**ABOUT LAST NIGHT...** Spencer Horwitz matched a record that stood for 59 years in an 11-5 comeback win for the Vancouver Canadians over the Spokane Indians (Rockies) at Ron Tonkin Field.

Horwitz wasted no time making history. He laced the first pitch of his first at-bat into centerfield for a two-out single in the opening frame that made him the first Northwest League/High-A West batter to hit safely in 26 consecutive games since Gary Johnson of the Tri-City Braves did so in 1962. Coincidentally, Johnson was the scout that signed current Canadians manager Donnie Murphy to a professional contract for the Kansas City Royals in 2002.

Spokane scored first with a run in the second but the C's responded with four runs in the third to go out in front. They used a hit by pitch, an error, a walk and a Horwitz RBI single to tie the game. A balk brought home the go-ahead run before consecutive RBI groundouts had the Canadians in front 4-1.

The Tribe rallied back with four runs in the top of the fifth to go ahead by a single score, but Rafael Lantigua's one out double in the bottom of the inning set up reigning High-A West Player of the Week Phil Clarke, who singled him home to tie the game at five.

That's where the score stayed until the bottom of the eighth. Vancouver erupted for six runs on four hits and five walks in the inning to go up 11-5. Five different players drove in a run in the inning, headlined by Horwitz's two-RBI single that gave him three hits and three RBI on the night. He also scored twice while raising his batting average to a team-best .292.

Vancouver's bullpen was terrific. Hayden Juenger, Gabriel Ponce (W, 2-2) and Will McAffer combined to retire the last 14 of 15 batters to keep Spokane off the scoreboard and allow the offense to put up the big inning.

Horwitz led the way, but all ten players who appeared on offense reached base. Tanner Morris extended his on-base streak to 33 consecutive games and has now reached in 51 of his last 53 games played. Clarke drove in three runs and has had a hit in a personal-best seven straight starts.

**THE TRIBE HAS SPOKANE:** The Canadians welcome the Indians to Ron Tonkin Field for their third visit of the year and the last of five series between the two clubs this season. These two teams last met July 27-August 1 at Avista Stadium in Spokane; that week, the C's lost four of six and were outscored 50-32. Despite those struggles, Vancouver leads the season series 15-11 and needs to win two games to take the set.

**HOME AWAY FROM HOME:** Due to pandemic-related border closures, Ron Tonkin Field in Hillsboro will serve as Vancouver's home ballpark this year. 78 of 120 C's game will take place in the Tualatin Valley over the course of the season (60 home games, 18 as the visitors).

**ON THIS DATE IN CANADIANS BASEBALL HISTORY:** September 9, 2017 - The C's beat Eugene 7-5 at PK Park in game one of the Northwest League Championship Series. Vancouver trailed 4-2 after four but a four-run fifth - headlined by Kacy Clemens' two-RBI go-ahead single - proved to be the difference. Chavez Young homered while Clemens, Logan Warmoth and Brock Lundquist had two hits apiece. Four pitchers - Graham Spraker, Brody Rodning, Brayden Bouche and Orlando Pascual - combined on the last 6.2 innings and allowed an unearned run on one hit with two walks and 10 K's.

**KEEP 'EM COMIN':** The C's have homered in 12 of their last 14 games and hit 15 over their last eight.

**COMEBACK KIDS:** Last night was Vancouver's 30<sup>th</sup> comeback win of the season. They've trailed at some point in the game in 58% of their wins this season.

**BMO:** Phil Clarke has been named the High-A West Player of the week for August 31-September 5. In five games at Everett, the Franklin, TN native went 13-for-25 (.520) with four doubles, two home runs (in consecutive games), six runs scored, seven RBI, a walk and racked up 23 total bases. He is the third C's player to win the award in the last four weeks (Sebastian Espino, August 10-15/Spencer Horwitz, August 17-22).

**TIED AT THE TOP:** Spencer Horwitz has a hit in 26 consecutive games, the longest hitting streak by any player in the High-A West this year and tied for the longest in Northwest League history. Horwitz has gone 46-for-106 (.434) with 12 doubles, seven homers, 23 runs scored, 31 RBI and 19 walks. He has tied the league record that was set in 1962 by Gary Johnson of the Tri-City Braves amidst a season in which he hit .341 in 135 games. Coincidentally, Johnson was the scout who signed C's manager Donnie Murphy to the Kansas City Royals in 2002.

**ACE OF ON BASE:** Tanner Morris has reached base in a season-high 34 consecutive games since July 25. He's 44-for-142 (.310) with eight doubles, a triple, two home runs, 19 runs scored, 22 RBI and 15 walks. In an even greater accomplishment, he's reach in 50 of his last 53 starts.

**ON THE HILL:** Andrew Bash makes his second career Advanced-A start tonight for Vancouver. He took his first turn on September 3 in Everett, the right-hander went three innings, allowed four runs on four hits - including two home runs - walked one and K'd three. Bash, 25, had previously worked in relief for the C's and went 2-0 with a 3.68 ERA in seven appearances that spanned 14.2 innings of work. In those frames, the Palm Desert, CA native K'd 15, walk'd four and held opponents to a .176 average. He was originally drafted by the Angels in the 30<sup>th</sup> round of the 2019 draft out of Cal Baptist and signed with Toronto this year as a free agent.

#10 Rockies prospect Chris McMahon gets the ball for Spokane. His last outing was on August 31 versus Tri-City when he earned the win with six innings in which he allowed on run on five hits with no walks and seven K's.
