jonah Bride started the inning with a single and two batters later, Troy Johnston walked. Will Banfield cracked an RBI single to give the Jumbo Shrimp the initial lead 1-0. A base hit from Tristan Gray coupled with a throwing error allowed Johnston and Banfield to score giving the Jumbo Shrimp a 3-0 advantage. Gray (13) blasted a home run in the sixth and Javier Sanoja ripped an RBI single in the eighth for a 5-0 advantage.

X MARKS THE SPOT

In 2023, Xavier Edwards registered one of the most illustrious seasons in Jacksonville's Triple-A/Double-A history (1962-present). His .351 batting average was the best in club single-season history, with his .429 on-base percentage ranking second. Despite starting the season on the IL, Edwards has picked up right where he left off in 2024. The Coconut Creek, Fla., native has hits in 12 of his first 15 games with the Jumbo Shrimp, compiling a remarkable seven multi-hit contests. In all, he is 20-for-60, slashing .333/.375/.433/.808 with four doubles, one triple, three RBIs, four walks and four runs scored.

LITTLE GUY BIG RESULTS

Over his first 11 games in Triple-A, Javier Sanoja was just 6-for-39 (.154) at the plate. However, the 5-foot-7 Venezuelan struck out in only two plate appearances. His contact ability has manifested itself in a huge way of late: Sanoja has reached base safely in 32 of his last 36 games, notching 17 multi-hit contests. During this span, he is 52for-143 (.364/.416/.517/.933) with 10 doubles, three triples, two home runs, 25 RBIs, 15 walks and 20 runs scored.

STARTING FROM SCRATCH

Jacksonville starting pitchers have tossed scoreless outings in five of the last eight games. During this stretch, Jumbo Shrimp lid-lifters have ceded only eight runs, all earned, on 25 hits (6.2 H/9) in 36.1 innings for a 1.98 ERA. Jacksonville starters have combined for 31 strikeouts against 11 walks during this stretch.

FRIENDS CLOSE, ENEMIES CLOSER

A remarkable 44 of Jacksonville's 69 games (63.8 percent) in 2024 have been decided by three runs or fewer, including 26 of the club's last 38 contests. After beginning the year 12-3 (.750) in these narrowly-decided contests, the Jumbo Shrimp have suddenly struggled in games determined by no more than three runs; Jacksonville has lost 22 of its last 29 games decided by three runs or fewer for an overall record of 19-25 (.432) in these affairs.

GRIFFIN-DOR, WHERE DWELL THE BRAVE AT HEART

In eight games from April 26-May 5, Jacksonville outfielder Griffin Conine suffered through a 2-for-30 (.067) stretch with 12 strikeouts. In the 35 games since, however, the former Duke Blue Devil has gotten hot. Conine is 38-for-hislast-115, slashing .330/.422/.687/1.109 with eight doubles, 11 home runs, 29 RBIs, 19 walks and 25 runs scored. Among the 126 qualified hitters in the IL. Conine ranks eighth in HR/ FB (29.2 percent). The 26-year-old has has driven in at least one run in 19 of those 35 games.

ROAD IS WHERE THE HEART IS?

Jacksonville's 14-25 (.359) home record is the worst such mark in the IL, while the club's 17-13 (.556) road record is one of only eight winning away records in the circuit this year. On the road, the Jumbo Shrimp have scored 160 runs in 30 games (5.3 per game), more than a full run better than what they average at home (third-fewest in Triple-A) 149 runs in 39 games, 3.8 per game). The Jumbo Shrimp have surrendered 196 runs (11th-most) in 39 home games (5.0 per game) compared to 135 (second-fewest) on the road (4.5 per game).

WALKIN' IN MEMPHIS

Jacksonville returns to Memphis for the first time since taking four-of-six from April 23-28. Since joining the International League in 2021, the Jumbo Shrimp have had a lot of success playing in the friendly confines of AutoZone Park. Since that inaugural 2021 Triple-A season, the Jumbo Shrimp are slashing .291/.358/.486/.844 with 52 home runs, 213 RBIs at AutoZone Park. Those 52 homers since 2021 are the third-most in an opposing team's ballpark, trailing Durham Bulls Athletic Park (Durham, 60) and Truist Field (Charlotte, 58)



ABOUT BRYAN

-In high school, Bryan was selected as a 2014 Under Armour All-American and was rated the 131st-best prospect in the nation by Perfect Game in 2015.

-He was ranked as the fourth-best player in the state of Indiana and the third-best right-handed pitcher as a senior in high school.

-Hoeing was named to All-Tournament Teams at 2014 Perfect Game WWBA 17U National Championship and 2013 Perfect Game WWBA 16u National Championship.

2024 SEASON

2023 SEASON

-Made first appearance of the season, coming out of the bullpen against Gwinnett. He tossed three innings, allowing just one run on five hits with four punch outs.

2022 SEASON

-Made MLB debut on August 20, 2022 against the Los Angeles Dodgers.

-Hoeing was transferred to Jacksonville on May 3 from Double-A Pensacola. At the time of his promotion, Hoeing was leading the Southern League in both ERA (0.35) and innings pitched (25.2) while ranking second in both batting average against (.211) and WHIP (0.94), tied for fourth in wins (2) and sixth in strikeouts (26).

2021 SEASON

-Hoening made 22 appearances (22 GS) going 7-6 with a 4.83 ERA in 121.0 innings, he allowed 65 ER and held opponents to a .267 batting average.

-After posting a 7.91 ERA in May (19.1 IP), 6.12 ERA in June (32.1 IP) and 6.29 ERA in July (24.1 IP), Hoeing closed the season strong. In August, he went 2-0 with a 1.00 ERA in four starts (27.0 IP, 16 H, 7 BB, 23 K). In three September starts, the right-hander worked to a 2-0 record and 3.00 ERA (18.0 IP, 19 H, BB, 11 K).

2019 SEASON

-After being drafted in the seventh round of the MLB draft in 2019, Hoening was sent to the NYPL with the Batavia Muckdogs.

-In nine relief appearances, he tossed 22.1 innings and struck out 17 in his professional debut season

-He tallied his first professional strikeout on 7/18 vs. the Auburn Doubledays.

ADDITIONAL CAREER NOTES

-Originally drafted out of high school by the Arizona Diamondbacks in the 32nd round (2015) but elected not to sign.

-Signed with Louisville but also strongly considered North Carolina, Vanderbilt, Indiana and Georgia ${\sf Tech.}$

-His mom, Donna, is the person whom had the greatest influence on his athletic career. She played basketball at Ball State. Meanwhile, Bryan's cousin, Alex Meyer, plays in the Minnesota Twins' organization.
