Overall.....

**AFC Richmond:** Somerset welcomes the Richmond Flying Squirrels to TD Bank Ballpark this week for the first meetings between the two sides. Richmond enters in fifth place in the Southwest Division despite sporting a 21-15 record. They feature two top-15 prospects in the San Francisco Giants organization: No. 3 Heliot Ramos and No. 11 Sean Hjelle.

**LUUUUKE:** New York Yankees first baseman Luke Voit begins a rehab assignment with Somerset Tuesday night. He marks the second rehab assignment in franchise history (Zack Britton). Voit hit .277 with the Yanks in 2020, led all of Major League Baseball in home runs (22) and ranked second in the American League in RBI (52). Voit has played in 12 games in the majors this season, and has already played in six games on rehab with Triple-A Scranton/Wilkes-Barre. He's expected to be with the Patriots all week.

A New Hope: The Yankees announced 15 transactions involving the Patriots prior to Tuesday game. Three players (RHP Luis Gil, RHP Greg Weissert, and LHP Matt Krook) were transferred to Triple-A Scranton. Four players (RHP Reid Anderson, INF Oliver Dunn, RHP Carlos Espinal, and RHP Shawn Semple) were transferred to High-A Hudson Valley. Seven new players (RHP Luis Medina, LHP Ken Waldichuk, RHP Hayden Wesneski, RHP Zach Greene, RHP Nick Green, RHP Addison Russ, and INF Luke Voit) were all transferred to Somerset. Additionally, INF Matt Pita was activated off the injured list.

**Birthday Boy:** SS Oswald Peraza is celebrating his 21st birthday today. The No. 4 Yankees prospect also makes his home debut. He went 4-for-24 with one homer last week in Erie.

**Digging the Long-Ball:** Somerset hit six home runs in their most recent series in Erie. The team has 10 home runs over it's last nine games and now have 45 home runs collectively on the season, second-most in the Double-A Northeast League (50, Bowie) and tied for sixth-most in all of Double-A (55, Northwest Arkansas).

**Home Run Dependant:** Somerset scored 13 runs over its six-game series in Erie, with 11 of those runs being scored on a home run. The lone exceptions were a steal of home by Oswaldo Cabrera Friday night and a run-scoring fielder's choice from from Diego Castillo when he started the play at second base Sunday afternoon.

**Starting with a Bang:** The Patriots have hit 15 home runs in the first inning this season: the most in all of Minor League Baseball and eight more than any other team in the Double-A Northeast League. Additionally, Somerset is collectively hitting .320 in the first inning - tops in the league - and is outscoring their opponents 38-14 in the first frame.

**Hits and Misses:** The Patriots pitching staff owns the lowest ERA (3.09) in all of Double-A baseball. The team has also struck out the most batters (425), leads in WHIP (1.15) and has the lowest batting average against (.202) amongst all Double-A teams.
