LAST TIME OUT: Rocket City scored eight runs combined in the second and third innings to overpower Tennessee 10-5 Tuesday night at Toyota Field. The Trash Pandas were down 2-0 in the second when Izzy Wilson ripped an RBI single and Mitch Nay rifled a two-run double to put the home team ahead for good. Rocket City batted around in the third as newly-minted third-baseman Brendon Davis rocketed a solo homer to right-center. A double and walk followed before Dalton Pompey blasted a three-run dinger to right-center to up the Trash Pandas' lead to 7-2. A double by Wilson and RBI single from Rocket City capped the scoring in the third. Centerfielder Orland o Martinez lifted a solo-homer to left-center in the fourth and Nay scored on a wild pitch following another double in the eighth to finish Rocket City's barrage. Reliever Luke Leftwich got the win in relief by tossing two scoreless innings. The Trash Pandas had 13 hits with Wilson leading the way with a double, two singles, two runs and an RBI while going 3-4. Martinez finished 2-5 with a homer double and two runs scored. Pompey was 2-3 with his three-run homer and three RBI. Nay was 2-4 with two doubles, two RBI and a run as well.

GETTING K'S: The pitchers are racking up the strikeouts against opposing hitters whiffing 678 batters through the first 64 games. That is good enough for first in AA-South. The most the Trash Pandas have struck out in a game was 19, which happened on 6/26 against Chattanooga when starter Reid Detmers set a new season-high for Rocket City pitchers with 16Ks followed by reliever Ryan Clark who punched out three more Lookouts. Twice the Trash Pandas have struck out 16 batters. First on 5/11 when they K'd 16 Smokies in a 10-inning loss then on 6/16 when they shutout Biloxi. The also struck out 15 Smokies in a shutout win on 5/13, 15 more against Birmingham on 5/25, and another 15 against Chattanooga on 6/5. Southpaw Reid Detmers leads the way with 97K's after his 16-strikeout performance. He and closer Oliver Ortega combined to strike out 15 Biloxi batters in the seven-inning game as Ortega tossed a 1-2-3 seventh for the save with one strikeout.

READY FOR LAUNCH: The Trash Pandas have lived up to the Rocket City moniker by launching 98 homers, which is tied for first in all of AA. 12 of those dingers came in the first Tennessee series, including two grand slams in the series finale on 5/16. Another 12 came in the series against Montgomery (7/6-7/10) with six provided by infielder Luis Aviles Jr. Rightfielder Izzy Wilson and third baseman Mitch Nay lead the way with 15 dingers, which is tied for a three-way league lead. In fact, the Trash Pandas possess four of the top 10 homerun hitters in AA-South on the team. Designated hitter Ibandel Isabel and outfielder Orlando Martinez are tied for seventh with 11. Home runs have accounted for 54 percent (164 of 304) of Rocket City's runs on the season.

TEEING OFF ON TENNESSEE: Of the 98 homeruns hit by Rocket City this season, 58 have come against the state of Tennessee. The Trash Pandas have 32 homers this season against the Smokies, the most against any team.

PANDAS POUNCE AT HOME: Toyota Field has become quite the launching pad for the Trash Pandas. Of the 98 homers hit on season, Rocket City has blasted 55 of them at home. After hitting 12 in the first series against Tennessee, the Trash Pandas hit 18 dingers during an 11-game homestand against Chattanooga and Birmingham. In fact, the home team had at least one homer in 10 of the 11 games. Rocket City has tied the 12-homer mark with a dozen in the series against Montgomery, six by Luis Aviles Jr. Of the 18 position players to play for the Trash Pandas this season, five have homered in their Toyota Field debut.

IZZY BEEN BUSY: In June, outfielder Izzy Wilson was hitting lights out going 25-77 (.325) with six homers and 17 RBI. The first homerun was especially memorable as he launched a three-run blast off Chattanooga starting pitcher Hunter Greene, one of the top prospects in all of MILB, on 6/4. The following week, Wilson had a night to remember as he went 4-4 with two singles, two homers, two runs scored and two stolen bases on 6/10 against Tennessee. Wilson has followed that up by going 14-49 in July meaning he is 39-126 since 6/3 (.310). In addition, Wilson stole four bases in the Tennessee series that began on 6/8. He currently has 18 steals in 22 attempts, which is second in AA-South. In addition, his 15 homers are a league tied for a league lead, which includes third baseman Mitch Nay. He is also second in AA-South in RBI with 38.

TODAY'S STARTING PITCHER: Right-hander Aaron Hernandez will be on the mound for Rocket City. Not including his last appearance on 7/15, where he only went one inning due to rain, Hernandez is coming off one of his better outings as he allowed two runs on only five hits in 5.1 innings against Montgomery on 7/8, receiving a no-decision. Hernandez allowed six runs in the sixth inning of a loss at Tennessee on 6/30. Until that inning, Hernandez had allowed only one run over his previous eight frames, which included a win over Chattanooga on 6/24. Hernandez made his AA debut on 6/11 against Tennessee and went five innings and allowed two runs on two hits with eight strikeouts in earning the win. A 3rd round draft choice in 2018, Hernandez was 1-2 with a 1.93 ERA in five starts for high-A Tri-City this season. He fanned 20 in 18.2 innings while walking 13 and allowing four earned runs. Opponents only batted .175 against him.

The name was chosen in a name-the-team contest and is a reference to the area's association with the space industry and the determination and ingenuity of raccoons, aka trash pandas.

Trash Pandas, slang for raccoon, was included in the original 10 nominations following several Brandiose-led focus groups in Madison and Huntsville. The ballot descriptor read: Our community is known for engineering, and no creature in our galaxy is as smart, creative, determined and ingenious a problem solver - dedicated to the challenge at hand - as our local raccoons!

