JUMBO SHRIMP DROP SERIES OPENER WITH LOUISVILLE The Jacksonville Jumbo Shrimp offense struggled Tuesday in a 7-1 loss to the Louisville Bats from Louisville Slugger Field. The Bats (18-21) got off to a strong start. Jumbo Shrimp (19-19) starter Sean Nolin (1-1) yielded a two-out single to Christian Encarnacion-Strand and a double to Jason Vosler, TJ Hopkins then smashed a three-run home run to put Louisville in front. After taking a 4-0 lead into the fourth inning, Jacksonville got on the board with a double from Jordan Groshans and an RBI single from CJ Hinojosa. The Bats added three more runs in the fifth and held on 7-1.

DOCTOR, DOCTOR GIVE ME THE NEWS

Jacksonville starting pitching seemed to find their footing over their previous 20 games. From April 13-May 5, Jacksonville starters yielded 42 runs, 35 earned on 90 hits (8.2 H/9) in 98.2 innings for a 3.19 ERA. Jumbo Shrimp lid-lifters have struggled in eight of their last nine games. They've allowed 37 runs, 36 earned on 43 hits (13.3 H/9) in 29.0 innings for a 11.17 ERA with 21 walks (6.5 BB/9) and 22 strikeouts (6.8 K/9).

WALKING ON SUNSHINE

Over the season's first eight games, Jacksonville mustered only 25 walks, the second-fewest such total in the International League. However, the Jumbo Shrimp have shown a significant amount of patience of late; Jacksonville has registered 149 free passes over the last 29 games since April 11, a figure that ranks tied for third in the International League. During this stretch, the club has walked in 12.9 percent of their plate appearances. The Jumbo Shrimp walked in just 7.6 percent of plate appearances in their first eight games, Jacksonville's 11 walks on April 30 were their most in a game since tallying 12 against Birmingham on 6/15/19. The last time the club tallied 11 walks at home was 8/6/15 vs. Pensacola.

"DOUBLE AA" BAT-TERY

Austin "Double AA" Allen entered play on April 28 just 2-for-his-first-47 (.043) on the season. In the 11 games, since, however, the St. Louis native is 12-for-36 (.333/.415/.750/1.165) at the plate with three doubles, four home runs, eight RBIs, five walks and nine runs scored. Allen has raised his season line to .184/.283/.425/.708 with his recent hot stretch

KING CHARLES

Over an eight-game stretch from April 14-27, Charles Leblanc went just 1-for-26 (.038) at the plate. The native of Laval in Canada has been absurdly hot at the plate since. Over the last 16 games dating back to April 28, Leblanc is a scorching 18-for-52 (.346/.514/.481/.995) with two doubles, one triple, one home run, five RBIs and a remarkable 18 walks. On the campaign, the 26-year-old has walked (30) nearly as much he has struck out (32). Leblanc ranks third in the International League in walk percentage (22.6 percent) and fifth in total walks (30). His swingingstrike rate of 7.1 percent ranks 15th-lowest out of the circuit's 133 qualified hitters.

'PEN PALS

The Jacksonville bullpen struggled mightily during a seven-game stretch from April 14-26. Over that timeframe. Jumbo Shrimp relievers collectively surrendered 27 runs, 26 earned, on 38 hits (11.7 H/9) in 29.1 innings for a 7.98 ERA. However, in the 16 games since, Jacksonville relievers have combined to cede 31 runs, 25 earned, on 60 hits (6.4 H/9) in 84.0 innings for a 2.67 ERA. The Shrimp bullpen has combined for 93 strikeouts (10.0 K/9) against 53 walks (5.7 BB/9) during this recent run.

LONG TIME. NO SEE

Heading in to play on Tuesday, Jacksonville will take on a Cincinnati Reds affiliate for the first time since July 21. 2019 when they played the Chattanooga Lookouts at AT&T Field. That contest ended in a 10-5 win for the Jacksonville Jumbo Shrimp. This will be the first matchup for Jacksonville against a Cincinnati affiliate in the International League.

SHRIMP BITES

The Jumbo Shrimp have walked at least five opposing hitters in six of the last seven games... Jacksonville avoided dropping their fourth game in a row, with an 8-2 win against Norfolk on Sunday. They suffered through a four-game skid just once (May 14-18) in 2022...With Jacksonville traveling to Louisville this week, they will be playing in Kentucky for the first time since they were members of the IL in 1968,

-After one year with the Eagles, Smeltzer transferred to San Jacinto College, so that he would become eligible in the 2016 MLB draft. Smeltzer had a 9-3 record and a 1.18 ERA with 128 strikeouts in 91.2 innings pitched for San Jacinto's baseball team.

-Smeltzer commited to transfering to Texas Tech after his sophomore year, but the Los Angeles Dodgers selected Smeltzer in the fifth round of the 2016 MLB draft. He signed with the Dodgers rather than transferring to Texas Tech, and received a \$500,000 signing bonus.

-Smeltzer ttended Bishop Eustace Preparatory School in Pennsauken, NJ before pitching two seasons at San Jacinto College in Houston, TX.

-Smeltzer had his picture posted on the school's Wall of Legends.
