KENT SHINES BUT JUMBO SHRIMP FALL 3-2

Matthew Kent tossed seven innings of one-run ball on Tuesday, but the Jacksonville Jumbo Shrimp blew a late lead in a 3-2 loss to the Nashville Sounds. The Sounds opened the scoring in the second with an Alex Jackson sacrifice fly. Jacksonville failed to garner even a hit through the first five innings, but Devin Hairston's leadoff double in the sixth ended the no-hit bid. He scored on a Peyton Burdick RBI triple before Lewin Díaz smacked a base hit to plate Burdick and give the Jumbo Shrimp the lead. However, Nashville notched two runs in the ninth to win the game.

CHARLES LE MAGNIFIQUE

Charles Leblanc has reached base in 15 consecutive games (13-for-59, .373/.422/.542/.964, 4 2B, 2 HR, 12 RBIs, 7 R), tied for the longest active streak in the International League. On the season, the Laval, Quebic City native has reached base safely in 25 of his 27 games this year, with multiple trips on in 15 of those contests. On the season, Leblanc ranks second in the International League in both batting average (.373), and OPS (1.058), fourth in OBP (.440), tied for fourth in hits (38), tied for sixth in RBIs (23), seventh in slugging (.618) and tied for 13th in home runs (6) Among the 132 qualified hitters in the circuit, Leblanc leads the league in both wOBA (.462) and wRC+ (183).

Jacksonville boasts an impressive 12-6 record on the road thus far in 2022, marking one of just two teams in the International League East with a winning record away from home. Interestingly, the Jumbo Shrimp have hit far better on the road, posting a team batting line of .299/.368/.516. The club's resulting .884 OPS places second in Triple-A. When playing at 121 Financial Ballpark, Jacksonville is hitting .235/.330/.377, with the club's .707 OPS ranking 18th at the Triple-A level.

BLEDAY OF THE DEAD

Over the season's first 18 games, Jacksonville outfielder JJ Bleday struggled, going just 10-for-63 at the plate with two doubles and two home runs for a measly batting line of .159/.321/.286/.607. However, over the last 11 games, Bleday is 14-for-40 with three doubles and four home runs, slashing .350/.469/.725/1.194. Including a nine-game hitting streak from April 28-May 7, Bleday has reached base at least once in 10 of his last 11 contests.

THE CHICKS DIG IT

Jacksonville has popped 43 home runs thus far in 2022, ranking fourth in the International League. The home run power the Jumbo Shrimp have shown has been a rarity for teams on the First Coast in recent years; no Jacksonville team has finished outside the bottom 10 in either Triple-A (2021) or Double-A (2014-19) in home runs since 2013, when the Jacksonville Suns bashed 104 bombs to place 14th in Double-A. In fact, the last time a Jacksonville club ranked in the top 10 of its level in long balls was 2009, when the Suns cracked 110 homers. The Jumbo Shrimp's run of at least one home run in 11 consecutive games ended on Tuesday.

THIS CUBAN IS CRUSHING MISSILES

Over his last 15 games, **Lorenzo Quintana** has gone 21-for-62 at the plate, slashing .339/.397/.726/1.058 with six doubles, six home runs, 18 RBIs and 14 runs scored. This hot stretch has pushed Quintana up the International League leaderboards on the season; the native of Pinar del Rio in Cuba ranks in the top 20 of the league in slugging (6th; .620), OPS (8th; .980), home runs (T-8th; 7), batting average (11th; .315), extra-base hits (T-11th; 14), RBIs (T-12th; 22) and hits (T-17th; 29). Of the 132 qualified hitters in the International League, Quintana has posted the seventh-lowest strikeout rate (12.1%). He places ninth in both wOBA (.424) and wRC+ (158).

ABOUT DANIEL

-Castano was included by the St. Louis Cardinals along with right-handers Sandy Alcantara, and Zac Gallen and outfielder Magneuris Sierra on December 14, 2017 in a trade with the Miami Marlins for outfielder Marcell Ozuna.

-Castano was originally selected by St. Louis in the 19th round of the 2016 draft out of Baylor.

-A product of Lake Travis High School, one of Castano's teammates in high school was Baker Mayfield, formerly the quarterback of the Cleveland Browns. Castano threw a no-hitter in the District 4A playoff series against Crockett in 2013.

-Castano starred at Baylor University, earning All-Big 12 Honorable Mention in 2015, as well as a spot on the 2014 Big 12 All-Freshman Team. That 2015 season saw Castano post a 3.48 ERA, the 25th-lowest in school history. He tied for first on the team in strikeouts (45) and wins (four), while finishing second in innings pitched (77.1).

2022 SEASON

-Castano began the season with Miami but was optioned to Jacksonville on April 28.

2021 SEASON

-In his final start of 2021, Castano no-hit Gwinnett for 7.0 innings before yielding a leadoff single to Chadwick Tromp in the eighth. He ultimately ceded two hits in 8.0 shutout frames.

-Castano made four starts with the Marlins before being optioned on May 9 to Jacksonville.

-Castano was placed on the 10-day injured list on June 8 with a left shoulder impingement, one day after being recalled from Jacksonville to Miami. The lefty was later transferred to the 60-day IL on July 9. He was optioned again to Jacksonville on August 9 following the conclusion of his rehab assignment with the Jumbo Shrimp.

2020 SEASON

-Castano made his major league debut for the Marlins on August 8, 2020 at the New York Mets' Citi Field in Queens.

-After posting a 4.11 ERA in his first four starts (15.1 IP, 16 H, 8 BB, 8 K), Castano went 1-0 with a 1.88 ERA over his final three outings, including two starts (14.1 IP, 14 H, 3 BB, 4 K).

2019 SEASON

-Castano began the season with High-A Jupiter before earning a promotion on May $28\,\mathrm{to}$ Jacksonville.

-The left-hander worked a minimum of 6.0 innings in each of his six starts from July 15 through August 16. During that span, Castano went 5-0 with a 1.73 ERA in 41.2 innings. He whiffed 40 against three walks and 26 hits against.

-Castano matched Jacksonville's Marlins era record (2009-present) by whiffing a careerhigh 13 batters in a career-best 9.0 innings on August 8 against Mississippi. The outing marked Jacksonville's first nine-inning complete game since Justin Nicolino's gem on July 29, 2014 at Montgomery.