In July 2018, after the results from several focus groups in Madison and Huntsville, 10 names were selected, based on their uniqueness and how each name relates to the characteristics of the area: (Alphabetically) Army Ants, Comet Jockeys, GloWorms, Lunartics, Moon Possums, Puffy Head Bird Legs, Space Chimps, Space Sloths, ThunderSharks and Trash Pandas. The focus groups were led by San Diego-based Brandiose, the Minor League Baseball industry's premiere branding partner.

Over the next few weeks, two rounds of online voting took place. The first round narrowed the list to Comet Jockeys, Moon Possums, Space Chimps, ThunderSharks and Trash Pandas.

Trash Pandas won the final round with 44.75 percent of the vote to ThunderSharks 19.25 percent. Moon Possums was Comet Jockeys fifth (11.38 percent).

third (12.57 percent); Space Chimps fourth (12.05 percent); and By the way, Trash Pandas dominated both rounds. More than 28,500 nominations and votes were recorded. According to Brandiose, this represented - by far

- the largest community participation in a Name the Team contest in the history of Minor League Baseball. The team name was announced in a local microbrewery in September 2018 with nearly 1,500 fans on hand. Trash Pandas was nominated by Matthew Higley of Lacey's Spring, Ala. He received two box seats for the first five seasons and will throw out the ceremonial first pitch at a Trash Pandas home game.

The regional identifier was also chosen by the community. Out of 13,559 votes cast, 67.4 percent chose Rocket City over North Alabama (18.09 percent) and Madison (14.51 percent).

Press Release From Major League Baseball - March 11, 2021

Major League Baseball (MLB) announced today the testing of a variety of experimental playing rules at various levels of the Minor Leagues during the upcoming 2021 season. These experimental playing rules have been approved by the Competition Committee and the Playing Rules Committee. MLB will closely monitor and analyze the impact of each rule change throughout the 2021 season and report to Clubs on their effects for further analysis. Consistent with the preferences of our fans, the rule changes being tested are designed to increase action on the basepaths, create more balls in play, improve the pace and length of games, and reduce player injuries.



Below is a summary of the experimental rules that will be tested during the 2021 Minor League season:

Double-A (Defensive Positioning): The defensive team must have a minimum of four players on the infield, each of whom must have both feet completely in front of the outer boundary of the infield dirt. Depending on the preliminary results of this experimental rule change, MLB may require two infielders to be positioned entirely on each side of second base in the second half of the Double-A season. These restrictions on defensive positioning are intended to increase the batting average on balls in play.

NOTEWORTHY

THE HERNANDEZ FILE: RHP Aaron Hernandez will make his 7th Double-A appearance (6th start) after being promoted to Rocket City from High-A Tri-City on June 8. Currently ranked as the Angels No. 22 prospect by MLB.com, Hernandez made his professional debut at High-A Inland Empire in 2019 and spent most of the season in the 66ers rotation, with five appearances coming out of the bullpen. He began the 2021 season in the Dust Devils rotation and went 1-2 with a 1.93 ERA (4 ER/18.2 IP) with 13 walks and 20 strikeouts over five starts. His first win of the season came when he threw 5.0 shutout innings with two hits against, one walk, and five strikeouts on 5/29 vs. Hillsboro. In his Double-A debut on 6/11 at Tennessee, he earned the win after giving up two runs on two hits with three walks and a season-high eight strikeouts over 5.0 innings. He got rocked for 10 runs, nine earned, in his first home start, a loss against Biloxi on June 18. He rebounded in Chattanooga on June 24, getting the win after giving up just one run on four hits over 5.0 innings to earn his second road win for Rocket City. He then came in as a reliever on June 30 at Tennessee and suffered the loss after giving up six unearned runs in 3.1 innings. He left his last home start in line for a win after 5.1 solid innings on July 8, but the Trash Pandas bullpen couldn't hold the lead in an eventual 7-4 victory over Montgomery. His last start at Birmingham on 7/15 was cut short after a scoreless first inning due to rain. So far, he is 2-1 with a 1.88 ERA (3 ER/14.1 IP) over four road appearances and 0-1 with a 12.91 ERA (11 ER/7.2 IP) over his two starts at Toyota Field.

VS. TENNESSEE: Over two appearances, one start, against the Smokies this season, Hernandez is 1-1 with a 2.16 ERA (2 ER/8.1 IP) along with six walks and 14 strikeouts. Both starts occurred at Smokies Stadium.

MORE NOTES

FALL STAR: In 2019, Hernandez pitched for the Mesa Solar Sox of the Arizona Fall League and won Pitcher of the Week honors for the final week of the season. Over his final two starts for Mesa, he allowed five hits across 9.0 scoreless innings, striking out 11 and issuing only two walks. He finished the AFL season with a 2-0 record and a 3.38 ERA (7 ER/18.2 IP) with 25 puchouts and seven walks.

NCAA NOTES: Attended Texas A&M University-Corpus Christi (Corpus Christi, TX) where he pitched for two seasons in 2016 and 2018. In 34 career games (19 starts) for the Islanders, Hernandez went 7-9 with a 4.49 ERA (61 ER/122.1 IP) with 139 strikeouts, 61 walks, and a 1.431 WHIP. In 2018, he recorded 102 strikeouts to become the seventh Islander to record 100 strikeouts in a season. That total ranked fifth in the Southland Conference and 50th in all of Division I baseball. When the Angels drafted him in 2018, he became the first player in school history to be taken in the first three rounds of the draft.

<u>CAPE COD LEAGUE</u>: In 2017, Hernandez pitched for the Wareham Gateman of the Cape Cod League. Over five relief outings that summer, Hernandez went 1-0 with a 0.90 ERA (1 ER/10.0 IP) with four walks and 11 strikeouts.
