JACKSONVILLE DROPS FOURTH STRAIGHT GAME

Jonah Bride and Will Banfield each lashed two hits and collected an RBI on Friday, but the Jumbo Shrimp suffered their fourth straight loss in a 7-2 defeat to the RailRiders. Scranton/Wilkes-Barre jumped out to a 1-0 lead in the first on Carlos Narvaez's RBI double. Jacksonville grabbed the lead in their first at-bats thanks to Bride and Banfield's RBI singles. However, the RailRiders scored four runs in the second inning to take an advantage they would not relinguish. Home runs from T.J. Rumfield and Jose Roias in the seventh capped the scoring at 7-2.

FRIENDS CLOSE. ENEMIES CLOSER

A remarkable 18 of Jacksonville's 31 games (58.1 percent) in 2024 have been decided by three runs or fewer. The Jumbo Shrimp have excelled in these contests, going 12-6 (.667) in those closely-decided affairs thus far. Last season, 85 of the club's 149 games (57.0 percent) were determined by no more than three runs, with the club going 39-46 (.459) in those contests. Prior to that, Jacksonville had been over .500 in games decided by three runs or fewer in every season from 2019-22.

TROY MEETS WORLD

Troy Johnston, the Miami Marlins Minor League Player of the Year in 2023, got off to a slow start this season. Through his first 16 games, the Puyallup, Wash., batted just .203/.292/.234/.526 with two doubles, six RBIs, four walks and three runs scored. In his last 14 games, however, Johnston is 19-for-59 at the plate, hitting .322/.365/.508/.873 with eight doubles, one home run, five RBIs, three walks and 10 runs scored.

SHRIMP ON THE POND

Through 31 games in 2024, Jacksonville has mustered 133 runs (4.3 per game), a figure that ranks 25th in Triple-A in large part due to the club's struggles with runners in scoring position. Thus far during the 2024 campaign, the Jumbo Shrimp are a woeful 60-for-264 (.227/.326/.367/.693, ranking 29th, 27th, 25th and 28th, respectively, in Triple-A) hitting with runners in scoring position. In 2023, Jacksonville hit just .247/.336/.400/.736 with runners in scoring position, figures that respectively ranked 27th, 29th, 27th and 29th at the Triple-A level.

ALWAYS THE BRIDE, NEVER THE BRIDESMAID

Jumbo Shrimp infielder Jonah Bride began the season with Miami, batting just 1-for-7 in five games before getting optioned to Jacksonville. Since coming to the First Coast. Bride is 30-for-86 (.349/.482/.698/1.180) with seven doubles, one triple, seven home runs, 16 RBIs, 19 walks and 14 runs scored in 25 games played. Bride leads the International League in OPS while ranking second in both on-base percentage and slugging percentage, seventh in batting average, tied for eighth in extra-base hits (15), tied for ninth in home runs, tied for 13th in walks (19) and tied for 23rd in hits (28).

IT IS HOW YOU START

Out of the club's 275.1 innings pitched thus far in 2024, Jacksonville starting pitchers have accounted for just 138.1 frames, a ratio of only 50.2 percent. That said, those 138.1 innings are the fourth-most in Triple-A for any starting rotation. Jumbo Shrimp starters have also provided quality in their innings. The club's starting rotation has posted the second-best batting average against (.240) and third-best ERA (4.16). Jacksonville starters have collectively ceded the 10th-fewest hits (126) and tied for the 11th-fewest walks (53). The Jumbo Shrimp's starting staff has yielded three runs or fewer in 14 of their last 16 games.

GRIFFIN-DOR, WHERE DWELL THE BRAVE AT HEART

In six games from April 5-14, Jacksonville outfielder Griffin Conine suffered through an 0-for-20 stretch with seven strikeouts. In the 12 games since, however, the former Duke Blue Devil has gotten hot. Conine is 11-for-his-last-38, slashign .289/.438/.553/.991 with a double, three home runs, five RBIs, nine walks, seven runs scored and only 13 punchouts. Conine has multiple hits in four of these last 12 contests, reaching base at least once in eight of those

SHRIMP BITES

Cody Poteet, who starts for Scranton/Wilkes-Barre on Saturday against the Jumbo Shrimp, pitched in 39 games, including 38 starts with Jacksonville in 2018-19 and again in 2021-22. With the Jumbo Shrimp, he posted a 9-15 and 3.91 ERA (103 R, 94 ER in 216.1 IP)... Jacksonville has not lost five in a row since a six-game skid from May 29-June 3, 2023.

ABOUT PATRICK

-Monteverde is the youngest child from a massive family. He is the youngest of 27 grandchildren on his dad's side and the youngest of 18 grandchildren on his mom's side. Both of Monteverde's parents are the youngest of twelve.

-A native of Pittsburgh, Monteverde started his collegiate baseball career at Divison III Virginia Wesleyan (Norfolk, Va.) for a season, posting a 1.96 ERA in 82 2/3 innings. In 2018, he moved up a rung, transferring to Division II Seton Hill in Greensburg, Pennsylvania, about 45 minutes from Monteverde's home. He had a solid first year there in 2018 (3.04 ERA), but three starts into his second season with the Griffins, he heard a pop in his elbow and underwent Tommy John surgery. Monteverde made just one more start for Seton Hill in 2020 before the COVID pandemic then shut down the season for him.

-Monteverde completed his collegiate career by transferring to Texas Tech University for the 2021 season. He went 7-4 with a 3.75 ERA, leading the Red Raiders in wins, starts (16), innings pitched (86.1) and strikeouts (101).

2024 SEASON

2023 SEASON

-Monteverde was promoted to Jacksonville on July 25 from Double-A Pensacola. At the time of his promotion, he led the Southern League in wins (8), ERA (2.44) and WHIP (1.11) while ranking second in both innings pitched (84.2) and batting average against (.207), tied for eighth in strikeouts (90) and tied for 14th in games started (14).

-Made 21 total starts with Pensacola in 2022. Led team in wins (10), innings pitched (114.0), strikeouts (114), double plays (T-1st, 11).

-Led qualified pitchers in ERA (3.32),

-Among the 119 Southern League pitchers with at least 30 IP, Monteverde ranked 40th in stranded runners (71.3%).

2022 SEASON

-Monteverde was promoted to Double-A Pensacola on August 2 from High-A Beloit.

-Over his final 13 starts in High-A, Monteverde went 3-4 with a 2.30 ERA. He pitched 70.1 innings, yielding only 54 hits (.211 batting average against) and striking out 75 against 21 walks.

2021 SEASON

-Six of his seven outings were in a relief role. Prior to that, he had not pitched in relief since 2017, his freshman year at Virginia Wesleyan. Even during that 2017 campaign, 11 of his 15 appearances were starts.
